Re: Request for Renewal, City of Key West Art in Public Places Administrative Agreement

The City of Key West Art in Public Places Administrative Agreement first dated November 21, 2017 between the City Commissioners for Key West and Monroe Council of the Arts will end November 21, 2019. However, we would like to exercise the amendment, written in paragraph 3 of the contract that states there is an option to renew for 2 years. This would be effective November 22, 2019 and expire on November 21, 2021.

This is a request that a new Art in Public Places Administrative Agreement be entered by the Board of Commissioners for Key West and the Monroe Council of the Arts through November 21, 2021.

We respectfully request your kind consideration of this matter in a timely manner so we may provide effective administration of Art in Public Places for many upcoming projects. The Art in Public Places Board unanimously recommended at the October 10, 2019 meeting to renew this agreement.
