

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST,  
FLORIDA, AMENDING THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM  
FOR GENERAL EMPLOYEES; AMENDING CHAPTER  
46, SECTION 63 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES  
EXTENDING TRUSTEE TERMS TO FOUR YEARS;  
PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR  
CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE  
DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Retirement System for General Employees has recommended certain revisions to the plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission finds that the recommendations are in the best interest of the City, the taxpayers, and the plan participants;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the City Commission of the City of Key West:

**Section 1. Chapter 46, Article II, Section 46-63 of the Key West City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:**

**Sec. 46-63. Terms; vacancy.**

- (a) ~~The elected active employee representative position expiring next after the passage of this ordinance shall be appointed for a term of three years. The two remaining elected active employee representatives shall be elected to a term of two years. The member appointed by the mayor and city commission shall be appointed to a term of three years. The member appointed by a majority of the board shall be appointed to a term of two years.~~ **All members of the board of trustees shall serve a four year term. All trustees serving as of July 1, 2019 shall have their current terms extended so that the length of the term is four years.**
- (b) If a vacancy shall occur prior to the expiration of a trustee's term, a replacement trustee shall be chosen in the same manner as the trustee who has left office. A replacement trustee shall serve a full term measured from the date of replacement.
- (c) All trustees shall serve until their replacements are selected.

**Section 2. Should any section of this ordinance be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall be in full force and effect as if the invalid provision had not been adopted.**

**Section 3. This ordinance shall be codified in the Key West City Code. The editor of the Code shall be authorized to renumber or re-letter sections as may be necessary.**

**Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.**
