A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE KEY WEST ART CENTER TO CONDUCT AN ART SHOW ON SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 27, 2021 AND SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 28, 2021 DURING THE HOURS OF 10:00 A.M. TO 5:00 P.M; (SET UP 5:00 A.M.) AT THE TRUMAN WATERFRONT QUAY WALL; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, The Key West Art Center wishes to conduct an Art Show on the day and during the hours stated above, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida;

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law"

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use or distribution of single-use polystyrene/plastic items, including but not limited to single-use polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City"

SECTION 3. That the Key West Art Center is hereby granted permission to conduct an Art Show on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and provided the organizations meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That the Key West Art Center is hereby granted permission to use the Truman Waterfront Quay Wall on the date and during the hours stated above.

SECTION 5. That the Key West Art Center will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 6. That the applicant acknowledges this authorization may be revoked by this Commission or the City Manager, due to exigent circumstances such as the resurgence of COVID-19 in the Community.
