On 02/18/2020 at approximately 2300 hours, Officer K. Waite and I (Ofc. A. Litton) were dispatched to the area of 200 Whitehead Street in reference to a subject sleeping on the sidewalk, under a black blanket.

When I arrived, I located two subjects sleeping in front of 215 Whitehead Street. A woman in a black hooded sweatshirt was sleeping on top of an unknown, shirtless male. I immediately identified the woman as Sara Finamore because I encountered her the night before.

On 02/17/2020 at approximately 2300 hours. I found Finamore under similar circumstances, asleep on the sidewalk, on a blanket, with multiple bags surrounding her. The bags were filled with clothes, food, personal belongings, and alcohol. Finamore was informed and issued warnings for the city ordinances she was violating. Finamore was informed she is subject to arrest if she violated the ordinances again.

Finamore was sleeping on top of Gerald White. Both subjects were surrounded by bags that contained visible, clothes, food and an opened bottle of vodka. Before we woke them up, I informed Officer Waite that Finamore would be placed under arrest because I informed her of the ordinances the night before. After they woke, the male was identified as Gerald White who received a camping warning from Officer M. Brable on 11/25/2019. I informed Officer Waite of the warning and that both offenders were going to be arrested.

Officer Waite stated very clear and precise instructions for White and Finamore to stand up, face away from the officers, and place their hands on the wall behind them. White slowly stood up and would not place his hands on the wall while saying "Fuck you." Officer Waite and I quickly placed White in handcuffs and I took control of him, so he would not have the chance to fight or flee.

As I held White, Officer Waite proceeded to place handcuffs on Finamore, who would not place her hands on the wall. Officer Waite grabbed Finamore by the wrist to place her in handcuffs. Finamore pulled her arm away and spun around to face Officer Waite. So she would not further resist or offer violence, Officer Waite took Finamore to the ground with a take-down to place her in handcuffs.

I transported White to my patrol vehicle and sat him inside without incident. I then assisted Officer Waite with Finamore, who continued to resist Officer Waite's efforts to place her in his patrol vehicle. Finamore refused to enter the vehicle and would not follow instructions needed for us to affect an arrest. Finamore was eventually placed into the patrol vehicle and transported to MCDC without further incident. Finamore's property was searched and placed into Key West Police Property for safekeeping. White was transported to MCDC without incident.

Based on the circumstance the subject was found, Gerald White violated municipal ordinance 62-4, camping in a public place. White was asleep on the sidewalk, with a habitat established around him. Among the items around him were necessary items for survival including food, beverages and clothing. White was not wearing a shirt but used Sara Finamore for comfort and warmth as he slept. White exhibited an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath and was in the constructive possession of a bottle of vodka.

Based on her actions and the circumstance the subject was found, Sara Finamore violated FSS 843.02, resisting an officer without violence, when she resisted Officer K. Waite's efforts to affect an arrest for a violated city ordinance. Finamore tensed her body and pulled away from Officer Waite as he attempted to put her in handcuffs, forcing Officer Waite to use a take-down tactic. Finamore then resisted Officer Waite's efforts to place her in his vehicle by tensing her body and refusing to enter the vehicle.

Based on the circumstance the subject was found, Sara Finamore violated municipal ordinance 62-4, camping in a public place. Finamore was asleep on the sidewalk, with a habitat established with her belongings. Finamore's belongings contained necessary items for survival including food, beverages and clothing. All belongings were in her possession as she used Gerald White for her protection and comfort from the ground.

On February 19, 2020, I, Ofc. Waite, was dispatched to 215 Whitehead Street as backup for Ofc. Litton who was out with two subjects sleeping on the sidewalk. On arrival, I observed a female, identified later as Sara Finamore, laying over the top of a male subject, identified later as Gerald White. Both Finamore and White were asleep and had various bags and personal belongings strewn around them. Ofc. Litton told me he recognized Finamore from a previous encounter in which he issued her a camping warning.

Ofc. Litton and I awoke Finamore and White and gathered their identification. Both subjects appeared to be disoriented and were slow to respond to our verbal commands. Ofc. Litton returned to his vehicle to run Finamore and White for warrants and prior camping warnings. While Ofc. Litton was away, White stated he was not camping and said, "I'm not going anywhere!" which I interpreted to mean he was not going to be taken to jail.

Ofc. Litton returned and signaled to me that both White and Finamore had prior camping warnings and were going to be arrested. Keeping in mind that White had just said "I'm not going anywhere!", I gave him and Finamore clear and simple commands to deter resistance. The sidewalk area in which White and Finamore were laying down butted up to a small footwall at the adjoining property. I instructed White and Finamore to stand up, face away from Ofc. Litton and I and place their hands on the footwall. With their hands on the footwall, White and Finamore would be off balance if they began resisting. White stood up first and said, "You all suck ass!". I instructed White to place his hands on the wall and he said, "Fuck you dude!" then turned around to face me. Ofc. Litton and I grabbed White by the arms and placed him into handcuffs. While handcuffing White, Finamore told me "You can't arrest me! You can't handcuff me! I didn't do anything!". I instructed Finamore to place her hands on the wall. I approached Finamore, grabbed her left wrist and attempted to place her into handcuffs. Finamore violently pulled away from me, knocking my bodycam off of its mount with her left elbow, and said "let go!".

Finamore displayed active resistance, making physically evasive movements to defeat my attempts at control by pulling her left arm away from me as I attempted to handcuff her. Finamore then escalated from active resistance to aggressive resistance, making attacking movements likely to cause injury, by hitting me in the left chest with her elbow. Due to Finamore's escalating resistance, I took her to the ground, using a modified armbar takedown maneuver, to limit her physical resistance while I placed her into handcuffs. While on the ground, Finamore continued to actively resist, flailing her arms around to avoid being handcuffed.

Once in handcuffs, I stood Finamore up and walked her to my patrol vehicle. Upon searching Finamore, I instructed her to take a seat in the back of my patrol vehicle. Finamore refused to enter my vehicle. After instructing Finamore for nearly a minute to enter my patrol vehicle, I told her if she did not get in, she would be tased. Finamore immediately entered my vehicle.
