A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA), AWARDING THE BID OF NEARSHORE ELECTRIC, INC. FOR ITB 20-004 - PORTABLE GENERATOR INSTALLATION AT KEY WEST BIGHT FERRY TERMINAL, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$278,303.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CRA/CITY OF KEY WEST IN SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMANCE WITH DOCUMENTS CONTAINED IN THE BID PACKAGE, UPON ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; WAIVING MINOR INCONSISTENCIES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in October 2019, the CRA issued Invitation to bid 20-004 for Portable Generator Installation at Key West Bight Ferry Terminal, and four firms submitted a response on November 6, 2019; and

WHEREAS, City staff reviewed the responses and identified one transposed dollar amount in Bid Line Item 20, of the bid submitted by low bidder Nearshore Electric, Inc., which resulted in a \$36 discrepancy in the overall bid. Regardless of the minor irregularity, City staff recommends award of the bid to Nearshore Electric, Inc. as the lowest responsive bidder; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of November 13, 2019, the Key West Bight Board recommended award of ITB 20-004 to Nearshore Electric, Inc.; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Nearshore Electric, Inc. for "ITB 20-004 Portable Generator Installation - Key West Bight Ferry Terminal," in an amount not to exceed \$278,303.00 is hereby awarded.

Section 2: That minor inconsistencies in the original submitted bid are waived.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract in substantial conformance with documents contained in the bid package, as amended, on behalf of the City of Key West, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That the project is budgeted in account No. 405-7506-575-6400.
