


Photo showing whole tree. Note that Fiddlewood tree on left and Geiger tree on right to remain.




Photo showing tree trunks and canopy, view 1.





Diameter: 7.3"

Location: 70% (canopy growth impacted by two adjacent trees-growing next

to large Geiger and Fiddlewood tree.)

Species: 50% (not on protected or not protected tree list) Condition: 50% (overall fair, older tree, growth lean of tree)

Total Average Value = 60%

Value x Diameter = 4.3 replacement caliper inches
