On Friday, March 13, 2020, at 0038 hours, I (Officer Morris) was traveling north on College Road and saw a male, later identified as Steve Berry, standing in the middle of the road. I had to completely stop my vehicle to avoid hitting Berry. Berry stumbled backward out of the roadway onto the shoulder of the road. I parked my patrol vehicle off the road next to the KOTS staging area (5330 College Road) and approached Berry who was standing in the grass near the road.

I introduced myself to Berry and asked him if he was ok. I asked Berry if he was intoxicated because he was stumbling, and I noticed he wasn't wearing a shoe. I immediately recognized Berry was highly intoxicated. Berry had slurred speech, red/glassy eyes, and was very unsteady on his feet. I pointed out to Berry that he was only wearing one shoe and noticed there was a large bottle of vodka near his shoe. I asked Berry what he was doing, and he said he was looking for a place to stay for the night. I asked Berry if he had ever heard of KOTS and he said, "KOTS is a piece of shit". I pointed out to Berry that I recognized the large bottle of vodka next to his shoe. I noticed two large rocks that were behind Berry on the ground and Berry again started to stumble. I asked Berry multiple times to sit down and even tried to assist Berry to the ground, explaining to him that I didn't want him to fall. I took Berry by his left wrist and his left elbow and asked him to sit down for his safety. While I was holding Berry, he attempted to pull his left arm from my grasp multiple times. I let go of Berry's arm and once again explained to Berry that I was trying to help him. I explained to Berry he was highly intoxicated, and I needed him to sit down. Berry again began to stumble backward toward College Road. I again took Berry by his left arm and asked him to sit down. After giving Berry multiple loud verbal commands to sit down, I performed a leg sweep on Berry's left leg and assisted him to the ground.

Officer Lopez arrived on scene. I asked Berry what his name was and he identified himself by name and date of birth. I explained to Officer Lopez that Berry was going to be placed into custody reference the Marchman Act due to his level of intoxication. Berry provided me with an Illinois ID card. Berry's ID returned to a Steve Berry, D.O.B. 4/15/1963.

I told Berry, who at the time was sitting on the ground with his feet crossed in front of him, to place his hands behind his back. I placed my handcuffs on Berry's left hand and as I was trying to handcuff Berry's right hand, Berry pulled his arm away from me. I again told Berry to place his hands behind his back and Berry again pulled his hand away. Berry was tightening his arm and pushing back against me, attempting to prohibit me from placing him into handcuffs. I continuously gave Berry loud verbal commands to place his hands behind his back and Berry continued to stiffen his body and refused to place his right hand behind his back. I pushed Berry forward, causing him to lay on his stomach, so he would not continue to have leverage with his body. When I pushed Berry forward, Berry placed his right arm under his body. I continued to give Berry loud verbal commands to place his hand behind his back and he tensed his arm, refusing to give me his right arm. Officer Lopez was able to take Berry's right hand and place it behind Berry's back while I handcuffed Berry's right hand.

I returned Berry to the seated position and advised Key West Police Department Dispatch that we had to perform a takedown on Berry and asked for a Sgt. to respond.

Officer Lopez and I assisted Berry to my patrol car and placed Berry into my vehicle. Sgt. Vazquez and Sgt. Kouri responded to the scene to complete an RRI. I transported Berry to the Monroe County Detention Center without further incident.

On 03/13/2020 at approximately 0035 hours, I, Ofc. Lopez backed Ofc. Morris with an intoxicated subject at 5530 College Road.

Upon arrival, I observed a male sitting on the ground, the male was later identified as Steve Berry, (dob:04/15/1963). Berry was highly intoxicated, Berry kept talking and he did not make sense. Ofc. Morris was trying to identify Berry with dispatch. Berry was unable to spell his name correctly to Ofc. Morris.

Berry later pulled his wallet from his pocket and Ofc. Morris located Berry's Michigan identification. Ofc. Morris was able to identify Berry. Ofc. Morris was going to take Berry into custody under the Marchman Act. Ofc. Morris instructed Berry to put his hands behind his back and Berry kept pulling his arm away. Ofc. Morris contacted him first and had control of one of his arms. Berry leaned his body forward as Ofc. Morris attempted to gain control of Berry. I placed my hand on Berry's right arm to assist Ofc. Morris put handcuffs on Berry, I told Berry five times "Stop resisting" and Berry kept pulling his right arm forward resisting both of us.

Berry was belligerent and did not comply with our verbal commands. Berry was forcefully placed into custody for resisting.

I stood by after Sergeant Kouri responded to the scene reference our response to resistance.

This incident was recorded with my body worn camera, 3722.
