








Diameter: 22.6"

Location: 60% (growing in street planter with ATT utility box within 5 ft of

base of tree and utility lines overhead) Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 40% (poor, tree unbalanced-portion of tree torn off in Hurricane

Irma, all the growth and weight of tree is over parking area and road. Damage to main tree trunk in several area-potential fail lcoations.)

Total Average Value = 73%

**Value x Diameter = 14.9 replacement caliper inches**
