A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AWARDING THE BID OF CHARLEY TOPPINO & SONS, INC. RECEIVED IN RESPONSE TO INVITATION TO BID (ITB) #19-015 FOR DENNIS STREET STORM WATER PUMP STATION PROJECT (ST38021601) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,767,806.00; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING CITY THE MANAGER EXECUTE CONTRACT TO Α SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMANCE WITH THE BID UPON CONSENT PROPOSAL, OF THECITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City's stormwater master plan includes the historically flood-prone area of Dennis Street, between Venetia Street and Blanche Street near the Key West High School; and

WHEREAS, Black & Veatch was awarded the bid for design and construction phase services for the Dennis Street project, and the City worked with the Monroe County School District to obtain a necessary easement for the project to move forward; and

WHEREAS, due to ground conditions and the depth of the wells, an increase in funding was presented in the FY 2020 budget rate models and requested in the FY 2020

budget, and a bid extension to begin work after October 1 (FY 2020) was requested and received from all bidders; and

WHEREAS, two bids were received in response to ITB 19-015, with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. submitting the lowest bid; and

WHEREAS, City staff finds the lowest bid to be reasonable and responsible, and recommends award of the bid to Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. is hereby awarded in response to ITB 19-015 for Dennis Street Storm Water Pump Station, in an amount not to exceed \$2,767,806.00.

Section 2: That this project is funded in budget account 402-3803-538-6500 Utilities/Stormwater/Collections/Construction Project No. ST38021601, and any necessary budget adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract in substantial conformance with the bid documents upon consent of the City Attorney.
