On 01/01/2020, at approximately 2312 hours Officer Leahy and I (Officer R.Perez), responded to assist Sgt. Siracuse in reference to a person with an active warrant.

Upon arrival, Sgt. Siracuse had a white male, later identified by his Florida ID as Manuel Milian-Barrera, in custody. Sgt. Siracuse said Milian-Barrera had fled during his arrest.

The following statement is Sgt. Siracuse's account of the arrest.

On 1/1/20, at approximately 2300 hours, I (Sgt. M. Siracuse) was traveling northbound on 17th Terrace, approaching the intersection of 17th Street. I was in my marked patrol vehicle equipped with emergency lights and a siren. As I approached the intersection, I observed a Hispanic male (Manuel Milian Barrera) cross the street in front of me. Barrera was on a black bicycle wearing khaki pants and a puffy green jacket. I recognized Barrera from numerous BOLOs (Be On the Lookout For) and I knew him to have active felony arrest warrants.

I turned my vehicle around and caught up to Barrera at the intersection of 17th Terrace and Northside Drive. Barrera had picked up speed on his bicycle and lost a sandal in the roadway. I knew Barrera was attempting to flee. I activated my emergency lights and siren and Barrera continued to pedal faster, westbound on Northside Drive, then northbound on 17th Street. Barrera ran both stop signs at 17th Terrace and Northside Drive and Northside Drive and 17th Street. Once on the 900 block of 17th Street, Barrera circled around a white pickup truck that was facing northbound on the east side of the roadway. Barrera doubled back and began traveling southbound on the 17th Street sidewalk. I jumped out of my patrol car and caught up to Barrera at the rear of the white truck. I tackled Barrera off the bicycle and into a chain link fence just beside him, bordering the front yard of 909 17th Street. We fell to the ground and I gave Barrera several clear, loud, verbal commands to place his hands behind his back. Barrera eventually placed his hands out to where I could see them, and I waited for backup.

Ofc. M. Hansell arrived on scene first and assisted me while placing Barrera in handcuffs.

Officers B. Leahy and R. Perez took custody of Barrera and processed him at the Monroe County Detention Center.

I had Ofc. Perez issue Barrera a criminal citation for flee/elude with lights and siren activated under my name.

Based on the facts and evidence I believe there is probable cause, that on 01/01/2020, Milian-Barrera knowingly and intentionally flee from Sgt Siracuse on a bike while Sgt Siracuse's vehicle lights and sirens were activated violating FSS 316.1935(2) flee/ attempt to elude LEO.

I issued Milian-Barrera a Florida Uniform Traffic Criminal Citation(#AC1J3SE). Milian-Barrera is to appear in front of the Honorable Judge Fowler on 01/16/2020 at 0900 hours.

Milian-Barrera is currently on felony probation for multiple narcotic related offenses. Milian-Barrero also had an active felony warrant for his arrest reference fleeing and eluding from law enforcement, which occurred two weeks ago.

I transported Milian-Barrera to Monroe County Detention Center.

The incident was captured on my AXON BWC and my in-car camera.
