A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EVALUATION PANEL RANKING OF THE PROPOSALS RECEIVED FOR KEY WEST AMPHITHEATER VENUE MANAGEMENT SERVICES IN RESPONSE TO RFQ NO. 19-003; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT IN SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMANCE WITH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS CONTAINED IN RFQ 19-003 UPON THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City issued Request for Qualifications No. 19-003 for Key West Amphitheater Venue Management Services, and two responsive proposals were received; and

WHEREAS, an evaluation panel, comprised of City staff, convened at a properly noticed meeting conducted consistent with the "Sunshine Law," on March 1, 2019, and ranked the proposals upon specific criteria; and

WHEREAS, the panel recommends that the City Commission authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute an agreement with the highest-ranked proposer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the proposals for Key West Amphitheater Management RFQ 19-003 are hereby ranked and approved by the City Commission as follows:

- (1) Rams Head Promotions of Key West, LLC
- (2) We've Got the Keys/AAG Live

Section 2: That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with the first-ranked firm in conformance with terms and conditions contained in the proposal package, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3: There is a separate budget account established for the facility, to capture and track revenues and expenses. A facility and maintenance fee will be charged on each ticket, and additional revenue terms, will be set forth in the contract.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.

(RFQ) No. 19-003: Key West Amphitheater Management

Action Statement

Approve evaluation panel ranking of firms submitting responses to RFQ 19-003: Key West Amphitheater Management and authorize City Manager to negotiate and, pursuant to legal review, enter into contract with Rams Head Promotions of Key West LLC. Authorize any necessary budget transfers/amendments.

Background

The City of Key West (City) requires the services of a qualified firm (Manager) to provide professional amphitheater management services. The Manager will work independently but cooperatively to ensure proper operation of the Amphitheater while minimizing City involvement in event operations. The Manager will be responsible for the administration, financial management, marketing/outreach, venue operations, and coordination with City services.

In response to this need, the City issued RFQ 19-003 to solicit proposals from potential venue managers. The City subsequently received two (2) responses to the RFQ from the following firms:

- Rams Head Promotions of Key West LLC
- We've Got the Keys/AAG Live

On March 1, 2019, an evaluation panel consisting of City Staff held a publicly advertised meeting to present qualification and cost proposal ranking of the two firms submitting responses. Both firms' proposals were considered Responsive and Responsible. Panel rankings are attached for review.

Using the Selection Criteria in the RFQ, the evaluation panel ranked the firms as follows:

Qualifications

Rams Head Promotions has managed three self-owned entertainment venues in Maryland, as well as a 10-year partnership with the City of Baltimore to manage the Pier Six Pavilion. Additionally, they provide event management to the Maryland Hall for the Performing Arts, the St. Johns College Francis Scott Key Auditorium and created Annapolis' Silopanna music festival. In Key West, Rams Head produces events for the Key West Theater, the Sunset Green Event Lawn, and the Key West Amphitheater.

Options

There are two (2) options:

- Accept the rankings of the panel and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and, pursuant to legal review, enter into contract with Rams Head Promotions of Key West LLC.
- 2. Authorize City Manager to negotiate and, pursuant to legal review, enter into contract with the second ranked firm, We've Got the Keys/AAG Live, or reject all proposals and provide further direction to Staff regarding amphitheater venue management.

Financial Issues

Rams Head Promotions of Key West LLC is proposing the City receive \$1 per ticket sold plus 20 percent of net profit for all amphitheater events. They will additionally charge a facility and maintenance fee on each ticket to reinvest in the regular maintenance and upkeep of the amphitheater. The City's sole responsibility will be mowing the grass.

Final total compensation and the City revenue package will be established during agreement negotiations.

Term of the contract to be negotiated; Rams Head Promotions of Key West LLC desires a three-year lease with one (1) three-year renewal option.

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve staff ranking of firms submitting responses to RFQ 19-003: Key West Amphitheater Management, and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and, pursuant to legal review, enter into contract with Rams Head Promotions of Key West LLC, and authorize any necessary budget transfers/amendments to fund venue management operations.

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Truman Waterfront Amphitheater - Event Manager Ranking Committee Meeting RFP 19-003

Meeting Minutes March 1, 2019

Purpose: Meeting of the Ranking Committee to review, select or rank proposals made for the Truman Waterfront Amphitheater Event Manager. Responsive Proposers were as follows:

- 1) Rams Head Productions
- 2) We've Got the Keys/AAG Live

Discussion/Comments:

- 1) Meeting was called to order at 11:05 by Steve McAlearney (Steve), Director of Engineering, City of Key West.
- 2) Steve began the meeting by allowing each of the committee members to ask questions (if any) of the proposers prior to formal ranking. John Paul Castro (JPC) was the first to respond with a question.
 - a. JPC requested clarification from Rams Head Production (RHP) of the 20% net income, after tax would come to the City, what taxes are they speaking of? RHP responded that the net revenue is after any assed taxes (sales tax). RHP further clarified that the 20% the City would receive would be 20% of their total net profit.
 - b. JPC requested clarification from RHP on the length of the proposed contract. The RFP stipulates a 2 year contract and in RHP's proposal they requested a 3 year term with a 3 year option. RHP responded that it would take a solid 2 years to start generating any money so a 2 year contract would not be satisfactory.
 - c. JPC requested clarification on the maintenance portion. RHP verified that they would take care of everything except landscape maintenance and that would be the City's responsibility.
 - d. JPC and Todd Stoughton (Todd) requested clarification on the financial return to the City from We've Got the Keys/AAG Live (WGTK/AAG). Based on the RFP it was unclear the 25% return would be based on gross sales or 25% of total profit. After a phone conversation with the principle of WGTK/AAG (Jason), it was verified that the 25% would come from gross sales.
 - e. JPC inquired from WGTK/AAG about their maintenance program as well. They proposed that the only thing the City would be responsible for is the landscape maintenance.
 - f. Todd questioned Engineering staff as to metering of water, sewer and electric. Engineering responded that in light of both proposers level of responsibility once the Amphitheater was turned over to the event coordinator the City would transfer all the services over to them.



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- g. Todd questioned how/who local events (Key West Highschool Band) would go to for coordinating individual events. Steve responded that everyone would go through the event manager.
- h. RHP further acknowledged that there would not be a charge for that event.
