On January 27, 2020 at 2314 hours Ofc, Tellier and I (Ofc, Wynn) responded to a call at 5537 College Rd. (Keys Overnight Temporary Shelter - KOTS) in reference to a trespasser. KOTS had a client that needed to be removed for aggressive behavior. Ofc. Mogerley was the primary officer on the call. Ofc. Gillespie assisted.

A monitor at KOTS called dispatch and stated that a subject, later identified by his Florida Driver's License as Michael Engle, was refused entry to KOTS for being highly intoxicated. The staff at KOTS reported that, as Engle was leaving the property, he attempted to damage a fence and a security keypad at the neighboring Sunset Marina (5555 College Rd).

A second caller, Ryan Cross, from the apartment complex at Sunset Marina, stated that Engle was sitting outside the complex. Cross stated that he had seen Engle break and destroy the front gate to the Sunset Marina parking garage.

Ofc. Mogerley arrived first and had the suspect detained before we arrived. Ofc. Mogerley met with Cross and Cross provided him with a video of Engle breaking the gate.

Engle was detained in handcuffs sitting on the curb. Engle was instructed to stand up by myself and Ofc. Gillespie multiple times. Engle refused each time. Engle laid back and tensed his body (actively resisting). Ofc. Gillespie and I stood Engle up, at which point Engle refused to walk, making his legs go limp, to where we had to almost carry him to the patrol car (passively resisting). Ofc. Gillespie and I escorted Engle to the car, holding him up while he dragged his feet. Engle refused to get in my patrol car and began tensing his upper body and his legs (actively resisting).

Engle was warned by Ofc. Tellier, that if he did not comply with the lawful order to get into the patrol car, we would have to use force on him due to his continued resistance, and possibly TASE him in order to gain compliance. Engle was finally placed in the patrol car, but as soon as he sat down he tensed his lower body, making getting his legs in the car impossible. I ordered Engle to get his legs in the car multiple times. He reused and I began to push on Engle's legs in order to get them inside the door. Engle kicked me, mid-chest, with enough force to push me back with his right leg. Engle tried to push me off with his left while I was attempting to get him fully into the car (aggressively resisting). Ofc. Tellier deployed his TASER (cartridge off drive stun) to Engle's lower, right ribcage. Engle stopped kicking me and complied with our loud verbal commands to put his legs in the car.

Sgt. Sims was notified of the response to resistance and responded to the scene. Sgt. Sims requested an ambulance to the scene in case any injuries needed to be addressed. Pictures of the TASER signature marks were taken. Engle was medically evaluated and cleared by Rescue.

Engle was transported to Monroe County Detention Center. Engle continued resisting officers while escorting him to intake. While in the elevator he was pulling away from us and tried to turn to face us. Once we reached intake Engle was verbally abusive and combative with jail personnel.

Ofc. Gillispie interviewed property manager, Mayra Meckel. Meckel works for property owner Pelagic Property Management. Meckel stated that the estimated damage for parts and labor to fix the gate was \$1000. Meckel stated she wanted to press charges on behalf of the business.

During this call I was wearing my standard issue, Key West Police Department Class B patrol uniform and driving a marked patrol vehicle.

On 01/27/2020, at approximately 2301 hours, I (Officer Gillespie) responded to 5555 College Rd. in reference to a possible criminal mischief incident.

Upon arrival, I met with Officer Tellier and Trainee Wynn who had already arrived on scene. I observed an older white male sitting on the curb in handcuffs (later identified as Michael Patrick Engle). I stood with Engle while Officer Tellier and Wynn conducted their investigation.

I assisted Wynn with placing Engle into the rear of his patrol car. I instructed Engle to stand up, Engle refused. I had to assist Engle to the car by lifting him by his left arm. Once inside the vehicle, Wynn was attempting to seatbelt Engle inside the vehicle, when Engle knowingly and intentionally kicked Wynn in the chest with his right leg, then pushed Wynn in the chest with his left leg. Officer Tellier gave loud verbal commands for Engle to comply, or he would be Tased but Engle would not. I observed Officer Tellier drive stun Engle in an attempt to persuade him to stop resisting and get into the vehicle.

I activated my BWC during this incident.
