## **Key West Bight Operations:**

• Preparing ITB for new pipe mooring piles at the Ferry Terminal Pier.

- Preparing ITB for the Seaports fire main replacement.
- Preparing ITB for Ferry Terminal Portable Generator installation.
- Contractor to start mobilizing to site for the Seawall Replacement project on August 5.
- Margaret St Bathhouse/ Laundry Repairs permits have been issued. Coordinating schedule with contractor.
- Meeting with Holiday Lighting contractor to prepare options for additional work for Boards review.

## **Key West Bight Marina:**

- July transient dockage was up 19% compared to last July.
- This year during Lobster Mini Season all slips were full, and we are having more families staying 5 to 7 nights with us.
- Starting to get a lot of calls for Fantasy Fest 2019 which is the last week in October.
- Working with the Florida Power Boat Club again for the 4-night stay in the first week of November.
- We are in the middle of the Boy Scouts of America summer program which runs from June 1<sup>st</sup> to the middle of August.
- 12,031 Passengers passed through the Ferry Terminal this July compared to 14,189 last July.
