An application was received requesting the removal of (4) Japanese Blueberry trees. A site inspection was done and documented that one of the trees is not regulated (tree #2) due to its diameter being less than 4" (Sec 110-321.a.3)






Photo showing the roots of tree #1, view 3.




Photo showing location of tree on property, view 2.




Photo showing trunk of tree #2. Note tree not regulated.




Photo showing the tree canopies in relation to the structure.




Photo showing root systems of trees 1-3 next to structure.




Photo of the root system of tree #4.




Photo showing the trunk and canopy of tree #4, view 2.




Photo showing the root system of tree #4.

Condition: 60% (fair)

Total Average Value = 50%

Value x Diameter = 2.8 replacement caliper inches

Total required replacement if both tree #1, #3, and #4 removed = 14.1 caliper inches.

Mr. and Mrs. Shapiro,

I have visited the site regarding the foundation concerns.

The home is resting on the original coral pier style foundations. Each of the foundations reviewed are in different phases of condition. Some have eroded more than others. The most concerning is the east side of the home. There are tree roots from trees along the property line that are disturbing the edge wall piers. This is causing shifting of the exterior wall at the east side. Upon reviewing the inside of the home, it is evident that the exterior wall is or has shifted. This wall is a bearing wall for the support beam that supports the current stairwell, as well as the upstairs hall / bedroom.

Upon my findings', I would recommend removing the trees along the eastern property line, excavating the intrusive roots that are impacting the pier foundations. Once trees and roots are removed, we will temporarily support the exterior wall and replace the coral foundations with concrete CMU style foundations. The current status of the home in relation to the sub grade is minimal. We would propose to excavate under the side of the home to gain access, and establish temporary supports until engineering and permitting is completed.

I have taken pictures of the mitigating circumstances. I will be sending to our engineer for his specific recommendations. He will determine size, and count of foundations to be replaced. I will be able to

provide pricing once I have spoken further with the engineer and determined how many and to what extent the project will ultimately entail.

Thank you for the opportunity to work with you on this, I look forward to getting you a detailed estimate once we hear back from the engineer.


