Citizen Review Board,

On June 26, 2020, the Key West Police Department received a complaint from Mr. John Aydent Jr. through the Citizen Review Board. Mr. Aydent explained his son Nicholas Aydent (age 27), who has a history of Epilepsy, had a seizure while walking his dog. Mr. Aydent stated in his compliant that his son was tased four times before being handcuffed. Mr. Aydent believes the use of the taser is harmful due to his son's condition.

As a result of this complaint, I conducted an inquiry into this incident. I reviewed the incident report and body worn camera (BWC) videos related to the incident.

On June 5, 2020 Nicholas Aydent's neighbor, Mike (unknown last name), called 911 after witnessing Nicholas having a seizure. Key West Fire/Rescue responded to the location. Upon their arrival, rescue personnel attempted to evaluate Nicholas. Nicholas became combative with them then ran away from them. At that time, rescue personnel requested an officer to respond. Officer Thomas Haynie and Officer Andrew Litton responded. Ofc. Haynie's BWC footage shows rescue personnel attempting to talk to Nicholas and asking him to sit down. Nicholas appeared frantic and out of breath. He was shirtless and had no shoes on as well. Nicholas began walking away again, so Ofc. Haynie grabbed Nicholas by the left arm. Nicholas attempted to break free from Ofc. Haynie's grip and tried to pry Ofc. Haynie's hands off of him. Officer Litton grabbed Nicholas' right arm and they were briefly able to get Nicholas to sit on the ground. Nicholas then stood up and broke free from the officers' grip. The officers struggled with Nicholas for a few moments. It should be noted the brief struggle to get Nicholas under control caused all three of them to move into the roadway (Northside Drive) and there was vehicle traffic approaching them. When Nicholas began to run away from the officers, Ofc. Haynie gave Nicholas verbal commands to stop or he would be tased. Nicholas did not stop and continued running. Ofc. Haynie deployed his Taser, striking

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Nicholas in the back, and Nicholas fell to the ground. It is important to note this was done for the protection of Nicholas. Due to his altered mental state it appeared he was unaware of traffic and could easily have ran in front of a moving vehicle, causing serious injury or death. The officers attempted to gain control of Nicholas and secure him in handcuffs. Nicholas continued to struggle with the officers and would not listen to their commands to place his hands behind his back. Ultimately, Ofc. Haynie delivered four additional Taser cycles until they were able to get Nicholas secured in handcuffs. Once Nicholas was in handcuffs, he continued to struggle with the officers. Rescue personnel eventually sedated Nicholas and transported him to the hospital for further evaluation.

After completing this inquiry, I have determined the actions of Officer Haynie and Officer Litton were within Key West Police Department policies and procedures pertaining to the use of the Taser. However, all officers are trained to constantly reassess an active response to resistance situation and recognize whether their response is achieving the desired outcome; which is safely securing a resisting subject in handcuffs. In the video, it is clear that Nicholas continued to struggle with the officers after each five second Taser cycle; indicating the Taser was not affecting Nicholas. The video also showed Officer Haynie and Officer Litton demonstrated a lack of proper technique in physically controlling Nicholas prior to and after the use of the Taser. As a result of this, Officer Haynie and Officer Litton did receive a supervisor's counseling regarding this incident and they will be receiving remedial training on the proper mechanics of physically controlling a resisting subject.

Although we sympathize with Nicholas, and understand the seriousness of his medical condition, the officers still had an obligation to ensure he received proper medical care. Nicholas' altered mental state was preventing him from understanding that the officers and rescue personnel were there to provide him with medical care. They could not allow Nicholas to leave on his own and risk further injury.

		CONTRACTOR SOLUTION AND ADDRESS.

On Thursday, June 4, 2020 at 7:57 PM, Officer Litton and I were dispatched to the Mariner's Cove Apartments at 3330 Northside Drive for a medical assist. The reporting party, who didn't leave information, told Key West Dispatch his neighbor was having a seizure outside. The reporting party stated his neighbor's face was banged up and he observed blood. Key West Rescue arrived before us and requested for us to expedite as they were out with a known combative patient.

Officer Litton and I arrived at 7:59 PM. I observed the patient, later identified as Nicholas Aydent, stumbling down the sidewalk, heading west, in front of the Santa Clara Condominiums at 3312 Northside Drive. I observed an EMT walking behind Nicholas. Nicholas was shirtless, covered in sweat, mumbling incoherently, and had a dazed looked on his face. Nicholas stopped in front of my police car, which I parked on the sidewalk. I exited the car and observed the EMT trying to reason with Nicholas. It was obvious Nicholas was having a medial issue and if we didn't assist rescue in detaining him, he would have been a harm to himself. Nicholas told the EMT he was ok and just needed help. I also tried reasoning with Nicholas. I asked if he would, "please let them take care of you". Nicholas stumbled between my police car and the fence at the Santa Clara Condominiums. I went around the back of my car and grabbed Nicholas while giving loud verbal commands. Officer Litton and I grabbed Nicholas' wrists and assisted him to the ground, in a seated position. Nicholas mumbled incoherently and pulled away from us the whole time. After a few seconds of being on the ground, Nicholas got back up and slipped from our grip, then fell into a bush. Officer Litton and I grabbed Nicholas once again. He swung around and escaped our grip again then began running down the sidewalk. I ran after Nicholas, warned him I would deploy my Taser, then deployed my Taser after he continued running. The Taser probes struck Nicholas in the middle of his back. Nicholas' body responded to the Taser and went into neuromuscular incapacitation. Nicholas fell to the ground. After the Taser cycle ran out, Nicholas continued to struggle with Officer Litton and I. I gave several loud verbal commands for Nicholas to put his hands behind his back. Nicholas continued tensing his arms and swinging them away from us. I deployed four more Taser cycles. After every cycle, Nicholas continued to struggle. After the last cycle we were able to handcuff Nicholas on both wrists. After I handcuffed Nicholas, I straddled his lower back and maintained control of his hands. I asked Nicholas several times if he was ok and encouraged him to relax.

Key West Rescue sedated Nicholas. I assisted Key West Rescue with placing Nicholas onto a stretcher. Sergeant Kouri responded to the scene and collected the necessary information for a response to resistance report.

Officer Litton and I responded to the emergency room at the Lower Keys Medical Center and stood by with Nicholas. After around thirty minutes, Nicholas came to. Nicholas was apologetic and didn't remember what happened. Nicholas' dad, John Aydent, was at the emergency room. John told us Nicholas had Epilepsy and suffered from "Focal Awareness" seizures. One of the EMT's told me they struggled with Nicholas before we arrived. The EMT said Nicholas had a t-shirt on which slipped off in the struggle.

Officer Litton photographed Nicholas' injuries. Nicholas had abrasions on his shoulders, knees and elbows. I collected the Taser cartridge and AFIDS and submitted them as evidence.

I activated my KWPD issued bodycam and in-car Coban during this call.

On 06/04/2020 at approximately 2000 hours, Officer T. Haynie and (Ofc. A. Litton) were dispatched to 3330 Northside Drive, Mariner's Cove, in reference to a medical assist. Key West Rescue 3 advised they needed officers to expedite so I activated my overhead lights and sirens.

While driving down Northside Drive, I was flagged down by Key West Rescue as he followed a shirtless male subject, later identified as Nicholas Aydent, towards Santa Clara Condominiums. When I exited the vehicle, Key West Rescue advised Aydent was a seizure patient and was postictal. Aydent was making incoherent statements, saying he was okay followed by stating he needed help. Aydent appeared to be in an altered state of consciousness and could not follow or understand the commands given by the EMT, Officer T. Haynie or myself.

At one point, Aydent appeared to comply with the orders given and he began to sit down on the sidewalk. Aydent then quickly jumped to his feet and continued to walk down Northside Drive. Officer T. Haynie grabbed Aydent's arm while I grabbed his other and we assisted Aydent to a seated position. Aydent attempted to stand up and I again assisted him back to a seated position. Then, Aydent managed to get to his feet while flailing his arms, which slipped out of both my and Ofc. T. Haynie's hands causing Aydent to fall into the bushes next to the sidewalk. Aydent stood up and both Officer T. Haynie and I attempted to take Aydent to the ground, but I could not obtain a grip on Aydent's sweaty wrist or arm. Aydent slipped away from us and ran West on Northside Drive when Officer T. Haynie deployed his Taser into Aydent's back. Officer T. Haynie achieved neuromuscular incapacitation and Aydent fell to the ground.

Aydent continued to be noncompliant as we attempted to place him in handcuffs. Officer T. Haynie deployed additional cycles of his Taser until the handcuffs were secured on Aydent's wrists. Key West Rescue informed me they have had previous medical calls with Aydent on multiple occasions and he has similar reactions whenever he is postictal. Aydent was held on the ground until EMTs administered ketamine. Aydent was then placed into the ambulance and transported to Lower Keys Medical Center and I followed.

Aydent's father, Jack Aydent, was already at the hospital waiting for us. Jack informed me of Nicholas' epileptic condition and advised he has focal awareness seizures, which do not resemble the typical seizures associated with epilepsy. Jack explained Nicholas is mobile and conscious during his seizures, where he will walk or sometimes run in an aimless manner. Nicholas will remain unaware of his surroundings during these seizures.

Nicholas Aydent suffered minor abrasions on his shoulders, elbows, and knees during this incident. Aydent began to regain his awareness after about 30 minutes in the hospital, when he was able to sustain a conversation with his father, Officer T. Haynie and myself. Aydent remained under care at the Lower Keys Medical Center when I cleared.
