Our family writes to you today in strong support of the expansion of the Montessori Children's School to 1217 Varela Street. We do not believe that parking will be exacerbated by the expansion since the project is allowing for more space for the existing population to learn and enjoy outside enrichment. Dropoff and pickup practices will not change from that which exists today.

Traffic and parking are inherent problems throughout the island and are not confined to this neighborhood. In our experience, family members picking up and dropping off their children are courteous and respectful of each other and of the neighborhood.
