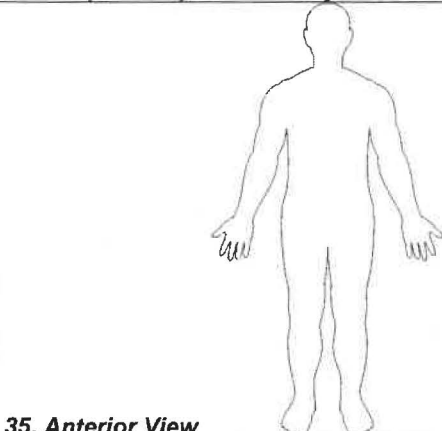

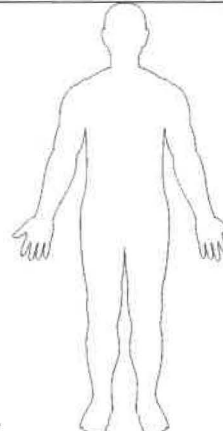

On Sunday, April 26, 2020, at approximately 0345 hours, I (Officer M. Brable) was on a routine patrol of Northside Dr, when I observed a white male ride a bicycle out of Surgery Center of Key West at 931 Toppino Dr at a high rate of speed. The subject (later identified as Gregory Wellet) left the area traveling East on Northside Dr.

I turned around and followed Wellet. I observed Wellet riding on the wrong side of the road and his bicycle was not equipped with lights. Wellet traveled about 150 yards while I was turning around. I caught up with Wellet, activated my overhead lights and attempted to pull Wellet over. Wellet sped up and turned onto 16th Terrace and later onto 17th Street traveling towards N. Roosevelt Blvd. Sgt. M. Siracuse happened to be at the intersection of 17th Street and N. Roosevelt Blvd and followed Wellet as he cut through the La Laureate Hotel's parking lot. Weller rode into a dead-end street behind 21st Century Oncology but was able to avoid Sgt. Siracuse and come back around. Wellet rode South on 17th Street back onto Northside Dr. Wellet then got onto 17th Terrace and turned right onto Donald Ave. Wellet was looping around in the area attempting to flee. Officer A. Hudson and I were able to catch up with Wellet at Donald Ave and 18th Street. Officer Hudson was following the bicycle and I passed both Officer Hudson and Wellet to make a safe gap and be able to get out of my patrol vehicle and stop Wellet. Officer Hudson utilized his AXON Taser to detain Wellet. I pushed Wellet off the bicycle to prevent him from attempting to get away.

Wellet complied with the verbal orders and I placed him in handcuffs. I asked Wellet why did he run from us, to which he replied he did not have lights and was scared.

During a search incident to arrest, Officer N. Mogerley found a glass pipe in Wellet's right short pocket. The glass pipe later tested positive for cocaine. During the search of Wellet's bicycle, Sgt. Siracuse and Ofc. Hudson found the following:

- 4x small bag of solid white substance (field tested positive for cocaine) total weight was 1.2gram.
- 13x 100ml syringe (New)
- 1x glass pipe used to smoke crack cocaine (2 total) (FTP Cocaine Residue)
- 2x table spoon with cocaine residue (FTP Cocaine Residue)
- 1x digital scale (FTP Cocaine Residue)
- 1x square plastic cutting tray with skull print on it with cocaine residue on it (FTP Cocaine Residue) used for cutting exact weighted amount ready to be packaged and sold.
- 2x plastic straw with a "spoon end" (one red, one yellow) used to scoop up and snort cocaine.
- 2x elastic cord used to wrap around one's arm in order make veins easier to inject.

Three small containers with unknown substance were also found. When asked, Wellet said it was a mixture of vinegar, alcohol, and water. A box cutter was found concealed under Wellet's belt in his small back area.

Wellet told me, he was going to start working as a confidential informant, but everything was postponed because of Covid-19 outbreak. Wellet told me, he was told to "keep doing what he does". Officer Hudson told Wellet he would be violating the C.I. agreement with possession of drug paraphernalia, to which he replied, "How Am I supposed to set people up".

Based on his action and the evidence found, Wellet violated the following:

1. Wellet possessed a substance. Four small plastic bags were found on a purple pouch inside of the bicycle's front basket.
2. The substance was crack cocaine of total weight 1.2gram.

7 counts of § 893.147(1) POSSESSION OF DRUG PARAPHERNALIA

1. Wellet knew of the presence of drug paraphernalia.
  2. Wellet possessed the drug paraphernalia with intent to use it manufacture, process, prepare, pack, repack, store, contain a controlled substance and inject a controlled substance into the human body.
- Wellet was placed under arrest and I transported him to the Monroe County Detention Center without an incident.

F.S.S. 316.1935(2) FLEEING TO ELUDE A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

1. Wellet was riding a bicycle upon a street or highway in Florida.
2. Wellet, knowing he had been directed to stop by a duly authorized law enforcement officer, willfully fled on a bicycle in an attempt to elude a law enforcement officer.
3. The law enforcement officer was in an authorized law enforcement patrol vehicle with agency insignia and other jurisdictional markings prominently displayed on the vehicle and with siren and lights activated.
4. During the course of the fleeing or the attempt to elude, Wellet rode his bicycle in a manner demonstrating a wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property.

I transported Wellet to the Monroe County Detention Center without an incident.

My AXON body worn camera was activated.

All the evidence was packaged and processed by Officer A. Hudson.

On 4/26/2020, at approximately 0330 hours, I (Sgt. M. Siracuse) was near the intersection of 17th Street and N. Roosevelt Blvd. when I heard Ofc. M. Brable calling out a traffic stop of a bicycle. Ofc. Brable said the bicycle was refusing to stop and fleeing through the Laureate Hotel on N. Roosevelt Blvd. I observed the bicyclist, later identified as Gregory Wellet (8/24/67), cutting through the parking lot of the Laureat Hotel with Ofc. Brable behind him in his marked patrol vehicle with emergency lights activated.

I activated my emergency lights and attempted to stop Wellet as he came out the N. Roosevelt Blvd. exit of the Laureat. Wellet ignored my verbal commands to stop and continued to flee on his bicycle westbound on N. Roosevelt Blvd. I used my vehicle's PA system and gave Wellet additional commands to stop. I followed Wellet into the rear parking lot of the 21st Century Oncology building where I blocked Wellet against a wall in the rear of the parking lot. I got out of my vehicle and attempted to stop Wellet on foot. Wellet was able to squeeze between my vehicle and the wall and again flee on his bicycle back out toward N. Roosevelt Blvd. I deployed my Taser as Wellet fled the parking lot, however it did not make contact with him.

I called out Wellet's description and direction of travel as he continued eastbound on N. Roosevelt Blvd. and turned southbound on 17th Street. There were numerous Officers in the area who intercepted Wellet and surrounded him on Donald Avenue. Ofc. Hudson informed me had Tased Wellet and he was in custody on Donald Avenue. I responded to that location and took photos for the RRI report. Rescue responded and treated Wellet on scene. I searched some of Wellet's property and located a box of needles, bands, a digital scale, a square plate used for cutting crack cocaine, spoons, push rods, and numerous pieces of drug paraphernalia. Officers continued the search of his property which turned up additional narcotics.

Ofc. Brable transported Wellet to the Monroe County Detention Center without further incident. This incident was recorded on my in car COBAN video as well as my BWC.

On 04/26/2020 at approximately 0335, while on routine patrol in the City of Key West I responded to the area of 17th st and N Roosevelt Blvd attempting to locate a bicyclist who fled from Officer Brable.

On arrival, Sergeant Siracuse told me the subject, who was later identified as Gregory Wellet, had traveled South on 17th St towards Northside Dr. I observed the subject traveling South on 17th Terr, got directly behind him and activated my blue overhead emergency lights and siren. The Wellet did not stop. Wellet made a right turn onto Donald Ave traveling West. Wellet the made a right turn onto 17th St traveling North on the wrong side of the one way street. Wellet left the roadway and rode his bicycle through the median and continued back onto Donald Ave traveling East. Officer Brable got in front of Wellet's bicycle and slowed. Wellet then attempted to make a u-turn to travel West on Donald Ave.

At this time, I drew my agency issued Taser and gave Wellet loud repetitive verbal commands to stop or he would be Tased. Wellet again started to Pedal. I then fired the Taser striking Wellet in his left shoulder and left mid back area. Officer Brable then took Wellet to the ground at which time he was taken into custody without further incident. I then called for rescue to respond and removed the Taser probes. Sergeant Siracuse also responded to the scene and photographed Wellet's injuries.

The Taser cartridge, probes and AFIDS were placed into property as evidence.

Sergeant Siracuse searched Wellet's bicycle and located numerous pieces of drug paraphernalia to include a scale and glass pipes with residue. All items field tested positive for cocaine. Wellet was also in possession of 13 un-used hypodermic needles.

Officer Tellier also located 4 small plastic zip lock style bags that contained a white rock substance. The substance field tested positive for cocaine.

All items were placed into property as evidence. The white rock substance was sent to FDLE for analysis.

All of the above was captured on my in-car and bodyworn cameras, 3940.

On 04/26/20 at 225 hours I, (Ofc. J. Tellier) responded to the intersection of Donald St. and 17th St. in reference to a fleeing suspect. Ofc. Brable attempted to stop a bicyclist, who could possibly be a battery suspect. The suspect Gregory Wellet refused to stop, attempting to flea the area.

While in route to the location, it was aired over channel one that the suspect was in custody.

Upon my arrival, Wellet was handcuffed laying on the ground. Officers Hudson and Brable were on scene. Wellet had a taser probe still stuck in his tail bone area.

An ambulance was called to treat/exam Wellet for his injuries. Sgt. Siracuse arrived on scene to conduct an RRI investigation. I was able to identify Wellet by his name and date of birth which he provided.

While waiting for the ambulance, Wellet remained laying on the ground passive. Since he was already in custody and had a bicycle, I helped conduct an inventory. The bicycle had a front and rear basket with numerous personal/hygiene items. While checking the front basket, I found a purple cloth zip up pouch next to the cup holder. When I opened the pouch a small clear plastic bag fell out onto the ground. Inside the pouch were three more clear plastic baggies. There were four clear plastic baggies in total. Inside the baggies was a white milky/wet looking powder. Ofc. Hudson tested the substance, and it tested positive for cocaine.

Ofc. Brable transported Wellet to Lower Keys Medical center and later on the Monroe County jail. I took possession of Wellet's property (bicycle and a bag of personal items). I placed the bag and the bicycle into the property section as prisoner property.

My BWC recorded my involvement in this case.
