On Tuesday, Novemeber 19, 2019, at approximately 0830 hours, Ofc. Ane and I, Ofc. Soza, were dispatched to Mcdonalds, located at 3704 N Roosevelt Blvd, in reference to a trespass.

Upon arrival I saw a white male, later identified as Bruce Furman. Furman was walking out of Mcdonalds, pushing the doors open in an aggressive manner. Ofc. Kouri was giving loud verbal commands, telling Furman to stop. Ofc. Kouri had her taser drawn and pointed at Furman while she continued to give him verbal commands. Furman did not stop and continued to walk away from Ofc. Kouri. A few seconds later, Furman turned towards Ofc. Kouri with his shoulders postured back and his fists clenched. Furman stopped, then continued to walk away from her again.

Ofc. Ane caught up to Furman and proceeded to perform a modified leg sweep. Ofc. Ane redirected Furman to the ground in order to get him under control. Ofc. Ane and Ofc. Kouri, placed Furman in handcuffs.

Ofc. Kouri told Ofc. Ane and I, when she arrived to Mcdonalds, she tried to wake Furman up from a table inside the dining area. Furman then stood up and tried to punch her in the face. Furman then walked outside, where we saw him leaving the restaurant. Ofc. Kouri was wearing her department issued Class B uniform and was easily identiable as a Law Enforcement Officer.

Ofc. Kouri advised Adelina Lawhorn and Pamelia Hersey were present inside of Mcdonad's when Furman tried to punch her. Ofc. Kouri collected statements from both. See supplemental.

Ofc. Ane notified Sgt. J. Dean to have his response to resistance documented. Furman advised he was uninjured and did not need medical attention.

Ofc. Ane and I transported Furman to MCDC.

Once at MCDC, I read Furman his Miranda Rights. Furman said he understood his rights and would speak to me without a lawyer present.

I asked Furman why he tried to punch Ofc. Kouri. Furman replied that he was sleeping. Ofc. Ane asked if he saw Ofc. Kouri dressed in a Class B uniform. Furman said he did not see it. Ofc. Ane asked why Furman was walking away from Ofc. Kouri and he replied he did not think he was doing anything wrong.

Bruce Furman refused to comply to Ofc. Kouri's lawful commands by walking away from her. Furman also tried to punch her in the face during the course of her investigation.

Ofc. Ane and I charged Furman with Assualt on a Law Enforcement Officer in violation of F.S. 784.07-2(a) and Resisting without Violence in violation of F.S. 843.02.

My department issued body warn camera was activated during this encounter and I later uplaoded it to evidence.com.

On November 19, 2019, I (Ofc. G Kouri), was dispatched to Mc Donalds, 3704 North Roosevelt Blvd, Key West, FL, in reference to a male subject refusing to leave.

Upon arrival, the employee pointed to a white male sitting at a table booth. I approached the male subject and introduced myself as an officer with the Key West Police Department. The subject looked up at me and began to stretch his arms above his head. I asked the subject if he had any ID with him. The male subject ignored me, so I asked him again. The male subject told me he did not, but he could give me his Pennsylvania drivers license that expired in 1995. I told the subject I did not care if it was expired but I wanted some form of Identification that had his name, date of birth and picture on it. The subject did not give me his ID. The subject then jumped up from the booth he was sitting in and attempted to punch me in the face with a closed fist. I moved my head in order to avoid being punched. The subject got out of his booth and started screaming "Ill hit you, Ill hit you". I removed my taser from my taser holster on my duty belt and pointed it at him. I gave loud verbal commands for the subject to back up. The subject turned away from me and started to walk out the door of McDonalds. I gave the subject loud verbal commands to "STOP". The subject turned away from me again and left McDonalds. The subject turned right and started to walk down a handicap ramp. I yelled at the subject to stop walking, however, he continued to walk away from me refusing to comply with my verbal commands. I keyed up on the main police channel and let them know the subject just attempted to punch me. I gave the subject more verbal commands to stop walking away from me and he turned around and started to walk towards me. I told the subject to back up as he was walking towards me. The subject began to yell at me that he was "hitting 90" and the rest of what he said was not understood. Ofc. Ane and Ofc. Soza arrived on scene. Ofc. Ane initiated a take down on the subject and we attempted to get handcuffs on him. The subject began to tense his arms up, however, we were able to get handcuffs on him.

Ofc. Ane and Ofc. Soza stayed with the subject while I went inside McDonalds to talk to witnesses. Margret Romero was inside in the line of McDonalds as this incident occurred. Romero told me there were two females inside who witnessed the whole encounter. I entered in McDonalds and approached one of the females who say the incident. The female was later identified by her Florida Drivers License as Adelina Lawhorn. Lawhorn stated she saw me walk in and ask the subject for ID twice. Lawhorn stated she then say the subject jump up towards me and yell at me that he was going to hit me as I backed away from him. Lawhorn stated she saw the subject begin to leave as I asked him not to. Lawhorn stated she then saw the male subject walking down the ramp and then begin to come at me again.

I spoke with the other female who is an employee at McDonalds. She was identified as Pamelia Hersey, by her Florida Drivers License. I asked Hersey if she saw what happened and Hersey was a bit shaken up. Hersey stated she was very scared. I explained to Hersey that it was okay, and no one was injured. Hersey told me the subject had been in the restaurant since 5 AM. Hersey stated he was asked to leave several times, however, he refused. Hersey stated she saw

me walk in and go speak with the subject. Hersey then stated she saw the subject try to punch me. Hersey said she saw the subject start walking towards me as I had him at taser point. Hersey stated the male subject walked out of McDonalds and I walked behind him.

Ofc. Ane and Ofc. Soza were primary on this call. I was dressed in my Class B uniform clearly representing the Key West Police Department as a Police Officer. I introduced myself to the subject as a Police Officer with the Key West Police Department. The subject did not give his proper identification to Ofc. Soza. The subject was transported to Monroe County Detention Center by Ofc. Ane and Ofc. Soza.

My body worn camera was active during my entire encounter with the subject. My body camera has been uploaded into Key West Police Property and Evidence under this case number.
