SECTION 1: PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

INTRODUCTION

Sunset Sail Key West proposes a two-part response to RFP 003-20. Part 1 is operating Historic Schooner When and If during the winter season out of the Key West Bight, and part two is operating Classic Schooner Free Spirit for the summer season in conjunction with Reef Relief. As we take our role as the stewards of the historic vessel When And If very seriously, we cannot justify keeping this undeniable part of American maritime history in harm's way during hurricane season. In addition, the hot summer conditions are detrimental to an 80-year-old wooden vessel. It is for these reasons that all the vintage wooden sailing ships in Key West travel north for the summer. Our two-part response ensures the longevity of the Historic When and If while satisfying the proposal requirements for historic and educational schooners to operate out of the Key West Bight.

EXPERIENCE

For the love of Sailing

Seth Salzmann's Key West experience began at 13 years old. Having moved to the island with his family, Salzmann was quickly drawn to the docks. After school he would watch the charter boats come in from their afternoon fishing charters at Garrison Bight's Charter Boat Row, and before long he had



convinced the captains and crew to let him wash down their fishing boats in exchange for a few dollars. His entrepreneurial spirit, coupled with his growing passion for all things boating, quickly developed into a busy routine - Key West Bight pre-dawn to wash a local schooner for \$5 paid to him by the crew, off to school, then to Charter Boat Row in the afternoon to wash the fishing boats, then back to Key West Bight in the evening to ride along and learn to sail onboard a schooner for the sunset sail.

A bright, idealistic character with a passion for sailing and seamanship blossomed into a career in the business of seafaring and yachting, along with a passion for passing on skills and opportunity to others. In just a few short years, Salzmann had become a constant on the waterfront at the Historic Seaport. He was featured on the front page article in *The Citizen* on May 31, 2000 for his love of sailing and admiration for the traditional ships, and was Citizen of the Day at just 16 years old. As all the Key West schooners set off for their New England summer tours, Seth joined them to work as a deckhand and broaden his sailing horizons. He was quickly promoted to first mate aboard the engineless, antique schooners that sailed in the

windjammer passenger trade on the coast of Maine. This experience opened his eyes to the ways of the bygone era of the sailing cargo trade along the United States' East Coast, from Maine to Key West and the Caribbean. Enthralled with the history of sailing ships, he began to read about the history of the Florida Keys marine trade, from natives to fishermen and pirates, to the first Coast Guard revenue cutters, and salvage schooners, to the brave merchant schooners. This vision of Key West as a major hub of sailing ships from around the world drove his desire to share the city's sailing history with all the guests that he entertained in the modern-day sailing trade.

On completing his first trans-Atlantic crossing as first mate on a 115' expedition trawler, Seth felt sure of his future path as a sailor and educator. Once he earned his USCG 100 ton Captains license at 19 years old, he began captaining first *Schooner Wolf*, then moved on to sail training schooners in both the Bahamas and the Florida Keys. Sailing week-long charters with upwards of twenty-two Boy and Co-ed Sea Scouts was his first experience channeling his personable nature and natural talent for sailing into education. He spent many happy summers teaching sailing and seamanship to young adults, while introducing them to the delicate marine ecosystems of the Keys. So popular was Seth as a captain and educator, that years later he was invited to bring his own vessel, *Conch West*, onto the team with Florida Seabase, with whom he worked for four wonderful summers.

With a desire to gain as much experience sailing traditional vessels as he could, Capt. Seth was very hard pressed to say "No" to the many opportunities offered to him to sail both at home and abroad; alas, he had a deep desire to keep Key West his home base. Keen to strengthen his newfound roots, Capt. Seth was honored to accept his promotion to captain in the Conch Republic Navy, as well as his invitation to join the illustrious Key West Propeller Club.

In 2008, having seasoned in New England in the summers and Key West in the winters as captain of some of America's most historic and well-known sailing ships and yachts, Capt. Seth returned to Key West and purchased his first vessel. He renamed it *Conch West* after his

adopted home, and she became the namesake for his corporation: Conch West, Inc. Using the skills he'd learned during his years at sea, and with the many resources his local friends and family offered, he began her restoration. In time, the twice-around-the-world sailing vessel Conch West was reborn. Fittingly, upon completion, her maiden voyage was with a Conch Republic Navy relief mission to Haiti following the devastating earthquake of 2010. Loaded with more than 4 tons of relief supplies and sailing in tandem with 4 other vessels, this mission delivered more than thirty tons of food, water purification devices and medical equipment to a small village in desperate need of help on Ile de le Gonave, Haiti.

In 2011, Capt. Seth founded Conch West, Inc. His new corporation would endeavor to create a company that would offer a real sailing experience to clients while providing a platform for local Key West residents to learn about their marine environment and hone their skills as sailors. To this day, the manifesto for Conch West, Inc. and its DBA, Sunset Sail Key West, is to act as a steppingstone into the marine industry with an emphasis on fine seamanship and business excellence in sailing and yachting for all its captains and crew. In 2012, with the early success of his new company, Sunset Sail Key West, Capt. Seth acquired the *S/V High Tide* and undertook a complete restoration -- self-funded through long hours and many day jobs -- of what had been Key West's first USCG certified sailing charter boat.

In the middle of *High Tide's* restoration, Capt. Seth was hired by a previous employer, who, having just purchased the historic 1939 wooden schooner *When And If*, was in need of a captain and project manager for the complete rebuild of the vessel. Accepting the job and juggling two restorations, one in New York and the other in Key West, he was a busy guy!

With High Tide nearing completion, Seth was able to lease dock space in the Key West Bight at Schooner Wharf Bar. On a rainy June 1ª of 2013, Capt. Seth and a small group of friends launched the fully restored, Florida Keys-designed thirty-three foot sloop *High Tide*. Aug. 1, 2013 finally saw the vessel in service as a charter vessel and her bright kelly green hull and pretty appearance under sail have made her a favorite in the Bight ever since. High Tide, which

was one of the first sailboats that introduced Seth to sailing, was now the flagship of Conch West, Inc. and a new tool in his mission to create and train some of the best sailors in Key West. Business was jumpstarted by the kind inclusion of a beautiful article in the



Key West Citizen's business section of August 13*, 2013. Aptly titled "Heart and Sail," the article touched many people and had the phone ringing non-stop.

Meanwhile, upon completion of *When And If's* restoration in New York, the owner no longer had a plan or the means to keep the vessel and decided to put her up for sale. Capt. Seth, knowing that there was much interest in these recently restored classic yachts in Europe, was afraid of the possibility of another American treasure being moved overseas and disappearing from American maritime culture. Seth's vision was to open *When And If* up to the public for day sails and tall ship festivals, in hopes of proving to a bank that she was a feasible business endeavor. The owner of *When And If*, aware of Seth's ambition, allowed him to execute a lease agreement on the yacht while she ran her first season, with first refusal to buy. It wouldn't be the last time a patron, full of admiration for Seth's passion and ambition in the maritime industry and knowing he would be an asset to any business, would offer a helping hand.

In November 2015, When And If arrived in Key West under her new leaseholder. Unable to get a commercial slip downtown for the historic yacht, Capt. Seth leased space on Stock Island and began operating When And If in addition to his three other private charter sailing yachts in operation.

True to his vision, Seth took *When And If* on her first Tall Ships Great Lakes tour in 2016. He was not disappointed. The enthusiasm with which she was received was remarkable, and through every corner of the Great Lakes, people congratulated Seth on his grand ambition to preserve the American flag of this historic ship. One such admirer, having questioned Seth closely during his two-hour day sail, was so taken with his passion and vision that he made it possible for funds to become available through the bank where he had connections. At the last moment, Seth was able to call in his first refusal privileges against an offer on the table from a European gentleman who wished to relocate and reflag the yacht. With funding in place and the stroke of a pen, on the dock in Stock Island, Capt. Seth and his company became the fifth owners of the 80-year-old schooner yacht built for General Patton and designed by legendary American yacht designer John Alden.

Capt. Seth has never looked back, and Sunset Sail Key West has grown to become known for its commitment to excellence within the Key West charter fleet. With Seth at the helm and the company motto, "For the Love of Sailing," Sunset Sail Key West has become not only a company that provides an authentic experience to its guests, but also one that has developed dozens of sailors and paid the way for eight crew to gain their captains' licenses and go on to be great captains and stewards of Key West's rich sailing and maritime history.

PROPOSED BUSINESS PLAN

DESCRIPTION OF OUR TWO-PART PROPOSAL

PART ONE

From November through May we will operate the schooner *When And If* in the Historic Seaport. We will offer both two-hour day sails and two-hour sunset sails. The *When And If* will offer shared experiences for up to twenty-eight passengers. As we have always done, we encourage passenger participation in raising the sails and taking the helm. Our crews are extremely well versed in the intricacies of sailing a traditional wooden schooner and are constantly engaging the passengers regarding what we are doing. It has always been our policy to interact with our passengers on a personal basis, rather than a canned narration. During the sail, our captain and crew point out the places of historic Key West interest. We pay special consideration to the historic significance of sailing vessels in Key West, as well as the roll New England boat builders played in both the boat building and home construction industries of the Keys.

In the summer months, When And If will continue her campaign of attending tall ship festivals on the East Coast of the United States and Canada. Thousands of people attend these festivals and visit the When And If, which sports her homeport of Key West on her transom.

PART TWO

From June through October we will operate the schooner *Free Spirit* in the slip occupied by *When And If* in winter months. *Free Spirit* is reminiscent of the types of shallow draft vessels built and used in Key West for fishing, sponging and transportation. These will be private charters for up to six passengers with a crew of two. We will have several programs to choose from.

Our tours are used to connect visitors to our beautiful ocean and surrounding environment. Sunset Sail Key West now wants to take this experience a step further and incorporate educational presentations into our tours. We believe that our guests will get more out of the

sailing experience if they know background information on our marine ecosystems, why oceans are so important and what they can personally do to keep them healthy. We will focus on the history of our waterfront and back-country and the role sailing vessels played. Our goal is to have our passengers take home a better understanding of our environment and history.

In order to achieve this goal, Sunset Sail Key West is excited to partner with Reef Relief and use their resources as a way to strengthen educational programs on our sailing tours. Reef Relief is a non-profit organization dedicated to preserving and protecting coral reef ecosystems. Since 1987, Reef Relief has taken the lead on educating visitors, community members and students about our fragile marine environment. For the past 32 years, they have reached hundreds of thousands of people through their various education programs, social media platforms, and public environmental learning center.

We plan to have Reef Relief staff train our mates on the best ways to teach passengers about the local environment. We will also work together to create captivating presentations such as "Marine Ecosystems,"

"Oceanography," and "The Natural History of the Florida Keys". By working together, we can effectively spread awareness on pressing environmental issues and create an experience that is much more than just a snorkel trip or sunset sail.

SUMMERY DESCRIPTION OF BUSINESS PROPOSED

By proposing this two-part response, we believe it makes possible the opportunity to bring the historic schooner *When And If* to a new home in the Key West Historic Seaport while still offering a hands-on educational experience to our visitors in the summer months.

When And If is a true part of American maritime history, and she turns heads at every port she enters. Many seaports pay a handsome fee to have When And If at their docks for tall ship events, and she attracts large numbers of visitors everywhere she goes. Enabling When And If to take her place in the Key West Historic Seaport will certainly add to the attraction of our waterfront.

VESSEL'S HISTORY

When General (then Colonel) George S. Patton commissioned one of America's greatest designers to conceive a boat to be built by F.F Pendleton of Wiscasset, Maine in 1939, he had the ultimate ambition in mind: "When the war is over, and if I live through it, Bea and I are going to sail her around the world." The designer, John Alden, had made his name as a builder of elite racing schooners that retained all their beauty and style while constantly winning the premier ocean races of the time. When And If was a new idea: a yacht which would maintain all her classic beauty and hold her own in recreational racing while being sturdy, comfortable, safe and luxurious enough to take a family on the voyage of a lifetime.

Long after the General's untimely death in 1945, When And If sails on. Having been maintained in impeccable condition, When And If remained in the Patton family until 1972 when the general's nephew, Neal Ayer, made a gift of the vessel to the Landmark School in Prides Crossing, MA, where she was the centerpiece of a sail training program for dyslexic children.

In a storm in November of 1990, When And If's mooring line broke and she was driven onto the rocks. Although the damage was extensive, the structural integrity of the ship was unaffected. At that time, When And If passed back into private ownership, and during the course of the next three years, she was painstakingly rebuilt. In June of 1994 she was re-launched. Renowned broadcast journalist Walter Cronkite praised both her wonderful strength, as well as the great work of shipwrights Gannon and Benjamin in Vineyard Haven, MA -- the boatyard that brought her back to life.

Spending the next 17 years cruising the coast of the United States and occasionally racing in classic yacht regattas, *When And If* turned heads wherever she went. In early 2012, Doug

Hazlitt purchased the When And If with plans to return the vessel to its original condition. Following an extensive two-year restoration, When And If was back in all her glory!

Currently owned and operated by Capt. Seth Salzmann, this historic schooner is open to the public for daily sails out of Key West during the winter and Salem, MA for the summer. The When And If is not only in impeccable condition, she is fulfilling an important role in educating her guests on the importance of maritime history and the role these classic schooners played.

VESSEL'S HISTORY

The schooner Free Spirit is a thirty-three foot Lazy
Jack schooner built in
Pensacola, FL in 1977 and designed by famed
designer Ted
Brewer. Brewer achieved
fame with the
modifications of the
successful 1962 America's
Cup defender, Weatherly,
and as the designer of Ted
Turner's 1962 America's
Cup 12-meter entry,
American Eagle.



Ted went on to design several notable schooners before designing the Lazy Jack series. His inspiration was the shallow draft Gulf Coast merchant schooners, with a versatile sail plan and shallow full keel with an extendable swing keel. He designed the Lazy Jack schooner to be an all-around everybody's schooner, capable of exploring the Gulf Coast from Mississippi to Key West, FL and the Florida Keys.

Reminiscent of the Bahamian and Greek sponging schooners with a Bermuda main and gaff foresail and low freeboard, the Lazy Jack schooner is ideal for sailing the back-country flats in search of sponge beds while being versatile and easy to handle short-handed.

Thirty-two Lazy Jack schooners were built, of which *Free Spirit* was hull #16 and Conch West, Inc. is its second owner.

1. Purpose

In return for payments and other valuable consideration and covenants as set out below, CRA desires to provide dockage space for the temporary use of Owner, who desires to purchase the right for temporary use of such space through regular payments and through faithful performance of the covenants and stipulations herein. The permitted use of said vessel is limited to commercial operations, specifically described as HISTORIC, VESSEL FOXATOR FOXATOR Owner agrees that the vessel shall not be used or rented for purposes of domicile or overnight residence while moored in the dockage space. The Marina Manager of the City of Key West must approve any change in use.

Owner agrees to be responsible to CRA and pay for any and all loss or damages to the docks, floats or other facilities caused by Owners vessel or Owner, his agents, servants, and/or employees whether caused by negligence or not, and further to hold CRA harmless for any of the foregoing. Further, Owner agrees to be responsible for damages, which Owner or Owners vessel may cause to other vessels in the Marina.

2. Dockage Space

The certain dockage space to be used by Owner is identified as berth _______ on Pier ______ in the Key West Bight Marina of the CRA of the City of Key West, Florida. Said berthing space is for the exclusive purpose of docking the above-named vessel only, or another vessel of similar size and use as a replacement for the vessel, subject to the approval of the Marina Manager of the City of Key West. CRA reserves the right to relocate Owner's vessel to an alternate location within the Marina at its sole discretion; draft, beam (width), and overall length will be the determining factors for slip assignments of commercial vessels.

3. Term

The term of this agreement shall commence on the ______ day of _____, 201_, and thereafter on a month-to-month basis until terminated as provided for by the terms of this Agreement. The Agreement is effective when signed by both parties.

This agreement shall constitute a month-to-month tenancy, with all rights and responsibilities as created by Chapter 83 of the Florida Statutes. Owner shall have the first right of renewal for the leased space. Notice of offer of renewal shall be sent to Owner by CRA in the form of an invoice prior to the expiration of the term of this agreement. Acceptance shall be made by payment of the invoice in the amount indicated. The right of Owner to occupy the leased slip shall continue on a month-to-month basis unless and until terminated as described in paragraph 25 of this agreement.
