

## Adaptation

- **Water Supply Plan Update:** Met 12/16 with Planning Director and Building Official to discuss Adopting Miami Dade County's Water Fixtures Guidelines as an addendum to our Building Code = All are on board. We'll take it to management next.
- **Adaptation Planning Team:** Next meeting 1/17
  - **Last Meeting Recap:** 12/20: Team encouraged to not set a limit for needed adaptation projects for bonding. Place all into 10 year CIP plan. Pick 2-3 for design funding for FY20-21. The Stormwater Master Plan gets renewed this year and will provide better cost estimates. Discussed which non-picked LMS projects will be put forward for HMGP-Michael Funding. Tidal Valves have been added to Google Map.
  - **County:** LMS Meeting 11 25
  - **FEMA Flood Maps:** Maps are posted on the [City's Floodplain page](#). First round of comments have been turned in by all local governments. Next Maps were expected 12/27/19, with tentative outreach dates of 1/13-17/20, but have not been received
  - **NEA Grant:** NEA Cultural Plan will be presented to City Commission in Jan 22. Commissioner Hoover will report on EcoArt Field Trip report at same time.
  - **Compact Summit:** Videos are posted, but not as individual presentations, as each of three days (4-8 hours each). Will review and recommend to staff what to watch. O
  - **FEMA CRS:** Researching with Caroline Horn on ordinance workshop with County.

  - 1) Less Cars on Road: see Tim's report.
    - **Extra Lower Keys Shuttle:** Interlocal passed at City Commission; Marathon next. FDOT Contract for LKS needs to be increased to \$750K to receive our 50%. Need to put bus drivers back in TAF budget.
    - **Florida Keys Transportation Coordination Committee:** Working on Transportation 101 education pieces to bring new board up to speed.
  - 2) Reduce Energy Use:
    - Working with Johnnie on priorities, calendar planning and a future workshop. Commission asked if Johnnie could be tasked with more time for Energy Management. Going to put some energy/solar resolutions together to run past SAB in January for CC.
  - 3) Reduce Waste Stream:
    - Florida DEO Jobs/Infrastructure Grant: Will wait until Mallory clears to enter Glass/Compost app. Rolling deadline date.
