A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION GRANT AGREEMENT" (PTGA) BETWEEN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) AND THE CITY OF KEY WEST FOR STATE TRANSIT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR SFY (STATE FISCAL YEAR) 2021 FOR OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE FIXED ROUTE BUS TRANSIT SYSTEM IN KEY WEST IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$293,546.00 (50% OF THE TOTAL PROGRAM COST OF \$587,092.00) [FDOT FINANCIAL PROJECT NUMBER 436702-2-84-01, CONTRACT #G1Q24]; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET AJDUSTMENTS OR AMENDMENTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE;

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation, via State Transit Block Grant Program, provides funding assistance for operating expenses of the fixed route bus transit system in an amount not to exceed 50% of the total project cost at \$587,092.00, or reimbursement of up to \$293,546.00 in operating assistance; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution 19-344, the City Commission authorized certain members of City staff to apply for and accept grant funding, and to execute and submit grant documentation through the Transit Award Management System (TRAMS) and FDOT; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached "Public Transportation Grant Agreement" (Contract G1Q24/FM #436702-2-84-01) is hereby approved, between FDOT and the City, for State Transit Block Grant Program funding assistance for SFY 2021 for operating expenses of the fixed route bus transit system in an amount not to exceed \$293,546.00 (50% of the program cost).

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized execute any necessary documents to effectuate this grant agreement, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3: That any necessary budget transfers or adjustments that are necessary to accept this grant are hereby authorized.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
