A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING A TASK ORDER UNDER THE CITY'S GENERAL UTILITIES CONTRACT WITH CHARLEY TOPPINO & SONS, INC. IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$69,508.00 FOR SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT AT CHARTERBOAT ROW - CITY MARINA AT GARRISON BIGHT; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 15-292, the City Commission approved a three-year General Utilities contract with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc., in Resolution No. 18-014 the Contract was amended to incorporate certain Federal Contracting provisions, and in Resolution 18-322 the contract was renewed for two years; and

WHEREAS, sidewalk replacement along Charterboat Row at City Marina is necessary and is eligible for up to 70% cost reimbursement through construction grant funding through the Tourist Development Council (\$58,000.00), approved in Resolution 19-012; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached Task Order under the City's General Utilities Contract with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. in a total amount not to exceed \$69,508.00, for Sidewalk Replacement at Charterboat Row - City Marina at Garrison Bight is hereby approved.

Section 2: That this project is budgeted in Account 413-7551-575-6300 (GB75511901), and construction costs will be reimbursed up to 70% (\$58,000.00) through the Tourist Development Council grant approved in Resolution 19-012. An unforeseen conditions allowance of \$4,000.00 is included in the Task Order. Any necessary budget adjustments are authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents for this Task Order, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect

immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication

by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of
