**A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR
AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT
AGENCY (CRA) APPROVING A CHANGE ORDER FOR
ADDITIONAL DOCK REPAIRS TO EBSARY FOUNDATION
COMPANY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$85,300.00,
PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-845 OF THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET
ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON ADVICE AND
CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 20-052 a contract was awarded to Ebsary Foundation Company for Dock Repair & Piling Replacement at the Key West Historic Seaport, in response to ITB #20-005; and

WHEREAS, a need for additional work that appears to be a residual effect of past storm events was discovered during construction, and staff recommends approval of a Change Order to complete the work while the contractor is on site, to save the cost of remobilization for the additional repairs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached Change Order, as provided for under Section 2-845 of the Code of Ordinances, in an amount not to exceed \$85,300.00 for additional work required for dock repair at the Key West Historic Seaport, under the contract awarded to Ebsary Foundation Company in Resolution 20-052, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That funds for this change order are available in Key West Bight Fund/Marina Operations/Infrastructure account #405-7503-757-6300 (Project KB1505). Upon approval, a change order in the amount of \$85,300.00 will be issued to PO #91627, and any necessary budget adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents to approve the change order upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect

immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
