On Thursday, June 20, 2019 at approximately 0937 hours, Key West Police Department Communications Center received a call from Steven Legnaioli.

Legnaioli stated he wanted an officer to go to a scooter/electric car rental center and obtain the insurance information for the company due to an unreported crash that Legnaioli was involved in approximately two and a half months ago.

Legnaioli stated he was "attacked" by an employee and he will "shoot him in the face" if he were to "attack" him again. It is unknown if the allegations of an attack occurred.

Legnaioli, at first contact, was civil, but as soon as I informed him of the 10 day reporting requirement for crashes, turned volatile and began calling me a moron and telling me how I was wrong. Legnaioli again reiterated his earlier statements to KWPD Dispatch by saying he would "shoot him in the face" if he were to attack him.

The encounter ended with Legnaioli yelling profanities at myself, Ofc. K. Beerbower, and Sgt. F. Duponty, and then entering his residence.

I met with Sgt. F. Duponty and informed him of my desire to pursue a Risk Protection Order (RPO) based upon Legnaioli's statements and the propensity for continued and evolving actions/statements from such.

I completed an affidavit and an ex parte RPO and met with the Honorable Judge Wilson for a hearing. Judge Wilson signed/approved the ex parte RPO.

I, along with Ofc. B. Vazquez, Ofc. I. Kasyanenko, and Sgt. F. Duponty, made contact with Legnaioli at his residence. Legnaioli refused to exit his yard and spoke to us through a fence while video recording and on the phone with who I believed to be his attorney.

After much conversation, Legnaioli ultimately signed the KWPD form accepting the RPO and understood that he must appear for the next hearing, scheduled for June 25, 2019, and for a later hearing, on July 3, 2019.

Legnaioli refused to allow the KWPD to search his residence in compliance with the RPO.

At this time, there is no probable cause for a search warrant to enter Legnaioli's residence.

I completed the provided form showing a return of service for the Monroe County Clerk's Office. I turned the form over to Det. M. Delvalle to turn into the Clerk's Office as I was not scheduled to work on Friday, June 21, 2019.

Upon completion of the RPO and all it entails (the original paperwork), it will be turned into KWPD Records.

My AXON BWC and my COBAN were activated for the above listed events.

I sent a department wide email containing a BOLO of Legnaioli and the RPO.

Nothing further at this time.

The Monroe County Offices were closed at this time, so Officer Rodriquez gave me the completed form showing a return of service for the Monroe County Clerk's Office. Officer Rodriquez also provided me with a Notice of Risk of Violence form. Officer Rodriquez informed me that Legnaioli's wife Danielle Legnaioili lived with him, so a Notice of Risk of violence form needed to be delivered to her.

Detective Peters and I went to two different address where it was thought she worked, contact was not made with her. At 2:33 P.M Detective Medina spoke to Danielle by phone and explained to her that we needed to meet with her to deliver her paperwork that was related to the RPO that was given to her husband. Danielle informed him that she was at home and she could meet with us.

At 2:40 P.M. Detective Medina called Danielle and asked her to meet us outside her residence, Danielle told him she left the house and was at a customer's house. Detective Medina asked Danielle if we could meet her at her current location and she said she didn't want the police at her customers house.

Currently due to Danielle's conflicting schedule I was not able to hand her the NRV Form. The Return of service was taken to the MCSO warrants office.
