My husband, Fred Covan, and I are currently out of the country. We have just heard about the huge project which is proposed at the corner of First and N. Roosevelt. Not only will it be an eyesore at what is currently a very attractive spot adjacent to Garrison Bight, it is totally and completely unfair to the rest of us who are required to obey City laws and regulations to allow the owner of the property to bypass the Planning Board and disobey the height, density, impervious surface and parking regulations with which the rest of us comply. There are plenty of other available spaces for a "storage facility." This is an extremely visible, well-trafficked, attractive location and turning it into an industrial-looking site is certain to reduce the value of the properties we own on First/Fogarty and the other we own on Seidenberg/George. We are unable to attend the meeting today but want you to know that we very strongly oppose this and the insult it is to those of us who obey the rules.
