

I was a former city official in Illinois, so I have been in your position and I know what it's like to be in your shoes.

BECAUSE I have been in your position, it struck me as unusual to Amend the City Code in this manner. Then I learned that the Governor's State of Emergency expires on Friday and he is likely not going to renew it. AHA! Now I understand why you are choosing to amend the city code instead of an uncodified, temporary Ordinance.

If you look on this picture, taken last night from the Covid Action Dashboard for Florida, it shows the following information regarding the last two weeks of local data, as it applies to the state's reopening plan, and if Monroe County meets the criteria to move into the next phase of reopening:

Does Monroe County meet the following criteria?

- Decrease in ER visits for Covid like Illnesses Yes a Decrease of 33%
- Decrease in new cases by date Yes a decrease by 44%
- Decrease in % positivity Yes a decrease of 27% the chart shows the recommended range of less than 10%
