On 2/6/2020, at approximately 2130 hours, I (Sgt. M. Siracuse) responded to the parking lot behind the San Carlos building, located at (516 Duval Street).

This area has become a local "hangout" for vagrants who are trespassing, drinking, and fighting. In response to these issues, the establishment has granted the KWPd authority to trespass individuals from the property. Additionally, they have posted numerous "No Trespassing / KWPd Authorization to trespass" signs throughout the area.

Earlier the same night, numerous officers, including myself, responded to this location in reference to a large fight with individuals who had armed themselves with pocket knives. At the conclusion of that investigation, at exactly 1931 hours, I approached three individuals involved in the incident (Jessica Minton, Jeremy Vallies, and Patrick Mulvey), and explained the trespassing laws and issued all of them warnings for being on the property. This was recorded on my BWC.

Approximately three hours later, as I walked onto the property for a separate call reference trespassers on the property, I observed Minton and Vallies standing just inside the parking lot, only few feet from a no trespassing sign.

I activated my BWC and placed Vallies in handcuffs. I had Vallies sit on the curb just beside us. Minton had a bag slung over her shoulder and I asked her to remove the bag prior to me detaining her. Minton refused and began arguing with me. I gave Minton several clear, loud, verbal commands to place her hands behind her back and she refused. Minton started repeating, "No, No, No," I reached for Minton's left wrist and she pulled her arm back, keeping me from taking hold of her arm. I deployed pepper spray and sprayed Minton in the face. Once sprayed, I was able to place Minton in handcuffs with little resistance. Ofc. M. Hansell and I walked both subjects over to an additional three subjects detained for a separate reason.

When I got to where the other subjects were sitting, I observed Mulvey as one of the individuals. Having just trespass warned Mulvey along with Minton and Vallies, I placed Mulvey in handcuffs as well.

After officers conducted searches of all persons and their belongings, I walked all three to the KWPd transport van. Once at the van, Mulvey refused to go sit inside. I gave Mulvey command after command to get inside the van and sit down. Mulvey continued arguing with me, ignoring my commands. Eventually I was able to talk Mulvey into sitting in the van. Once inside the Van, Mulvey refused to sit straight so I could seat belt him. I pushed Mulvey to the side and attempted to belt him, however he was too large to get belted.

Mulvey, Vallies, and Minton did trespass on a property other than a structure or conveyance. They were not authorized, licensed, or invited onto the property, and notice was given by posting, fencing, and actual communication by myself to stay off the property. Their actions violated F.S.S. 810.09(1)(a)(1).

Minton and Mulvey resisted and opposed a law enforcement officer (myself), during the legal execution of my duty. Minton and Mulvey's actions violated F.S.S. 843.02.

I photographed the area, the sign that was posted, and Minton for a response to resistance incident report. Minton did not sustain any injuries.

Woodruff continued to state "I'll be out tomorrow and I'll see you" and asked if that was a threat and Woodruff responded "Its a Promise". Right before all the arrested subjects were transported Woodruff stated "Yea and ill see you tomorrow, I'll kill you"

Woodruff knowingly and intentionally threatened Officer Malak's life by saying he will kill him. Woodruff will be charged with FSS 838.021 Corruption by threat against public servant.

When I arrived I learned Sgt. Siracuse had pepper sprayed one female. Sgt. Siracuse had another officer with him, so I went to help Ofc. Hansell who had detained three other people. A total of five people were detained for various reasons. Each were handcuffed and double locked.

I assisted in searching a total of four persons. While searching the pockets of a female, Dominic, I found a multi colored smoking pipe in her right front shorts pocket. This information was relayed to Ofc. Hansell for charging purposes.

My BWC was activated during this call and later uploaded. I also completed the RRI paperwork for Sgt. Siracuse.

On 02-06-2020 @ 20:39hrs. I k-9 Ofc. Matthew Hansell of the Key West Police Department, responded to the city pay parking lot located at 409 Appleruth Lane, in reference to an ongoing trespass issue.

Notes provided by dispatch indicated several subjects, who had caused a disturbance earlier in the day were back in the parking lot near a silver pick up truck.

I arrived in the area and pulled into the lot from Fleming St. in my fully marked Key West Police K-9 patrol vehicle. I saw three subjects next to the open driver side door of a silver pickup truck.

One of the subjects Myers Woodruff, was sitting in the driver seat with his feet out the door next to a female Dominique Vallejo, who was facing Woodruff.

As I exited my patrol vehicle, I watched Woodruff attempt to hand Vallejo a clear bag with a green leafy substance I knew to be marijuana based on my training and experience.

Woodruff looked over in my direction and clutched the bag in his right hand as I approached. I had Woodruff drop the bag and walk to the back of the truck along with Vallejo and a third subject Patrick Mulvey.

Mulvey, who was still wearing his Monroe County Jail shorts, stated he did not know what was going on and said he needed to catch a Gray Hound Bus out of the city per Judge Wilson`s orders.

Sgt. Sims and additional officers arrived on scene. I handcuffed Woodruff and Vallejo.

I conducted a K-9 sniff of the truck using K-9 Dexter, who gave an alert to the presence and or odor of narcotics coming from the vehicle. I conducted a search of the vehicle and located the bag containing the marijuana on the driver seat floor board. The marijuana was later field tested positive and later placed into evidence.

Sgt. Sims located a glass marijuana pipe with marijuana residue in the side pocket of Vallejo. Ofc. Wynn and Ofc. Malak took all subjects and placed them into the transport van to be taken to the Monroe County Jail.

Sgt. Siracuse charged three of the subjects with trespassing. I charged Woodruff with possession of marijuana under 20 grams. I charged Vallejo with possession of drug paraphernalia.

My Axon camera was used for this incident.
