On 03/10/2020 2216 hours, I was dispatched to 2610 Flagler Ave. for a battery.

When I arrived, I was approached by Maher Aballa C (later identified by a FL DL) who told me he was beat up and robbed. In talking to Alagal I discovered that he was from out of town and was staying with friends. Alagal stated that he met a girl later identified as [REDACTED] on Duval St. the night before. Alagal arranged through Snapchat to meet [REDACTED] the following night. Alagal said that [REDACTED] picked him up at CVS in a gray Toyota Corolla and they went to Government Rd. Alagal was unsure how far down Government Rd. they drove.

When [REDACTED] put the car in park two unknown males, one wearing a black hoodie and the other wearing a red hoodie pulled him out of the car and proceeded to beat him. Alagal told me he fell to the ground and covered his face as the males continued to beat him. Once the males stopped one of them grabbed his phone and they both ran off. Alagal also said he was missing his silver chain with charm and his sunglasses which he said he left in [REDACTED] car. The males then got into what Alagal described as a black or dark color regular pickup truck and drove off.

Alagal did not see the truck until they started to leave and did not know if there was anyone else in the truck. Alagal told me that [REDACTED] left the scene the same time the truck left. When the truck and [REDACTED] left Alagal did not know where he was and ran after the them because he figured that was the way out.

Once Alagal reached Flagler he started to try and flag down cars for help. Once he was in the vicinity of Peace Covenant Church, Michael Alfanzo stopped and helped him.

In talking to Alfanzo, Alagal mentioned [REDACTED] name. Alfanzo said he thought he knew her and was able to pull a picture of her up on his phone from a social media site. Alagal positively identified [REDACTED] as the driver of the Corolla. Sgt Siracuse was also able to pull her information up through Driver and Vehicle Identification Database (DAVID) which had another picture of [REDACTED]. Alagal again identified [REDACTED] as the driver of the Corolla. Through DAVID Sgt. Siracuse was able to find the license for the Corolla and [REDACTED] address. Lt. Wood, Ofc. Tellier Ofc. Hudson went to [REDACTED] where they found the car.

While this was going on Alfanzo and Alagal were able to login to Alagal's Find My Phone account using Alfanzo's phone. The phone showed up at 316 Julia St. Sgt Siracuse sent an Ofc. Mogerly to the house to attempt to retrieve the phone. Once Ofc. Mogerly retrieved the phone for the female at the house (later identified as Kristine Woldanski). We were able to identify the phone by the passcode given by Alagal. Ofc. Mogerly brought the phone to our location. When Alagal unlocked the phone he noticed the SIM card had been removed and some of the settings had been changed. His recent call were still on the phone and he was able to call his friend using my phone and get his address 1634 Flagler Ave.

I took Alagal to the house on Flagler and dropped him off. I gave Alagal one of my business cards with this case number on it.

After I dropped Alagal off, I went to the house on Julia St. When I arrived all the residents in the house were in custody. I took Peter R. Woldanski and searched him. He was then placed into the KWPD van.

I remained at the house with the other officers and awaited the arrival of the detectives. When the detectives arrived the decision was made to get a search warrant to search the house for the rest of the items.

On March 10, 2020, I (Ofc. Mogerley) assisted Officers on a robbery call (case number 20-001589). They had a stolen iPhone that was pinging to the location of 316 Julia Street. Ofc. Gillespie, Ofc. Dantu, and I searched the area. I checked with the neighbors, and the male at 318 Julia Street said that the woman who lives at 316 Julia Street has kids that fit the description staying in that house.

I knocked on the door of 316 Julia Street and spoke to a Kristine Woldanski and explained to her that we had a stolen phone tracking back to this house. Kristine said her son [REDACTED] was upstairs in the bedroom. She closed the door and went inside the house. She came out with the stolen phone and gave it to me. She told me that one of [REDACTED] friends left it in his room. Kristine refused to let me talk to her son and told me to call her lawyer. We verified that it was the stolen phone by putting the owner's password in it and it worked. I drove the phone over to Ofc. Roscoe.

Sgt. Siracuse asked me to come back to the house and said that we will be clearing the house to apply for a search warrant. I knocked on the door and window. Kristine came to the door. I explained to her what was going on and she was not complying. I went to place her into handcuffs, and she was resisting by pulling her arms away and we had to put her against the wall to handcuff her. Three males came charging down the stairs at us and the one later identified as [REDACTED] started screaming at us for handcuffing his mom and aggressively charged at us. Sgt. Siracuse went to place him into handcuffs and he was resisting. I had to turn my attention to the two other males on the stairwell who were getting very aggressive toward us. Sgt. Siracuse had to pepper spray [REDACTED]. I had to yell at the two males Peter Woldanski and [REDACTED] to sit down. I placed Peter into handcuffs without incident. [REDACTED] started to run up the stairs and I grabbed his arms to handcuff him and he started to pull away. He was given orders to stop resisting. He turned his body and started to sit down. I had to place [REDACTED] against the wall and pull his arms back to handcuff him. When walking [REDACTED] down the stairs he started to pull away from me and I had to pull him back and place him against the railing to gain control of him. All persons were escorted out of the house and the house was cleared. Sgt. Siracuse called in detectives to write a warrant for the house.

On 03/10/2020 at 2216 hours I, (Ofc. J. Tellier) responded to 2610 Flagler Ave. (Peace Covenant Church) as Ofc. Roscoe's backup, for an unknown problem. The caller stated he was out with a male who had been beaten up.

Upon my arrival, I made contact with the victim Maher Alagal and the caller Michael. Alagal stated he was visiting Key West for Spring Break and met a girl (later identified as [REDACTED]) on Snapchat the previous day. Alagal stated [REDACTED] picked him up in her car (later identified as Florida tag LRXQ85) and took him to Government Road. Government Road is a long stretch of road which parallels the Key West International Airport. There are no houses or streets lights.

Alagal stated that as soon as [REDACTED] stopped the car and put it in park, two males wearing hooded sweatshirts, open the passenger door, pull him out of the vehicle, and began beating him. He stated the two males left the scene and so did [REDACTED]. He stated he wandered back to Flagler Avenue for help, which is when Michael saw him and stopped. Alagal stated the two males got away with his brand new cell phone (bought the previous day) and a sterling silver necklace that had an alligator pendant on the end. He still had his wallet and all his cash with him on scene.

Michael stated he might know who [REDACTED] was and helped identify her by her Instagram account. He stated they both attend the same high school (Key West High School). Alagal described [REDACTED] car as a grey/silver Toyota four door.

Using DAVID, Sgt. Siracuse (who was also on scene) was able to identify [REDACTED] and her vehicle. Alagal had cuts and scrapes to his face. He had blood on his hands and complained of possibly having a broken finger. An ambulance was requested to treat Alagal's injuries.

The address for the vehicle came back to 3314 Northside Drive Unit 61 (Solanna Village). I drove to that location, and located the vehicle parked in front of Unit 61. The car was backed in so the tag wasn't visible from the street. The tag matched the vehicle officers were looking for.

Ofc. Hudson arrived as my backup, while I made contact with the residents. He knocked on the door and [REDACTED] mother answered. I asked if [REDACTED] was home, and she called her daughter. Once outside I told [REDACTED] why we were there. She seemed hesitant to speak with me. I examined the exterior of her car for any evidence. I obtained consent from [REDACTED] to search the car. I found no stolen property or evidence inside the car. [REDACTED] stated she was frightened by the attack, screamed and drove away, leaving Alagal alone, lost and in the dark. She was unable to provide description of the male suspects, other than they were "fat big".

On 03/10/202, at approximately 2256 hours, I (Officer Gillespie) responded as a back up unit to 316 Julia St. in reference to a Robbery incident.

Upon arrival, Officer Mogerley was already on scene. Officer Mogerley and I approached the home to make contact. We were able to make contact with Kristine Anne Woldanski (Home Owner). Officer Mogerley asked most of the questions. I observed Woldanski to be very guarded with her answers. Woldanski changed her story several times when asked specifics about what had happened this evening. I observed Woldanski to say her son [REDACTED] was home in bed because he had school in the morning. When questioned about the stolen phone and that it was actively pinging to her home, Woldanski said she knew nothing about a phone. Woldanski advised she would not wake up her son to come speak to us because the last time [REDACTED] spoke to a cop, he was arrested. Woldanski finally agreed to check inside her home for the stolen cell phone. Woldanski advised she went to [REDACTED] room, picked up a phone and asked him who's phone she was holding in her hand. [REDACTED] reply was "mine". Woldanski advised she picked up a second phone and asked who's phone this one was, and [REDACTED] said he didn't know and that one of his friends dropped it off to him. Woldanski would not let us speak to [REDACTED]. While on scene Officer Mogerley and I made contact with the victim and asked him what the 4-digit code was to open his phone. The victim advised the code, I entered it into the phone, and it worked, confirming this was the stolen phone.

I left the scene. I was later called and instructed to return to the scene in order to retrieve the SYM card that was missing from the stolen phone. I approached the home in my patrol car and waited outside for back up to arrive. I observed a white female (later identified as Katrina Rose Ognian) exit the front of the home. I stopped her and identified her. Ognian advised she was inside the home while Officer Mogerley were on scene the first time.

I was guarding the rear door of the home when other officers gained entry to the home. I heard loud noises coming from inside the home, so I left the rear of the home, went to the front and entered the home. I escorted [REDACTED] outside, to my car, and placed him inside and activated my in car camera.

After the home was cleared, I remained on scene until I was relieved by day shift.

I activated my BWC during this incident.

On 3/10/2020, I (Sgt. M. Siracuse) along with Officers Roscoe and Tellier, responded to the intersection of 8th Street and Flagler Avenue, reference an individual yelling in the street.

Upon arrival, I met with the victim, Maher Alagal, who said he was robbed on Government Road. Alagal said he had met a white female (later identified as [REDACTED]), the night before while on spring break on Duval Street. Alagal said he exchanged snapchat names with [REDACTED] and kept in touch with her. Alagal said tonight, [REDACTED] picked him up and told him she was going to take him to Government Road to hang out. Alagal said once on Government Road, [REDACTED] put the car in park and his door opened. Alagal said two males jumped him and took his stuff.

Alagal was visibly shaken and had difficulty describing the suspects. Alagal said one was wearing a red hoodie and the other a black hoodie. Alagal believed the suspects may have been black because they kept saying, "Nigga." Alagal had been punched in the face and had contusion under his left eye. Alagal said the suspects stole his chain, cell phone, and sunglasses.

Alagal knew the female's name [REDACTED] and the caller (unrelated party driving by who stopped to help), personally knew [REDACTED]. The caller pulled up a photograph of [REDACTED] from Instagram and Alagal immediately identified that as the female he believed set him up. I found [REDACTED] on DAVID and it was clear her photograph matched the one provided to Alagal. [REDACTED] had an address of 3314 Northside Drive, apartment 61. I had KWPD communications check out CAD system to see if [REDACTED] had any history. Communications informed me [REDACTED] was previously stopped driving a 2017 gray Toyota Corolla, bearing FL tag LRXQ85. This vehicle matched the description provided by Alagal. I retrieved a photograph of the suspect vehicle off the Cintel LPR system and Alagal confirmed that was the vehicle he was picked up in.

Officers Tellier, Hudson, and Lt. H. Wood responded to [REDACTED]'s home on Northside Drive and located the gray Toyota backed into the driveway. At the same time, Alagal was able to ping his stolen cell phone using the Apple "find my phone" app. And the ping showed the phone at 316 Julia Street. I spoke with [REDACTED] at her residence after her parents gave me permission. [REDACTED] had initially told Officers she had no involvement with the robbery, and that Alagal was pulled from the car, robbed, and she left the area because she was scared. [REDACTED] never called the police for help, and left Alagal on Government Road.

I asked [REDACTED] to see her cell phone. [REDACTED] allowed me to look at her phone and handed it to me. I immediately noticed all text messages and phone calls surrounding the time the incident occurred had been deleted. I did notice a new text message from '[REDACTED]' at (305-834-6387). This text message had no prior history. At the same time, Officer Mogerly, who was at 316 Julia Street, asked me if there was a '[REDACTED]' involved in the incident. Officer Mogerly told me he was able to recover the stolen phone from [REDACTED] at that location. When

confronted with the new information, [REDACTED] began crying and kept saying she didn't want to get in trouble. I asked [REDACTED] to simply be honest with me about what happened. Although she wasn't totally forthcoming about the incident, [REDACTED] told me she did give [REDACTED] her location on Government Road prior to the incident.

I left [REDACTED] residence and met with Officers on Julia Street. Ofc. Mogerly told me the SIM card had been removed from Alagal's cell phone and the occupants at 316 Julia Street were not cooperative and the chain and sunglasses were still missing. I spoke with Lt. Wood and agreed to secure the residence for a search warrant based on the information we had.

Officer Mogerly knocked on the door of 316 Julia Street for several minutes, however nobody answered. We could hear people inside and there was a surveillance camera directly over the door. I went to my vehicle and removed entry tools to gain access into the residence in fear evidence was being destroyed. Before returning to the door, Kristine Woldanski opened it. Officer Mogerly informed Kristine everyone in the house needed to come outside. Kristine said she needed to put their dog, a large pitbull on a leash. We allowed Kristine to go back inside and followed her in. Once inside the residence, Kristine began yelling to the occupants upstairs. Officer Mogerly tried to detain Kristine but she continued yelling and began pulling away. Officers Mogerly and Dantu struggled with Kristine to place her in handcuffs.

During the struggle, three more occupants came down the stairs into the living room. Kristine's son, [REDACTED], was one of the occupants on the staircase. Upon seeing his mother being detained, [REDACTED] began yelling and charging toward the officers. I stepped between [REDACTED] and the officers and told him to stop attempted to place him in handcuffs. [REDACTED] pulled away and was yelling for us to get out of his house. [REDACTED] was 6' tall and over 200 lbs. I pulled [REDACTED] into the kitchen and used all my force to get him to the ground. Once on the ground, [REDACTED] continued pulling away and he knocked my BWC off my chest while struggling. I deployed pepper spray into [REDACTED] face and immediately gained compliance. I placed [REDACTED] in handcuffs and told him to stay on his stomach. Once [REDACTED] was detained, the father, Peter Woldanski stepped out of a front bedroom area and into the kitchen. Peter was compliant and I placed him in handcuffs.

Once all parties were detained, I had officers move them outside to the front of the house. I was informed only one bedroom was not clear and there was a pitbull inside. I went upstairs and was able to clear the bedroom containing the pitbull. While clearing the bedroom, I noticed numerous handguns and a shotgun inside the bedroom in plain view. I closed the door and contacted detectives for further assistance.

Also on scene, parked adjacent to 316 Julia Street, was a dark gray Toyota pickup truck. Alagal said the suspects left
