On 9/15/19, at 21:32 hours, Ofc Tellier and I (Ofc. Jackson) responded to 1029 Truman Ave. (Bare Assets) regarding an unknown problem.

On arrival, I met with Laura Fernanda Ruiz Londono (identified later using DAVID). She was bleeding all down the left side of her face from a laceration over her left eye. She was only speaking Spanish, so I requested Ofc. Arguello to respond to the scene. There was a Bare Assets employee on scene who spoke Spanish, and he translated for me. I was able to ascertain Londono did not want medical attention. She told the translator that she is from Kendall and that her boyfriend hit her left eye. She would not tell us his name or give any information of him.

Observation:

Laura had blood coming from the laceration above her left eye, she had slurred speech, blood shot watery eyes, and the odor of alcoholic beverage coming from her breath.

Ofc. Arguello arrived, he asked her question in Spanish and Laura did not answer any of them. She got very upset and started to yell at Ofc. Arguello in English. She said she did not like the way Ofc. Arguello was talking to her. I asked her where her car was to retrieve her belongings. I escorted her to her car.

Observation:

Laura's car was parked sideways in the middle of the parking lot. There were cases of beer in the back seat and one can of beer in the passenger door. There were beer cans next to the car. The GPS mounting unit was on the seat. There was a long scratch on the back- passenger side door.

Laura got her phone. She was asked what her boyfriends name is. She said Brian Marx (unable to find). She tried to call her friend and did not get an answer. She told me her friend lives in Key Largo. She was told that she was in Key West. Laura seemed very surprised to learn she was in Key West. Laura believed she was in Key Largo.

Marchman Act Criteria:

Laura thought she was in Key Largo
she had slurred speech, blood shot eyes, and the odor of alcoholic beverage emanating from her person
She had no where to go or no one to take care of her

I attempted to place Laura in custody, she pulled away and was trying to get in her car. I told her not to resist us. I grabbed her left arm and tried to get her out of the car. Using her right arm, she grabbed the passenger side door frame. Three other officers, Ofc. Hudson, Ofc. Arguello and Ofc. Tellier grabbed her. I let go of her left arm and grabbed her right arm and hand. She would not let go of the door frame. She was told multiple times to stop resisting. I pulled her fingers off the door frame. She was now facing the passenger seat and she climb in. Laura would not put her hands behind her back. Ofc. Hudson drive stunned her. She continued to resist. Ofc. Hudson drive stunned her again. She continued to resist. Ofc. Tellier was able to get her right arm in a position so that I could get one cuff on her right wrist. Laura still would not put her left hand behind her back. Ofc. Tellier was able to get her left arm into position so I could put the other cuff on her. I double locked the cuff. We got Laura out of the car and walked her to Ofc. Tellier's patrol car. Laura started to fight us again. We were able to get her into the backseat and she locked her legs bracing the door open. She would not listen to commands. Ofc. Hudson told Laura to put her feet

in the patrol car or she would be pepper sprayed. Laura did not comply. Ofc. Hudson pepper sprayed her.

Rescue 1 responded. Laura got out of the patrol car without incident and onto Rescue 1's stretcher. I rode with Rescue 1 to the hospital. At the hospital Laura was treated for her original injuries (laceration above her eye). The drive stun signature marks were document by Sgt. Sims, who responded to complete a Response to Resistance Report (RRI). Laura was cleared from the hospital. Ofc. Tellier and I transported her to Monroe County Detention Center without incident.

My AXON BWC was activated during this encounter. In-car recorded transport.

Laura is in violation of F.S.S. 843.02 RESIST / OBSTRUCT OFFICER W/O VIOLENCE.

On this 9/15/19 at 1029 Truman Ave. (Bare Assets). Laura Fernanda Ruiz Londono resisted multiple officers, by pulling her arms away, grabbing the door frame, climbing into her car. She locked her lags to brace the patrol car door open. After being tased and pepper sprayed Laura was still resisting loud verbal commands.

On 09/15/2019 at approximately 2132, while on routine patrol in the City of Key West, I was dispatched to Bare Assets (1029 Truman Ave) reference an intoxicated female who was bleeding from the face.

On arrival, I observed a female, who was identified as Laura F. Ruiz Londono DOB 04/06/1992, sitting on the front stoop of the Liquor store speaking with Officers. I stood by, acting as scene security, while Ruiz Londono was interviewed by Officers Tellier and Jackson.

Ruiz Londono then returned to her vehicle, parked on the West side of the parking lot, with Officer Jackson to retrieve her phone. Officer Tellier told me Ruiz Londono was intoxicated, had no other place to go and was going to be taken into custody under the Marchman Act.

As I was speaking with Sergeant Kouri, away from Ruiz Londono, I heard Officer Jackson begin to give loud verbal commands. I observed Ruiz Londono partially inside the vehicle and Officers Jackson and Tellier attempting to handcuff her. I took both of Ruiz Londono's arms and held them behind her back as Officer Jackson attempted to place handcuff restraints on her wrists. Ruiz Londono continued to pull away and kick. She then wrapped her right arm around the front passenger side door pillar and would not comply with commands.

I then gave Ruiz Londono loud, repetitive verbal commands and told her she would be tased if she continued to resist. I drew my agency issued Taser from my holster, removed the cartridge and placed the Taser to her left mid back area. I again gave a loud warning that she would be Tased if she did not comply. She continued to resist. I administered one drive stun cycle. I continued to give her commands. Ruiz Londono continued to hold onto the vehicle and kept her left arm under her body. I again administered a drive stun cycle with my Taser. I continued to give commands, she continued to resist. I administered one last drive stun cycle with my Taser. At this time Officer Jackson was able to gain control of her arms and place her in handcuffs.

Ruiz Londono was then escorted to Officer Tellier's patrol car. As Ruiz Londono was being placed in the rear seat of the vehicle, she began to again get aggressive. Ruiz Londono pushed both of her feet against the door and locked her knees. Ruiz Londono was again given loud verbal commands to comply. She continued to resist. I then told Ruiz Londono if she continued to resist she would be sprayed with my agency issued pepper spray. Ruiz Londono refused to comply. I again gave Ruiz Londono a warning and released a burst of spray to her facial area. Ruiz Londono continued to refuse to place her feet in the vehicle.

Officer Tellier placed a hobble restraint device around Ruiz Londono ankles and, with warning, administered one cycle from his agency issued Taser to her right thigh area.

On 9/15/19 at 2132 hours, I (Ofc. Arguello) responded to 1029 Truman Avenue (Bare Assets) to assist on a battery call.

Upon arrival, I noticed a female (later identified as Laura Ruiz) sitting on the ground in front of the liquor store. Ruiz smelled of alcohol, had slurred speech and had glassy eyes. Ruiz had a large laceration on her left eyebrow. Ruiz refused to answer any of my question and told me to "don't fucking come at me like that". I backed away from the investigation due to Ruiz's behavior towards me.

I noticed that Ofc. Jackson and Tellier were trying to detain Ruiz. Ruiz began pulling away from the officer and I immediately ran towards her vehicle to assist. Ruiz was ordered to stop resisting and she continued to pull away and grab on to her vehicle. I grabbed her arm and tried pulling her away from her vehicle, but she was able to hold on. I assisted in escorting Ruiz to Ofc. Telliers vehicle. Ruiz sat in the back seat but refused to place her legs inside the vehicle. I do not have any further involvement in this case.
