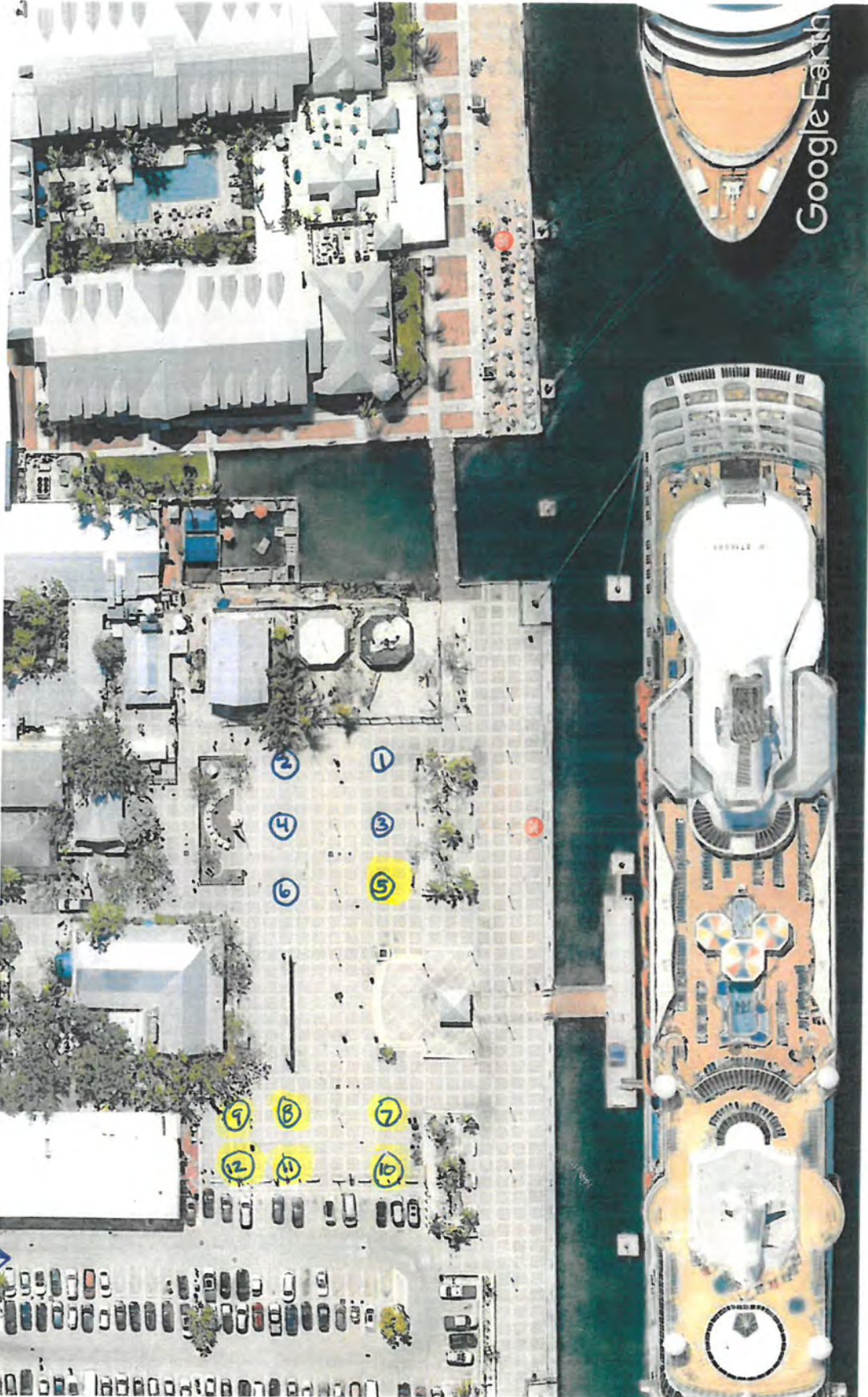

2-Wild Tamarind (Windsor and Virginia)

2-Gumbo Limbo (Duck Avenue)

1-Royal Poinciana (17th St median-replacing one removed)

2-Lignum vitae (memorial tree at fire station, Mallory square)

* Three Silver buttonwood trees purchase by a citizen and planted by the City in the right of way.

The goal of the tree orders for April and May were to fill in planters on Whitehead and Fleming Streets (recent sidewalk and paving work done by engineering dept).
