Re: December Monthly Report for Key West Historic Seaport

Key West Bight Operations:

- Bids received for piling replacement, staff will recommend award to lowest responsive bidder, Ebsary. Anticipate project start February 2020
- Second to last pour for seawall project to occur on 1/4. Anticipate punch list with substantial completion next week.
- Margaret Bathhouse to be complete January 2020.
- Harbor walk bathhouse project to follow above project.
- Anticipate fire main replacement project to start January 2020
- Anticipate FT mobile generator project to start January 2020
- Holiday Lighting a success, lights to be removed after second week of January
- Receiving quotes for transformer and pedestal replacement for H3 dock

Key West Bight Marina:

- December transient dockage down 17% compared to last December due to weather and smaller boats. Overall the marina is busier in monthly regular transient dockage this time last year.
- Fuel Sales are up 7% as we are attracting more commercial operators.
- Dinghy slip rentals are up 4% now that we are fully staffed and can monitor the dinghy docks better which leads to better enforcement and paid slip rentals.
- Replaced the high speed fuel hose at the Ferry Terminal.
- Started installing a different type of piling fenders at the Fuel Dock.
- The Ferry Terminal fire water line was replaced.
- Kearns Construction started the sea wall repair at the end of 201 William St.
- 15,085 Passengers passed through the Ferry Terminal this December compared to 13,280 last December.
