On 4/22/20 at 0341hrs, I, Officer Malak along with officers Mogerly, Brablc, Hernandez, Gillespie, and Deese, responded to 711 Duval St, in reference to an assault. The caller, Paul Clift DOB 8/23/87, stated he was chased and threatened by a subject he knows as Lonnie Lehmkuhle DOB 2/13/93.

Upon arrival to the area, I spoke to Clift for a brief second to attempt to locate Lehmkuhle. Clift stated the incident occurred on Petronia St near the cemetery and he did not see which way Lehmkuhle ran to. While Lehmkuhle was chasing him, Lehmkuhle was shouting threats towards him. Clift was scared if Lehmkuhle caught him, Lehmkuhle would cause physical harm to him. Clift also stated that Lehmkuhle was with 3 other subjects, but Lehmkuhle was the only aggressor.

I canvassed the area for Lehmkuhle, with Officer Mogerly and Brablc locating them in the 700 block of Southard Street (see both Officer Mogerly and Brablc's supplemental for further). When I arrived on scene, Lehmkuhle was being walked over to a patrol car and being instructed to give Officer Mogerly his hands. Lehmkuhle did not comply with commands and locked his hands together in front of his body. Lehmkuhle refused to comply with direct orders and continued to resist. After several warnings, Officer Brablc used a taser to deliver a drive stun, in efforts to get Lehmkuhle to comply with commands. After a failed attempt with the Taser, I grabbed Lehmkuhle by the back of the pant leg and brought him to the ground flat on his stomach. Lehmkuhle was still not obeying to clear and precise commands, so Officer Mogerly used his baton and pried Lehmkuhle's arms from underneath his body. Once Officer Brablc and I gained control of Lehmkuhle's arms and applied handcuffs, Lehmkuhle curled into a ball and began to shift his arms to the front. Sgt Siracuse arrived on location and assisted us with the arresting procedures. Lehmkuhle remained in a curled position and refused to straighten his arms out.

Rescue was called for Lehmkuhle and upon their arrival, they gave Lehmkuhle a sedative to bring him out of his belligerent state. Once calmed down, Lehmkuhle was put on a backboard and transported to Lower Keys Medical Center for further medical assessments. Officer Brablc rode with the ambulance to ensure the safety of medical staff.

Stephen Dean DOB 1/26/83, Jeremy Vallies DOB 4/14/84, and Joseph Elise DOB 5/23/74, were all present for the Assault of Clift and the arrest of Lehmkuhle. All three refused to provide statements and were subsequently released with no charges.

Officer Deese responded back to 711 Duval street to interview Clift about the assault again. Clift completed a written statement for the incident and stated he wanted to pursue charges against Lehmkuhle (see Officer Deese's supplemental for further).

Once cleared from Lower Keys Medical Center, Lehmkuhle was transported to Monroe County Jail without further incident.

Lonnie Lehmkuhle knowingly and intentionally chased Paul Clift while Clift was riding his Segway. Lehmkuhle was shouting threats towards Clift while Clift was able to ride away. Clift has a history of violence with Lehmkuhle and believed Lehmkuhle was going to cause him physical harm this morning. Lehmkuhle is being charged with FSS 784.011, Assault.

Lonnie Lehmkuhle knowingly and willingly resisted officers by not complying with lawful orders and actively tensing up to avoid arrest. Lehmkuhle is being charges with FSS 843.02, Resisting without violence.

On April 22, 2020, at about 3:41 a.m., Sgt. Siracuse, Ofc. Malak, Deese, Brablc, Gilispie, R. Perez, Roscoe, and I (Ofc. Mogerley), responded to a report of an assault that took place in the area of Patronia Street. The victim was at Aqua and reported that the suspect was Lonnie Lehmkuhle.

Ofc. Malak, Brablc and I were on a prior call with Lehmkuhle where he was trespassing in the area of Virgina Street and we were aware of who Lehmkuhle was. During this prior call Lehmkuhle was dropping his pants and exposing his buttocks as he was walking away from the area.

Sgt. Siracuse met with the victim at Aqua and I stopped by. The victim said the suspects were in the area of Grinnell Street and Angela Street. I responded to the area and located Lehmkuhle at the intersection of Grinnell Street and Southard Street. I told him to stop walking several times and sit down. Lehmkuhle responded with "taze me", and kept walking. Lehmkuhle was pushing a male in a wheelchair and two other males were with him. All males were refusing to stop walking and sit down. I notified the responding Officers that they were refusing to stop walking. I told Lehmkuhle to stop walking and put his arms behind his back. Lehmkuhle still refused and held onto the wheelchair. Officer Brablc and I grabbed his arms and he refused to let go and resisted us trying to put his hands behind his back by holding on to the wheelchair with a tight grib refusing to let go. I delivered a knee strike to his left thigh. Lehmkuhle let go of the wheelchair and locked his hands together in front of body. Ofc. Brablc and I were pulling his arms trying to get them behind his back to handcuff him. Lehmkuhle still refused. He was given several instructions to stop resisting. Ofc. Malak, Brablc and I escorted Lehmkuhle to the front of Ofc. Brablc's Police car and placed him against it. Lehmkuhle was still holding his hands locked in front of his body. I used my baton to try to pry his arms apart and he would not let go. Ofc. Brablc drive stunned Lehmkuhle with his Tazer. Ofc. Malak took Lehmkuhle to the ground. Lehmkuhle was still holding his hands together under his body. I placed my baton between his arm and ribs and used it to pull his arms out from under his body. I did this to both sides and when his arm was behind his back Ofc. Malak and Brablc placed him into handcuffs.

Ofc. Hernandez and Perez were trying to put the hobble strap around his ankles as Lehmkuhle was trying to kick us and was kicking his legs. I placed my baton across his legs to prevent him from moving them so the officers were able to get the hobble strap on. Key West Fire/Rescue arrived. Resuce treated him and placed him onto a backboard (to make it easier to transport him due to him fighting), and into the back of the ambulance. Lehmkuhle was transported to the Lower Keys Medical Center. Ofc. Brablc rode out with Lehmkuhle to the Medical Center and I followed. Ofc. Hudson relieved us at the emergency room until he was cleared to go to the Jail.

On April 22nd, 2020 at approximately 0430 hours, I (Officer Deese) met with Paul Rich Clift, identified by his name and date of birth, at Aqua Bar and Lounge located at 711 Duval Street in reference to an assault.

Upon arrival, Clift was visibly shaking and stated that he was "a little shaken up" due to the incident that happened on Petronia Street. Clift stated that he was riding on his segway down Petronia Street when he heard a male voice yell "Paul". Clift stated that he recognized the white male as Lonnie Lehmkuhle. Clift stated Lehmkuhle was chasing after him and threatening to beat him up. Clift stated he was scared that Lehmkuhle would become violent with him if he caught up to him. Clift stated he was able to get away and make it to Aqua Bar and Lounge where he works.

Clift wrote the following on a witness statement form:

"4:15AM I was heading south on Petronia St. passing the dog park next to the graveyard on Grinelle. Saw 3 people in the entry way. I was on my segway going 16 mph when I heard what turned out to be Lonnie Luhenki screaming at me and began chasing me barefoot almost catching me and shouting. It was apparent he was indenting to physically violent however I was able to escape just barley onto Windsor and then called KWPD (Key West Police Department) to file a report."

I asked Clift to raise his right hand and swear or affirm that what he wrote was true to the best of his knowledge or belief to which he stated "yes".

I placed the wittness statement form in Key West Police Department Records division.

My BWC was activated during the incident and uploaded to Axon Evidence.com.

On Wednesday April 22nd, 2020, at about 0341 hours, I, Ofc. L. Hernandez responded to Southard Street and Grinnell Street in reference to an assault incident that occurred near the Grinnell Pocket Park.

Upon arrival, Ofc. Mogerley, Ofc. Malak and Ofc. Blablac were actively trying to take the suspect into custody, Lonnie Allen Lehmkuhle (DOB 02/13/93 Florida ID Card # L524521930530). Lehmkuhle was actively refusing to be restrained by folding his arms against his chest and tensing up.

Ofc. Mogerley and Ofc. Malak kept telling Lehmkuhle to stop bringing his arms towards his chest to avoid being restrained and Ofc. Blablac had to drive stun him but Lehmkuhle kept resisting by pulling his arms towards his chest area, tensing up and preventing us from grabbing his arms to place handcuffs on him. I helped bring Lehmkuhle down onto the ground by holding his left arm and back.

We were able to handcuff Lehmkuhle once on the ground, but he was still pulling his arms towards his chest, tensing up and not following our clear and loud commands for compliance. Sgt. Siracuse and I had to hold Lehmkuhle's legs down because he kept moving them by bringing them up and down and to the side.

When Sgt. Siracuse and I tried to keep Lehmkuhle legs still he kept bringing them up and down. Because of the imminent threat of getting kicked by Lehmkuhle and his lack of compliance we decided to use a hobble to restrain his legs. Ofc. R. Perez and I secured Lehmkuhle's legs using the hobble.

I held down his legs by his ankles while holding the hobble until Lehmkuhle was turned over to the Key West Fire Rescue Crew.

This incident was recorded using my BWC 3452.

On Wednesday, April 22, 2020, at approximately 0340 hours, Officer Mogerley, Officer Roscoe, Officer Malak, Officer Deese and I (Officer Brablc) responded to and assault call at Aqua Nightclub, at 711 Duval St. Key West, FL.

KWPD dispatch advised, a caller (Paul Clift) stated, he was chased by Lonnie Lehmkuhle on Petronia St.

Officer Mogerley found Lehmkuhle on the 900 block of Southard St. I responded from Caroline St. Officer Mogerley advised, Lehmkuhle and three other subjects were refusing to stop. I approached Lehmkuhle and told him to stop. Lehmkuhle said he did not do anything. Officer Mogerley grabbed Lehmkuhle's left arm and I grabbed the right arm. Lehmkuhle refused to let go of the wheelchair he was pushing. I ordered Lehmkuhle to stop resisting and put his hand behind his back. Lehmkuhle refused and tried to pull away from Officer Mogerley. I used two closed fist strikes to Lehmkuhle's forearm to make him let go of the wheel chair. Lehmkuhle let go after the second strike. Officer Mogerley and I walked Lehmkuhle to the front of my patrol vehicle. Lehmkuhle would not respond to our lawful commands and place his hand behind his back. I used my TASER and drive stunned Lehmkuhle to gain pain compliance.

Officer Malak, Officer Mogerley and I, eventually placed Lehmkuhle on the ground and continued to gain compliance.

Lehmkuhle was detained and transported to the Lower Keys Medical Center for clearance. I rode in the ambulance with Lehmkuhle and Officer Mogerley followed.

Officer Hudson relieved Officer Mogerley and myself from the ER.

My AXON body worn camera was activated.
