On Sunday, July 26, 2020, at 0021 hours, Sgt. Vazquez, Officer Litton, and I (Officer Morris) were dispatched to 1704 Jamaica Drive, reference an intoxicated male.

Upon arrival, we were flagged down by the reporting party, Kim Chew Kwan (DOB 11/22/1976). Kim directed us toward her home, 1704 Jamaica Drive. Kim said there was a large male in her yard that was refusing to leave. Kim's home was surrounded by a four-foot chain length fence. The fence had a gate in the driveway in the front of the property. The gate had been pushed in and there was a large white male pacing back and forth in her yard. Sgt. Vazquez asked the male to exit the property to talk to us. The male said no, because we were going to arrest him for drug abuse. The male identified himself as Lazaro. Sgt. Vazquez again asked Lazaro to exit the property and talk to us. Sgt. Vazquez asked KWPD Dispatch to send rescue. Lazaro said he had taken acid and cocaine and he said he was very "high."

Sgt. Vazquez told Lazaro to exit the property. Lazaro said he didn't want to leave the property because he said we were going to tackle him into a fence. Sgt. Vazquez reassured Lazaro and asked him to just relax. Sgt. Vazquez, Officer Litton, and I stepped inside the fence. Lazaro placed his hands behind his back on his own and said he was going to kneel onto the ground. Sgt. Vazquez told Lazaro to kneel onto the ground and place his hands behind his back and Lazaro refused. Due to the numerous attempts to have Lazaro exit the property willingly, Sgt. Vazquez approached Lazaro and placed his hand on Lazaro's left arm in an attempt to place Lazaro into custody reference trespassing. Officer Litton attempted to grab Lazaro's right arm. Lazaro violently broke from their grasp, took a bladed stance, and stepped aggressively towards Officers. It appeared Lazaro was intending to offer violence towards Officers. Lazaro ran toward the open gate in an attempt to flee. Sgt. Vazquez drew and deployed his departmental TASER hitting Lazaro on the right side of his chest. The TASER deployment did not achieve Neuromuscular Incapacitation (NMI). Lazaro continued to run toward the street in an attempt to flee. I told Lazaro to get onto the ground. Lazaro who now was approaching the road dropped to the ground and rolled onto his stomach. Officer Litton and I handcuffed Lazaro and rolled him onto his side. KWFR 3 responded to the scene and transported Lazaro to the Lower Keys Medical Center for evaluation. I identified Lazaro as Lazaro Prieto (DOB 11/12/1996) by his Florida Driver's license.

Search incident to arrest, Officer Litton located two small clear plastic bags in Lazaro's front left pocket containing white powder. Officer Litton suspected the powder to be cocaine. Officer Litton field tested the white powder and it tested positive for cocaine. Officer Litton weighed the FTP cocaine and it weighed 0.6 grams.

Lazaro was cleared from the hospital and I transported him to the Monroe County Detention Center. Lazaro was denied at MCDC for an elevated heart rate. KWFR 3 responded and transported Lazaro back to the LKMC. Lazaro was again cleared medically from the LKMC and transported back to the MCDC without further incident.

Arrest information.

Based on the facts and evidence, there is probable cause that on 7/26/2020, at 0021, Lazaro Prieto (DOB 11/12/1996), did knowingly and intentionally possess 0.6 grams of FTP cocaine, in violation of F.S.S. 893.13-6A Possession of Cocaine.

Based on the facts and evidence, there is probable cause that on 7/26/2020, at 0021, Lazaro Prieto (DOB 11/12/1996), did knowingly and intentionally enter onto the property of Kim Kwan without authorization and refuse to leave, in violation of F.S.S. 810.09 TRESPASS ON PROPERTY OTHER THAN STRUCTURE OR

CONVEYANCE.

Based on the facts and evidence, there is probable cause that on 7/26/2020, at 0021, Lazaro Prieto (DOB 11/12/1996), did knowingly and intentionally resist arrest by pulling away from officers, Lazaro squared his body towards myself and the other officers with his fists raised, offering violence, and attempted to flee officers while placing him into custody, in violation of F.S.S. 843.01 RESIST / OBSTRUCT OFFICER WITH VIOLENCE.

I placed Sgt. Vazquez's TASER cartridge and AFIDS into KWPD Property and Evidence.

The incident was captured on my AXON BWC and in car COBAN.

On 07/26/2020 at approximately 0030 hours, Sergeant B. Vazquez, Officer C. Morris and I (Ofc. A. Litton) were dispatched to 1704 Jamaica Drive in reference to an intoxicated subject trespassing on the property.

When I arrived, Lazaro Prieto was standing in the driveway shouting at Sergeant B. Vazquez and Ofc. C. Morris. After talking for some time, Prieto would not follow any commands and showed no sign of complying. Prieto was standing with his hands behind his back and Ofc. C. Morris and I moved in to detain him. Prieto pushed us off, created space, turned to the officers and squared up. Sergeant B. Vazquez drew his Taser and fired at Prieto, striking him in the chest. Prieto ran out of the yard and I followed before he laid on the street and complied. I handcuffed Prieto behind his back and double locked the cuffs. Prieto stated he took acid and was very high.

Prieto was transported to Lower Keys Medical Center by Key West Rescue and I rode in the ambulance with him. Prieto talked the entire ride to the hospital and stated he had two bags of cocaine in his front, left pocket. After we arrived at the hospital, Prieto again stated he had cocaine in the deep corner of his front left pocket. I reached into his pocket and pulled out two clear, knotted bags both containing a white powdery substance. I took the bags to the Key West Police Department where the white, powdery substance field tested positive for cocaine. I placed the bags and white, powdery substance into Key West Police Property to be submitted to FDLE for analysis. I took photos of the bags and white substance and uploaded them to Evidence.com.

On Sunday July 26th, 2020, at about 0021 hours, Ofc. Morris, Ofc. Litton and I, Sgt. Vazquez responded to 1704 Jamaica Drive, in reference to an intoxicated male who was causing a disturbance.

Upon arrival, the caller, Kim Chew Kwan waved me down, while pointing to her residence, 1704 Jamaica Dr. I parked my patrol car and began to approach on foot. I was met by a belligerent male, later identified as Lazaro Prieto. Prieto was screaming and obviously creating a disturbance in front of Kwan's residence. Prieto and I began to converse. Based on my training and experience, I believed Prieto to be under the influence of narcotics and or alcohol. Prieto appeared to be in an altered state of mind. Due to theses circumstances, I requested KWFd rescue to stage in the area. I continued using verbal communication in attempt to have Prieto exit the property, he refused. After numerous attempts, I approached Prieto to place him in custody. I grabbed his left arm, while Ofc. Litton grabbed his right. Prieto violently broke from our grasp, took a bladed stance, and stepped aggressively towards us. Prieto suddenly escalated his resistance from active resistance to aggressive resistance, it was clear Prieto was about to physically attack officers on scene. Given these facts, I deployed my department issued Taser. The Taser probes struck Prieto in the left side of his chest. Given the short distance between Prieto and I, the Taser did not achieve NMI. Due to this Prieto was able to run off of the property, and into the street. Prieto ran about 30 feet. I gave chase on foot. Prieto eventually fell to the ground. I gave loud verbal commands for him to stay down, and to put his hands behind his back. Prieto eventually complied and was handcuffed without further incident.

Prieto admitted to taking Acid, Cocaine, and drinking alcohol.

I retrieved Kwan's information to add to the report.

Prieto was transported to the hospital to be medically cleared.

Ofc. Litton and Ofc. Morris took over the investigation.
