**Subject:** Approve Work Order for Pavement Marking, Striping & Roadway Signage

### **ACTION STATEMENT**

Award a Work Order in the amount of \$54,531.39 to Charlie Toppino and Sons, Inc. (CTS) for pavement marking inclusive of all ROW and permitting fees. Authorize City Manager to execute this agreement.

### **BACKGROUND**

Resolution 20-095 approved the CTS unit price bid to provide work on a task order basis in response to ITB 20-007: *Pavement Marking, Striping and Roadway Signage*. Streets to be striped under this work order: Geraldine (Fort to Emma), Emma (Amelia to Angela) and Northside Drive (18<sup>th</sup> Terr to Toppino Dr). Work will be in accordance with FDOT standards and CKW Code of Ordinances Chapter 70, Article IV, Division 5 *Residential Parking Permit Program* and Resolution 18-294 "*setting forth the percentage of Residential parking spaces per block.*"

### **PURPOSE AND JUSTIFICATION**

This resolution supports Strategic Plan, Infrastructure, Goal #1: *A transportation system which is aesthetically attractive, functional, efficient, safe and environmentally sensitive.*

### **FINANCIAL**

The Work Order sum of \$54,531.39 will be funded from account 102 4102 541 4600, Project #II41022003 *Pavement Marking, Striping & Roadway Signage*. Funding is available in the FY 2020 budget.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends awarding a Work Order in the amount of \$54,531.39 to Charlie Toppino and Sons, Inc. for pavement marking inclusive of all ROW and permitting fees. Authorize City Manager to execute this agreement.
