AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 58 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED "SOLID WASTE" BY AMENDING SECTION 58-65 TO PROVIDE THAT THE RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE RATE SHALL ADJUSTED EACH YEAR BE BY RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that regular adjustments to solid waste rates promote the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Key West.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That Section 58-65 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows*:

Sec. 58-65. Residential Rates.

The annual solid waste charge levied upon residential units in the city for maximum solid waste collection, transfer, and disposal service shall be established each year by resolution of

the city commission.\$356.28 per year. This rate may be adjusted each October 1, by resolution of the city commission, by up to 100 percent of the percentage increase in the CPI-(U), U.S. City Averages (as of June). The city commission shall enact an ordinance amendment to this section in order to increase the rate in excess of the CPI.

<u>Section 2</u>: If any section, provision, clause, phrase, or application of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall be construed as reasonable and necessary to achieve the lawful purposes of this Ordinance.

Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of said City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby superseded to the extent of such conflict. <u>Section 4</u>: This Ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
