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On Sunday, May 17, 2020, at 1441 hours, I (Ofc. A. Anglin) was dispatched to the Hilton Garden Inn on N. Roosevelt Blvd. regarding an assist for Monroe County deputies with a physical fight. The actual location of the incident was the driveway of the Gates Hotel, at 3824 N. Roosevelt Blvd. When I arrived at 1445 hours, three Monroe County (MCSO) deputies, J. Williams and Z. Eason, and L. Valdez were on scene, as well as KWPD Ofc. B. Leahy.

I saw Dep. Williams obtaining information from a white male sitting on the ground, identified as Lee. C. Quinn (who I had encountered the previous day at Uppy's with Ofc. Valdes-Marrero). I heard Quinn telling Dep. Williams that the other male hurt his jaw and ripped his pants. I observed Quinn was bleeding from a laceration above his left eye. I asked Quinn which man, and he pointed to a male who was sitting on the curb just inside the driveway to the Gates. This male identified himself as Jason H. Sapp, who I had encountered several days prior in another law enforcement contact.

Sapp told me the following:

Quinn had beaten up a veteran with one leg. Approximately an hour prior to this fight, Quinn had beat up Sapp's friend on Stock Island not far from the Tom Thumb and left. Sapp's friend asked Sapp to go to Winn Dixie Liquors for some drinks. Sapp told his friend, "If I see him I'm going to beat his fucking ass." As Sapp was riding his bike, he saw Quinn near the entrance to the hotel and confronted him. Sapp said something similar to, "Why'd you beat up that vet?" Quinn then took a swing at Sapp, which started a physical altercation between the two men.

During this conversation, Dep. Valdez was arguing with a potential male witness who became belligerent and upset when asked for his identification. The male had to be asked to leave as he continued to stand in the roadway and in traffic. I did not get a statement from this male.

As I was speaking with Sapp, I heard a commotion behind me and saw officers placing Quinn on the ground to place him in handcuffs. Dep. Eason, Ofc. Leahy, and Ofc. Valdes-Marrero laid Quinn facedown on the sidewalk and were trying to handcuff him, but he was holding his left arm in front of him. Quinn unintentionally rolled on Ofc. Valdes-Marrero's right leg, injuring it, as he was going to the ground. As a result, Ofc. Valdes-Marrero had to leave the group trying to handcuff Quinn. I got on the ground to pull Quinn's left arm out from under his body to maneuver it into place to be handcuffed behind his back. At this time Quinn began crying and screaming. We lifted Quinn and placed him in the backseat of my patrol car, where the in-car camera was activated. Quinn continued crying and screaming, and we requested an ambulance to evaluate him. KWFD R3 responded and transported Quinn (with Ofc. B. Leahy) to the emergency room at Lower Keys Medical Center.

Sgt. P. Rodriguez responded to the scene to document the take-down of the arrestee and the officer's injury.

Prior to being transported, Ofc. Leahy told me that he had told Quinn to place his hands behind his back to be handcuffed. Quinn began pulling his arms away, resisting multiple officers' attempts to place him in handcuffs.

Dep. Eason told me he heard Ofc. Leahy instruct Quinn to place his hands behind his back. First Quinn was going to comply, but then started pulling his arms away from officers and trying to brace to resist being handcuffed. Quinn was given verbal commands to stop resisting or he was going to get tazed. Quinn kept pulling away so they guided him to the ground.

Dep. Eason and Dep. Williams both stated when they were driving by the hotel, they observed both men on the ground actively fighting each other, and that both men were active participants in swinging and receiving punches.

I took pictures of both Sapp's and Quinn's physical appearance, and uploaded the pictures to Axon.

My BWC was activated and the footage also uploaded to Axon. My in-car camera video was uploaded as well.

While at the emergency room, Quinn continued to resist officers' and nurses' actions, resulting in Ofc. Leahy's exposure to bodily fluids, and an additional resisting without violence charge. Sgt. Rodriguez responded to the emergency room for further documentation purposes. See Ofc. Leahy's supplemental report for information regarding Quinn's second charge for resisting an officer without violence.

Based on Sapp admitting to me that he told his friend he would beat Quinn if he was located, and due to Sapp making the initial confrontation with Quinn, and that Quinn had a fresh laceration above his left eye, I have reason to believe Sapp actively and intentionally struck Quinn with the intent to cause bodily harm, in violation of F.S.S. 784.03(1A2).

Based on Deputies Williams and Eason witnessing Quinn actively engaged in fighting with Sapp, I placed Quinn under arrest for disorderly conduct, in violation of F.S.S. 877.03.

As Quinn actively resisted officers' attempts to facilitate the arrest by pulling away and bracing to resist being handcuffed, and due to further resisting behavior at the emergency room, I have reason to believe Quinn resisted an officer without violence, in violation of F.S.S. 843.02.

This case is closed with an arrest for Sapp.

I will be obtaining a warrant for Quinn's arrest at a later date as he was admitted to the hospital for psychiatric evaluation.

On 05/17/2020, at approximately 1439 hours, I, Officer Leahy responded to 3850 North Roosevelt Blvd to assist Monroe County Sheriff Deputies.

Upon arrival, I observed three MCSO deputies, two white males and a black male. I learned through further investigation MCSO deputies observed the two white males engaged in a fist fight.

Officer A. Anglin, Officer Valdez Marrero, Officer Kasyanenko arrived on scene.

While Officer A. Anglin was conducting her investigation, I approached the one white male, later identified as Lee Quinn (suspect). I observed Quinn sitting on the sidewalk. I observed Quinn to have a small laceration above his left eye. I observed blood on Quinn's face. I observed Quinn talking loud about the incident. I asked Quinn if he needed rescue to respond to the scene. Quinn said, "Hey fuck you bro." I said, Excuse me." Quinn said, "Fuck you, fuck you, lock me up I don't give a fuck. Having knowledge Quinn was already going to be arrested for mutual battery, I told Quinn to put his hands behind his back. I had Quinn stand up. During his fight with the other white male his pants was ripped during the altercation, so when he stood up, he let his pants fall to his ankles exposing his naked body. I told Quinn to place his hands behind his back or he would be TASED. As I took hold of Quinn's right arm, I could feel him tensing up. I told Quinn not to resist me. Quinn said, "I'm holding my arms I'm not resisting. Quinn continued to hold his arms tight together thwarting my efforts to handcuff him. With the help of deputies and Officers Valdez Marrero we were able to get Quinn off balance and onto the ground. Officer Valdez Marrero unfortunately was in a position where his leg was caught under Quinn subsequently taking on the weight of Quinn, myself and the other deputies as we went to the ground. I heard Officer Marrero say, "Oh my leg." Quinn continued to resist our efforts handcuffing him, holding his left arm in front of him. We were able to finally place Quinn into handcuffs. While officers and deputies held down Quinn, I retrieved a hobble from my vehicle. I hobbled Quinn's ankles so he could not kick and to keep him off balance. We picked up Quinn and placed him into the back of Officer A. Anglin's patrol vehicle.

Quinn complained of a concussion, a heart attack and a severed spine.

Key West Rescue arrived on scene to evaluate Quinn. Key West Rescue determined Quinn needed to go to the hospital. Quinn was transported to Lower Keys Medical Center.

During Quinn's arrest, my body worn camera was knocked to the ground. I retrieved my BWC. and continued to record the incident.

I road with Key West Rescue to Lower Keys Medical Center.

Upon arrival at Lower Keys Medical Center, Quinn was placed in a bed in the emergency room. Quinn was still hobbled and handcuffed. Emergency Room (ER) staff needed to inject Quinn with medicine so they could treat him. I assisted the ER nurse and moved Quinn to his side so the injection could be administered. After the injection was administered. Quinn stayed in a seated position. The ER nurse needed for Quinn to lay down. I kept asking Quinn to lay down on the bed and he refused. Quinn lost all self-control, screaming and shouting. As a one-point Quinn screamed at me, spitting blood onto my face and person. Quinn moved forward while screaming as if he was trying to get off the bed. I grabbed Quinn by the hair and pulled him back into the bed. Quinn continued to try and get up, while screaming and cursing at me. I placed my left hand under Quinn's chin area. I pushed Quinn's head towards the wall so he could not spit blood on me anymore. Unfortunately, Quinn continued to spit towards me until a face mask could be placed on Quinn. The only security guard at the hospital arrived to assist me in holding Quinn down. Officers Valdez Marrero, Dehanas and MCSO deputies arrived on scene to help secure Quinn. I retrieved a spit mask and provided it to MCSO Deputy Eason who placed the mask on Quinn.

I was admitted and treated at the hospital for my exposure.

The incident was captured on my AXON BWC.

On Thursday, May 21, 2020 at 1200 hours, I (Ofc. A. Anglin) was dispatched to DePoo Hospital, regarding Lee C. Quinn being released. Ofc. A. Rodriguez responded to assist.

I met Quinn as he was being released from DePoo and informed him of his active warrant resulting from the incident that occurred on Sunday 5/17/20. I handcuffed Quinn and Ofc. Rodriguez conducted a search of his person. Quinn was then placed in my patrol car for transport to Monroe County Detention Center.

During the drive to the jail, Quinn first stated the incident on Sunday was mostly a bike accident as the other male (Sapp) had hit Quinn with his bicycle. I informed Quinn that Sapp had told us there was a previous altercation on Stock Island prior to us finding them fighting on N. Roosevelt Blvd. Quinn first stated there had only been an argument between Quinn and another male. Then Quinn stated the other male (who had a cast on his leg) slapped Quinn, and Quinn had pushed him back.

At the jail, Quinn requested I take some pictures of bruises that resulted from the fight with Sapp, which I did. I took four pictures of Quinn, including his right hip, left abdomen, inside right bicep, and inside left bicep.

Quinn also stated he planned on dropping charges against Sapp for any battery that had taken place against himself.

I uploaded these four pictures, my in-car camera, and my BWC for today's encounter with Quinn.
