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On 01/02/2020 at approximately 2300 hours, I, Officer Purcell, responded to 320-8A Angela St in reference to a female on the ground possibly not breathing.

Upon my arrival I observed Key West Fire Department Rescue assisting a white female (later identified as Rochelle Lacroix) to her feet. Rescue advised she was uninjured but highly intoxicated. I asked Lacroix where she was staying several times but only received the answer she wanted to go home. I explained to Lacroix I wanted to help her get home, but I needed to know where her home was in order to help. Lacroix continued to tell me she wanted to go home but would not tell me where she was staying. Rescue noticed a phone ringing in Lacroix's pocket and took it out. I answered the phone call and stated I was Officer Purcell with the Key West Police Department. A male (later identified as Oscar Tellez) answered, asking to speak with Lacroix. I informed Tellez that I was on the 300 block of Angela St with Lacroix who was very intoxicated. I asked Tellez if he was in Key West and could come take care of Lacroix. Tellez stated he was on Duval St and would come right away.

After several minutes Tellez came running down Angela St from the direction of Duval St. I informed Tellez that Lacroix was uninjured but needed to go home. Tellez took Lacroix by the arm and began to lead her away. I asked Tellez where they were staying and how they planned to get there. Tellez told me they were staying about three blocks away and wanted to walk Lacroix home. I told Tellez I didn't feel comfortable with Lacroix walking that far in her intoxicated state. Lacroix said fuck you I want to go home. Tellez turned and screamed at Lacroix to shut the fuck up and to treat me with respect. I asked Tellez to calm down. Sgt Vazquez and I lead Tellez and Lacroix to the corner of Angela St and Whitehead St. I informed Tellez I was going to call a cab to take them home. Tellez stated that was fine.

While waiting for the cab Tellez began to pace back and forth in an agitated manner. Lacroix continued to state she just wanted to go home. Tellez turned and screamed at Lacroix to shut the fuck up. I asked Lacroix if she felt comfortable going home with Tellez. Lacroix stated she would be ok. Tellez stopped pacing and began to walk south on Whitehead St then turned into the entryway of 702 Whitehead St (Cornish Memorial African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church) Tellez was obscured from my view but I hear two loud thuds that sounded as if Tellez had stuck the front door of the church with his fist or his foot. I asked Sgt Vazquez to watch Lacroix while I went to investigate what Tellez had struck.

Tellez started to walk away from the church as I approached. I instructed Tellez to follow me to the front door, so I could determine if he had caused any damage to the church. I asked Tellez what he hit. Tellez stated he didn't hit anything then said he hit himself. I told Tellez that the sound was from him striking a solid object not himself. Tellez continued to state he hit himself. I observed no damage to the church.

I lead Tellez back to the corner of Angela St and Whitehead St where Sgt Vazquez and I were approached by two members of the church who witnessed Tellez walk to the front door of the church. Rev. Rochelle Pearson and the other member of the church were extremely upset and told us they heard him kick their church. Sgt Vazquez and I both instructed Tellez and Lacroix to wait where they were while we attempted to calm Pearson and the other church member down. Sgt Vazquez tried to explain nothing on the church had been damaged so we could not charge Tellez with criminal mischief. I attempted to calm Pearson down to inform her we could arrest Tellez for disorderly conduct when Sgt Vazquez noticed Tellez and Lacroix had walked away.

I observed Tellez and Lacroix briskly walking west halfway up the 400 block of Angela St. I yelled at them to stop. Tellez and Lacroix continued to quickly walk away. I ran down Angela St with the intention to place Tellez under

arrest for disorderly conduct, and place Lacroix in protective custody as a Marchman Act. and caught up with Tellez And Lacroix. I took control of Tellez's arm, pushed him against the wall of a building, and instructing him to place his arms behind his back. I placed Tellez in handcuffs and took Lacroix by the arm. I escorted them back to the corner of Angela St and Whitehead St. Sgt Vazquez took control of Lacroix While I held Tellez. Tellez was squirming and complaining about the handcuffs when I caught movement out of the corner of my eye. I turned in time to see Lacroix cock her arm back and strike Sgt Vazquez on the left side of his face with a closed fist.

I assisted Sgt Vazquez forcing Lacroix onto the ground. Sgt Vazquez took control of Lacroix while I instructed Tellez to sit down. Tellez did not sit down. I instructed Tellez again to sit down. Tellez did not sit down. I forced Tellez into a sitting position by applying downward pressure on his handcuffs.

Sgt Vazquez requested an additional officer via radio. Officer Morris and Detective Sgt Stockton arrived on scene. Officer Morris helped take control of Lacroix who was screaming and thrashing on the ground while Detective Sgt Stockton came to assist me with Tellez. Tellez tried to pull away from me and I forced him into a prone position face down while Detective Sgt Stockton controlled his feet. Tellez and Lacroix were hobbled and placed into my patrol vehicle.

I spoke with Officer Morris who stated Lacroix kicked him in the left shoulder twice while he was trying to restrain her on the ground. Officer Morris was not injured.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause, that on 01/02/2020, Rochelle Nicole Lacroix did knowingly and intentionally strike Sgt Vazquez in the face with a closed fist and kick Officer Morris in the shoulder while they were performing their lawful duties, in violation of FSS 784.07-2B.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause, that on 01/02/2020, Oscar Abraham Tellez did knowingly and intentionally resist a sworn law enforcement officer in the performance of his duties, in violation of FSS 843.02. I also believe there is probable cause, that on 01/02/2020, Oscar Abraham Tellez did Knowingly commit an act to corrupt public morals and outrage the sense of public decency by striking a church in the presence of its patrons, in violation of FSS 877.03.

I transported Tellez and Lacroix to the Monroe County Detention Center without incident.

Pearson provided a written statement of the events she witnessed.

Officer Morris took photographs of the abrasions on Lacroix's knees and the red handcuff marks on Tellez's wrists. I took a photograph of the bruising beginning to form next to Sgt Vazquez's eye.

This investigation was recorded with my Axon BWC.

On January 2nd 2020, at about 2256 hours, I Sgt. Vazquez responded to 320 Angela Street for a medical call. The caller stated a female was unconscious and lying in an unnatural position.

Upon arrival, I observed Ofc. Purcell and KWFD speaking with a female later identified as Rochelle Lacroix. Lacroix appeared to be highly intoxicated, and argumentative. While speaking with Lacroix her phone rang with the name "Babe" Ofc. Purcell answered the phone and instructed the caller, to respond to Angela and Whitehead Street. The plan was for the caller (Babe) to respond and we would decide if the caller was a responsible party to take care of Lacroix.

A few minutes later a Hispanic male (Babe), later identified as Oscar Tellez arrived on scene. Tellez, Lacroix and I, began to walk to Angela and Whitehead Street, so we could wait for a taxi. While waiting for the taxi, Tellez walked to the church located at 702 Whitehead St., and struck the door, with an unknown object. The noise was loud enough to grab our attention as well as the Reverend of the church. The Reverend of the church became irate and wished to pursue charges for the alleged damage to the door. It appeared the door was not damaged, However their peace and quiet was disturbed and they wished to pursue charges for disorderly conduct. While trying to calm down the Reverend and another witness, Lacroix and Tellez, began to flee on foot. Ofc. Purcell caught up to Tellez, and Lacroix, and brought them back to Angela and Whitehead St.

I left the irate Reverend, to assist Ofc. Purcell. Ofc. Purcell already placed Tellez in custody (Disorderly Conduct). Tellez appeared to be irate and visibly upset. Without warning, Lacroix closed her right fist and punched me in my left eye. I swiftly grabbed Lacroix left arm and did a modified takedown to gain control of the physically resisting Lacroix. Once on the ground, I was able to place Lacroix in handcuffs. I asked the units that were responding to expedite due to the scene rapidly deteriorating. Other officers arrived on scene, and both Lacroix were physically restrained using a Hobble restraint. Ofc. Purcell transported both Lacroix and Tellez to the MCDC without further incident.

My left eye sustained slight bruising. Ofc. Purcell took a photograph using AXON capture.

My BWC was activated.

I hereby state the following: White Officer Vasquez was speaking to myself and Mr. McEntyre - visitor to Key West. Officer Purcell attempted to stop the male down.
