Public Art Projects: [November updates in blue –](#)

1. **Truman Waterfront Park – Master Arts Plan Accepted! We are “done” with our ongoing input – we will work with the Parks & Rec Board to advance the goals and action steps in the plan.**
2. **1400 Duval Park/Mall – 5 sculptures installed! New signs also ordered and installed. Final sculpture – John Martini’s “Blue Teacher” (gift from Timyan family) to be installed in November. Press release also complete. Paperwork for Finance department submitted for the artist’s honorariums – payments pending. Working with Enid of HARC and city staff, and artist Reen Stanhouse for an iron/metal permanent park sign to replace temporary sign.**
3. **KW Seaport Public Art project – RFP has been approved and final edits completed by Administrator. Need to determine best release and due date – has been paused due to Covid-19. Do not have a release date yet.**
4. **Mallory Square – Working with Steve McAlearney and Patti McLaughlin at the City Manager’s direction to have a Call for Designs for new gateway signage. Ongoing**
5. **Zero Duval Street - Private/City– Meeting scheduled for Nov. 4<sup>th</sup> with Planning Director to review Fury Watersports/ Wonderdog Studios design proposal.**
6. **Douglass Gym – No updates – waiting on revised plans to be approved by the City Commission –**
7. **Private/Public – CHI Health Clinic at Douglass Band Room – following BVRAC, HARC and Commission meetings – working with Marianne Finizio to determine 1% and best practices for calls for proposals for 1% for public art as the Clinic is now a MDP.**
8. **AIPP Ordinance review – will to set up a meeting with Marianne and City Assistant Attorney, George Wallace. Will schedule a mutual date to meet in November**
9. **Private -The Capitana – approved and completed email follow-up – project on schedule.**
10. **Private - 725 Duval St – no updates 1% private – major development restoration**
11. **Collections Management – will work with City staff to create and update City collection/inventory app ready to go, need to work with each board member -ongoing**
12. **Ongoing Projects spreadsheet – ongoing –**
13. **Gift from Timyan family – in process - 2 sculptures approved by AIPP Board (Sept 2020) for restoration by the artist. Mr. John Martini is in possession of the 2 sculptures and will complete maintenance/restoration and will transport and install when complete. One for Truman Waterfront Park and the other for loan to 1400 Duval Park**
14. **Possible long-term loan of a Frank Stella sculpture for Truman Waterfront Park – No updates**
15. **FAPAP Webinar – on legal issues with monuments presented by attorney Anne Dalton – via zoom on Thursday November 5<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 am. Next webinar set for January.**
