SUBJECT: Expand the Non-Resident Parking Permit for Truman Waterfront Park in City of Key West Ordinance Sec. 70-265 to include Jackson Square and 500 Block of Thomas Street after business hours and on weekends.

Action statement:

Request the Key West City Commission to approve modification to the City of Key West Code of Ordinances Sec. 70-265 to allow Non-Resident Parking Permit for Truman Waterfront Park holders to park up to 4 hours for free, one time per day, after business hours and on weekends at the Jackson Square Parking behind Monroe County Courthouse including 500 block of Thomas Street.

Background:

The City currently has a Non-Resident Truman Waterfront Park Permit Program that allows vehicles registered to Monroe County Residents who reside up to mile marker 11 to park in the Truman Waterfront Park up to 4 hours, one time per day, for free (with exceptions, including special events). This Ordinance Modification would add the Jackson Square Lot including 500 Block of Thomas Street to this program. The cost for this permit is \$25.00 per year. They are sold at City Hall at 1300 White Street. Registration and Proof of residency such as a driver's license is required with application.

Recommendation:

Change the Non-Resident Truman Waterfront Park Parking Program in City Ordinance Sec. 70-265 to include 4 hours free, one time per day, to Permit Holders at Jackson Square Parking Lot and 500 Block of Thomas Street after hours and Weekends.

Financial Impact:

The financial impact to the City will not be significant. There is excess parking in this area most of the time on nights and weekends. This expansion will not deny a paying customer a place to park except on rare occasions when the area is full.
