On 3/13/2020 about 2010 hours, I (Ofc. Dantu) was dispatched to 202 Duval Street in reference to a battery.

Upon arrival, I met with Jean Marcelin who told me he was punched in the head by a female, (Jennifer Brady) who was wearing a pink tank top and jean shorts. I asked Marcelin if he was injured or needed medical attention. Marcelin said he did not need any medical attention.
Ofc. Gillespie and Ofc. Malak arrived on scene.

Marcelin, who is an Uber driver said he was in the process of picking up 5 people at 202 Duval Street. (Marcelin said it was supposed to be 4 people and not 5 people according to his Uber information.) Brady entered the front passenger door and sat on top of a male person who was sitting in the front passenger seat. Brady was facing the rear of the vehicle.

Marcelin said he attempted to explain to Brady that she needed to exit the vehicle and sit in the rear seat. According to Marcelin, Brady refused to exit the vehicle and sit in the rear seat.
Marcelin said he tried to help Brady out of the front passenger seat, but Brady became angry and began to curse at him. Marcelin said Brady refused to exit the vehicle and became violent. Marcelin said Brady punched him multiple times in the head before exiting the vehicle and continued punching him in the head when she had exited the vehicle.

Brady was not on scene when I arrived.

Ofc. Gillespie managed to access video surveillance of the incident from Rick's Bar.
I spoke with Josh Crocker, (Irish Kevin's doorman) who witnessed the incident. Crocker saw Brady sitting in the front seat of Marcelin's vehicle. Crocker said he witnessed Brady punch Marcelin multiple times before Brady left the scene in a pink taxi.

Ofc. Gillespie said he viewed video surveillance of Brady sitting in the front seat of Marcelin's vehicle. Brady is seen sitting on a male person's lap facing the rear of the vehicle. Video surveillance footage showed Brady punching and kicking Marcelin when she is inside of the vehicle and punching Marcelin when Brady is outside of the vehicle. The video surveillance footage shows Brady as the aggressor. Brady is eventually seen getting into a Five 6s' taxi, (number 21) and leaving the scene.

I contacted KYPD dispatch and asked if they would contact Five 6's taxi company and attempt to find out where Brady was transported. Dispatch said Brady was transported to the 3700 block of Eagle Ave.

Ofc. Gillespie, after viewing the surveillance video recognized a male person in Marcelin's vehicle. Ofc. Gillespie contacted Sgt. Siracuse who was able to help locate the male person via cell phone. Sgt. Siracuse was able to locate the address where Brady was staying. (3497 Eagle Ave). The male was later identified as, Joey Hughes.

Ofc. Gillespie, Sgt. Siracuse and I made our way to 3487 Eagle Ave. Upon arrival, Ofc. Gillespie, Sgt Siracuse and I met with Fredrick Troika. Troike was upset and continued to say that Marcelin was putting his hands-on Brady when Marcelin attempted to get Brady out of his vehicle. Troike told me that Marcelin did not ask Brady to exit the vehicle. Troike said Marcelin attempted to physically remove Brady without first asking Brady to exit the vehicle. Troike became upset.

Brady appeared on scene when I was talking with Troike. Brady was wearing the same pink tank top and jean shorts

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as seen in the surveillance video from Rick's Bar. Brady had a strong odor of alcohol coming from her breath. Brady's eyes were red. Brady was angry. I asked Brady to step outside of the house. Brady walked out onto the front porch. I attempted to explain to Brady that she was being arrested for battery. Ofc. Gillespie was on the porch with me. Brady refused to listen to what I had to say and became argumentative. Brady began to curse at me. I attempted to speak with Brady again but she turned around and yelled at me not to touch her. I tried to handcuff Brady but Brady pulled her right arm away from me. Ofc. Gillespie grabbed Brady's right arm and leaned Brady up against the house in order to gain control of her. Brady threw herself onto the floor. Ofc. Gillespie and I stood Brady back up. Brady continued to scream and curse.

I managed to handcuff Brady. Brady stiffened up her body and refused to walk. Brady pushed back into me and continued cursing calling me a pig. Brady did not want to leave the property at 3487 Eagle Ave. I managed to walk Brady to my vehicle and transport her to Monroe County Detention Center.

Brady said she punched Marcelin because Marcelin touched her, (when he attempted to help her exit his vehicle). Brady admitted to punching Marcelin multiple times. The video surveillance footage shows Brady punching and kicking Marcelin.

Ofc. Gillespie and Sgt. Siracuse were involved in an incident with Troike. Troike was detained and arrested for resisting Sgt. Siracuse and Ofc. Gillespie without violence.

I obtained a copy of the video surveillance footage and uploaded the footage to evidence.com
I photographed Marcelin's face. I uploaded the photographs to evidence.com.

Based on the facts and evidence in this case there is probable cause to believe on 3/13/2020, at about 2010 hrs. a battery was committed by Brady. There is probable cause to believe on 3/13/2020, at about 2010 hrs. the defendant, Brady, knowingly and intentionally struck the victim, Marcelin, against his will. The victim was not injured.

I arrested Brady according to Section 784.03, Florida Statutes. I arrested Brady for battery.

And

Based on the facts and evidence in this case there is probable cause to believe on 3/13/2020, at about 2130 hrs. Brady resisted an Officer without violence. Brady:

- Resisted, obstructed, or opposed a law enforcement officer;
- At the time, the officer was engaged in the execution of legal process of the lawful execution of a legal duty;
- The officer was a person legally authorized to execute processes; and
- At the time, Brady knew that the person resisted, obstructed, or opposed was in fact an officer or other person legally authorized to execute process.

Brady was arrested according to Section 843.02, Florida Statutes. (Resisting an Officer Without Violence).

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Upon arrival, I met with Marcelin, (an Uber driver) who told me a female, (Jennifer Brady) wearing a pink tank top and jean shorts punched him in the head multiple times.

With the help of Sgt. Siracuse and Ofc. Gillespie I was able to locate Brady at 3487 Eagle Ave. I was able to make contact with Brady who had a strong odor of alcohol coming from her breath. I tried to explain to Brady that she was under arrest. I asked Brady to step outside of the house. Brady walked out onto the front porch. Brady's long time boyfriend Fredrick Troike became angry and upset. I attempted to handcuff Brady.

I heard Sgt. Siracuse ask Troike to step back multiple times. Sgt. Siracuse was in the front doorway of the house asking Troike to please step back as I attempted to handcuff Brady outside on the front Porch. Ofc. Gillespie was standing behind Sgt. Siracuse. I was unable to see Troike.

The following is Sgt. Siracuse's account of the incident:

On 3/13/2020, at approximately 2000 hours, I, (Sgt. M. Siracuse) responded to 3487 Eagle Avenue to assist Officers Dantu and Gillespie in arresting a female for battery.

Prior to going to this location, Ofc. Gillespie showed me a video in which a white female, later identified as Jennifer Brady, attacked an Uber driver in front of Ricks Bar (202 Duval Street). During the attack, you can see a second male, wearing a white t-shirt, trying to hold back Brady and calm down the situation. I recognized the white male as Captain Joseph Hughes of the Key West Fire Department. The incident initiated because there were too many people in the vehicle and Brady was sitting on Hughes' lap facing backwards in the front passenger seat and the driver refused to transport them in that manner. Hughes can also be seen in the video holding an open bottle of beer in his left hand while trying to hold back Brady.

After meeting with Officers Gillespie and Dantu, it was clear there was probable cause to arrest Brady. I contacted Hughes by phone and he immediately knew why I was calling him. Hughes told me they were located at 3497 Eagle Avenue and that Brady was sleeping upstairs.

Upon arrival we noticed there was no 3497, but 3487 Eagle Avenue was likely the correct residence. I knocked on the door of 3487 Eagle Avenue and made contact with Hughes and his friend Frederick Troike. Troike appeared under the influence of alcohol and was rather loud. We spoke to Troike for some time about the incident and he defended Brady, saying it was the driver's fault for trying to physically get her out of the vehicle. While arguing with Troike, Hughes went upstairs and brought down Brady. Brady was still in the same clothes seen in the video and was clearly very intoxicated. Brady was slurring her words and yelling about how she was touched first and how she would go to jail.

Officer Dantu stepped outside onto the front porch of the house. After a short period of time I heard Officer Dantu struggling with Brady on the front porch and it was clear she was resisting. Officer Gillespie stepped outside to assist Ofc. Dantu and I stepped into the doorway separating Troike from Brady and the Officers. While taking Brady into custody, she began yelling, "Fred, Fred," and Troike kept stepping further outside the front door. I asked Troike twice to go back inside the house because he was only escalating the situation. For the safety of Officers Dantu and Gillespie, I got closer to Troike and told him an additional four times to go back inside the residence. After ignoring

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my verbal command a total of six times, I attempted to take hold of Troike's left hand and place it behind his back. Although only 5'4, Troike had a muscular build and was well within my reactionary gap. As I grabbed Troike's left hand he ripped it away from me. I placed my left hand at the bottom of Troike's neck and pushed him back while I drew my Taser from its holster. I told Troike one more time to put his hands behind his back and like all other commands, he refused to do so. I deployed my Taser and both prongs made contact with Troike's left pectoral area. The spread between prongs was small and muscular incapacitation did not occur. Troike briefly crouched down, yelled, "Ahh Fucker," and raised his hands toward me. I pushed Troike back and Officer Gillespie entered the narrow hallway to assist me. Troike fell onto his side as I connected the front of my Taser to his left flank and his lower right thigh area. At the same time, Officer Gillespie held Troike down and layed him flat on his stomach. Once on his stomach, we were able to place him in handcuffs. Troike was only tased for one five second cycle, and approximately an additional three second drive stun.

I rolled Troike back over on his left side and removed the probes from his chest. Throughout the incident Troike continued calling us fucking assholes and fucking dicks, and told us we would be sued. A small amount of blood was dripping from one of the probe punctures and I asked KWPd communications to dispatch rescue to our location. We walked Troike to the back seat of Ofc. Gillespie's patrol vehicle where he was seen by rescue. Sgt. C. Sims arrived at our location to complete the use of force incident report.

I returned inside the residence to photograph the scene. Hughes had begun cleaning up the area and I asked him to stop until photos were taken and the afids, prongs, etc, were collected. I took photographs of the scene and uploaded them to Evidence.com. I returned with Sgt. Sims to collect AFIDS and the prongs. Hughes had taken the bath mat from the bathroom and wiped the area. I located everything except one of the taser prongs (which was not where I had left it) and asked Hughes if he knew where it had went. Hughes responded, "I don't know, that's your fucking job," and walked out of the house. I eventually located the missing prong near the garbage can inside the bathroom.

I locked the front door (per Troike's request) and left the residence. I placed the spent cartridge, afids, and prongs into the KWPd property section as evidence. This incident was captured on my BWC and uploaded into Evidence.com.

I had Ofc. Gillespie transport Troike to the LKMC for medical clearance.

Based on the facts and evidence in this case there is probable cause to believe on 3/13/2020, at about 2130 hrs. Troike resisted an Officer, (Sgt. Siracuse) without violence. Troike:

- Resisted, obstructed, or opposed a law enforcement officer;
- At the time, the officer was engaged in the execution of legal process of the lawful execution of a legal duty;
- The officer was a person legally authorized to execute processes; and
- At the time, Troike knew that the person resisted, obstructed, or opposed was in fact an officer or other person legally authorized to execute process.

Troike was arrested according to Section 843.02, Florida Statutes. (Resisting an Officer Without Violence).

On 3/13/2020, at approximately 2000 hours, I, (Sgt. M. Siracuse) responded to 3487 Eagle Avenue to assist Officers Dantu and Gillespie in arresting a female for battery.

Prior to going to this location, Ofc. Gillespie showed me a video in which a white female, later identified as Jennifer Brady, attacked an Uber driver in front of Ricks Bar (202 Duval Street). During the attack, you can see a second male, wearing a white t-shirt, trying to hold back Brady and calm down the situation. I recognized the white male as Captain Joseph Hughes of the Key West Fire Department. The incident initiated because there were too many people in the vehicle and Brady was sitting on Hughes' lap facing backwards in the front passenger seat and the driver refused to transport them in that manner. Hughes can also be seen in the video holding an open bottle of beer in his left hand while trying to hold back Brady.

After meeting with Officers Gillespie and Dantu, it was clear there was probable cause to arrest Brady. I contacted Hughes by phone and he immediately knew why I was calling him. Hughes told me they were located at 3497 Eagle Avenue and that Brady was sleeping upstairs.

Upon arrival we noticed there was no 3497, but 3487 Eagle Avenue was likely the correct residence. I knocked on the door of 3487 Eagle Avenue and made contact with Hughes and his friend Frederick Troike. Troike appeared under the influence of alcohol and was rather loud. We spoke to Troike for some time about the incident and he defended Brady, saying it was the driver's fault for trying to physically get her out of the vehicle. While arguing with Troike, Hughes went upstairs and brought down Brady. Brady was still in the same clothes seen in the video and was clearly very intoxicated. Brady was slurring her words and yelling about how she was touched first and was willing to go to jail.

Officer Dantu stepped outside onto the front porch of the house. After a short period of time I heard Officer Dantu struggling with Brady on the front porch and it was clear she was resisting. Officer Gillespie stepped outside to assist Ofc. Dantu and I stepped into the doorway separating Troike from Brady and the Officers. While taking Brady into custody, she began yelling, "Fred, Fred," and Troike kept stepping further outside the front door. I asked Troike twice to go back inside the house because he was only escalating the situation. For the safety of Officers Dantu and Gillespie, I got closer to Troike and told him an additional four times to go back inside the residence. After ignoring my verbal command a total of six times, I attempted to take hold of Troike's left hand and place it behind his back. Although only 5'4, Troike had a muscular build and was well within my reactionary gap. As I grabbed Troike's left hand he ripped it away from me. I placed my left hand at the top of Troike's chest and pushed him back while I drew my Taser from its holster. I told Troike one more time to put his hands behind his back and like all other commands, he refused to do so. I deployed my Taser and both prongs made contact with Troike's left pectoral area. The spread between prongs was small and muscular incapacitation did not occur. Troike briefly crouched down, yelled, "Ahh Fucker," and

raised his hands toward me. I pushed Troike back and Officer Gillespie entered the narrow hallway to assist me. Troike fell onto his side as I connected the front of my Taser to his left flank and his lower right thigh area. At the same time, Officer Gillespie held Troike down and layed him flat on his stomach. Once on his stomach, we were able to place him in handcuffs. Troike was only tased for one five second cycle, and approximately an additional three second drive stun.

I rolled Troike back over on his left side and removed the probes from his chest. Throughout the incident Troike continued calling us fucking assholes and fucking dicks, and told us we would be sued. A small amount of blood was dripping from one of the probe punctures and I asked KYPD communications to dispatch rescue to our location. We walked Troike to the back seat of Ofc. Gillespie's patrol vehicle where he was seen by rescue. Sgt. C. Sims arrived at our location to complete the response to resistance incident report.

I returned inside the residence to photograph the scene. Hughes had begun cleaning up the area and I asked him to stop until photos were taken and the afids, prongs, etc, were collected. I took photographs of the scene and uploaded them to Evidence.com. I returned with Sgt. Sims to collect AFIDS and the prongs. Hughes had taken the bath mat from the bathroom and wiped the area. I located everything except one of the taser prongs (which was not where I had left it) and asked Hughes if he knew where it had went. Hughes responded, "I don't know, that's your fucking job," and walked out of the house. I eventually located the missing prong near the garbage can inside the bathroom.

I locked the front door (per Troike's request) and left the residence. I placed the spent cartridge, afids, and prongs into the KYPD property section as evidence. This incident was captured on my BWC and uploaded into Evidence.com.

I had Ofc. Gillespie transport Troike to the LKMC for medical clearance.

On 03/13/2020, at approximately 2002 hours, I (Officer Gillespie) responded to 211-B Duval St. (Crocs Store) in reference to a battery.

Upon arrival, I met with Jean Davidson Marcelin (Uber driver) at the corner of Duval St. and Charles St. Marcelin advised he was punched twice in the head by a female suspect (later identified as Jennifer L. Brady) that refused to get out of his Uber. After identifying the location where the battery took place, I entered Rick's Bar to obtain video footage of the incident.

Rick's Bar was able to provide clear security footage of the incident. During our investigation it as determined that it was possible Brady was located at 3487 Eagle Ave.

Officer Dantu, Sgt. Siracuse and I responded to 3487 Eagle Ave. to attempt to make contact with Brady. Upon arrival, a white male (later identified as Frederick Louis Troike) opened the front door and invited us in. Brady was notified that we were on scene and came downstairs to meet with us. Officer Dantu and I met with Brady on the porch. I observed that Brady appeared intoxicated. I observed Brady to have slurred speech, red blood shot eyes and a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from her breath and person. I observed Officer Dantu attempt to speak with Brady but due to her level of intoxication, she wouldn't listen. Officer Dantu attempted to speak with Brady again when she turned and faced him and said, "Don't touch me". I observed Officer Dantu instruct Brady to turn around and that she was under arrest, which Brady complied. When Officer Dantu attempted to place Brady in cuffs, she pulled her right arm away from Officer Dantu. I stepped in and grabbed Brady's left arm to try and gain control of her, that is when Brady pulled her arm away from me. I grabbed her hand more firmly and leaned her against the house in an attempt to gain control. Brady, then threw herself on the floor of the porch. Officer Dantu and I stood Brady back to her feet, all while Brady was screaming.

Just after getting Brady under control, I heard Sgt. Siracuse give loud verbal commands for Troike to "go back inside". Troike did not comply with Sgt. Siracuse direct order, then Sgt. Siracuse gave another loud verbal command to Troike "go back inside or you're going to jail". Then Sgt. Siracuse instructed Troike twice to "put your hands behind your back" to which Troike did not comply. That is when Sgt. Siracuse pulled his taser and pointed it at Troike. I pulled my Taser and pointed it at Troike but did not discharge it. Sgt. Siracuse deployed his Taser on Troike. While the taser was cycling, Sgt. Siracuse attempted to grab Troike, but was unsuccessful because Troike attempted to strike Sgt. Siracuse with his right arm. As Troike was pulling away, he appeared off balance, that is when I grabbed him and we both went to the floor. I grabbed Troikes' left arm and placed it behind his back while laying on top of him. Sgt. Siracuse placed hand cuffs on Troike.
