On 10/07/2020, at approximately 1856 hours, I (Ofc. R. Perez) was dispatched to the intersection of Whitehead St. and Truman Ave. in reference to a reckless driver.

Upon arrival, I was advised that the driver was a Hispanic male, who was driving a red Nissan Xterra had left the area. I looked for the driver on Whitehead St. and was unable to locate him. I then looked for the driver on Duval St. As I approached the intersection of Duval St. and Angela St. I noticed that traffic was being held up. I activated my emergency lights and drove around the traffic to try and see what was obstructing the road. As I approached Aqua Nightclub, I noticed a Hispanic male wearing a white shirt and gray sweatpants, out of his vehicle, in the street, screaming obscenities in Spanish at the performers standing in front of Aqua. The male was later identified by his Florida DL as Roberto Ulesias-Cedeno. I attempted to pull over Ulesias-Cedeno for obstructing traffic. Ulesias-Cedeno then ran to his vehicle, got in and drove 50 feet south on Duval St. and pulled over in front of 716 Duval St. Ulesias-Cedeno got out of his vehicle, I advised him to get back in his vehicle and he complied. When I approached the vehicle, Ulesias-Cedeno was screaming obscenities at me and stated that he is hunting me. I asked Ulesias - Cedeno for his driver's license, he handed it to me and then swung his driver side door open attempting to strike me with it.

I told Ulesias-Cedeno several times to step out of his vehicle due to him attempting to strike me with his car door and for his disorderly actions in front of Aqua Nightclub. Ulesias refused to step out of his vehicle, i attempted to remove Ulesias-Cedeno out of his vehicle, he resisted and scratched my hands in the process. Ulesias-Cedeno then reached out and opened the glove box of his vehicle without being instructed to do so. Ulesias-Cedeno reached inside attempting to grab something out of the glove box. I drew my firearm and had it in the low ready position. I told Ulesias-Cedeno not to reach into his glove box, when he realized I had my firearm drawn he stopped reaching and brought his arms back toward his body. I then placed my firearm when back in its holster when he complied. Ofc. Ham arrived on scene and assisted me in removing Ulesias-Cedeno from his vehicle. Ulesias-Cedeno was still attempting to pull away outside of his vehicle, I wrapped my arms around his midsection and performed a modified leg sweep to get him to the ground. Ulesias-Cedeno was placed in handcuffs double locked, searched and placed in the back seat of my marked patrol vehicle.

Ofc. Ham got witness statements from two witnesses. The first witness was a black male later identified by his Florida DL as Kelby Thomas. Thomas stated he was outside of Aqua nightclub handing out fliers when Ulesias-Cedeno stopped his vehicle in the streets, got out of his vehicle and was screaming at the people outside of Aqua nightclub. Thomas stated Ulesias-Cedeno was holding up traffic and was then pulled over. The second witness was a white female later identified by her Florida DL as Susan K. Murphy. Murphy stated Ulesias-Cedeno stepped out of his vehicle, was blocking traffic and yelling at "drag queens" in Spanish. I arrived pulled Ulesias-Cedeno over and when I approached the vehicle i was called "puta" (bitch in Spanish) very loudly. when I attempted to remove Ulesias-Cedeno from his vehicle he swung his arm at me. Ofc. Ham arrived on scene and helped me remove him from his vehicle. Murphy stated that my taser was drawn but never pointed at Ulesias-Cedeno and it was quickly

rebolstered. The whole time we were on scene Ulesias-Cedeno was yelling at us in Spanish. Both witnesses are willing to cooperate in the prosecution of this case.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause, that on 10/07/2020, Roberto Ulesias-Cedeno, did knowingly and intentionally engage in conduct as to constitute a breach of the peace violating F.S.S. 877.03 Disorderly conduct. Furthermore Roberto Ulesias-Cedeno also scratched me and resisted violently while I attempted to place him under arrest violating F.S.S. 843.01 Resisting arrest with violence.

Ulesias-Cedeno was taken to the Monroe County Detention Center.

My Axon BWC was activated during this incident.

On October 7, 2020, at approximately 1856 hours, I, Ofc. S. Ham was dispatched to the corner of Truman Ave., and Whitehead St., reference a reckless driver.

Upon my arrival, the vehicle was no longer in the area, Ofc. R. Perez and I began searching for the vehicle. Ofc. Perez located the vehicle in front of 711 Duval St. and initiated a traffic stop.

Upon my arrival at the traffic stop, Ofc. Perez was attempting to have the suspect, later identified as Roberto Cedeno, step out of the vehicle. I approached the vehicle from the driver side and asked Ofc. Perez what the problem was. Ofc. Perez stated Cedeno struck him with the driver's side door and was acting very irate. Ofc. Perez stated Cedeno began reaching for the glove box after he told him not to. Ofc. Perez stated we needed to get him out of the vehicle.

Cedeno was not listening to Ofc. Perez's verbal commands. Ofc. Perez and I had to physically remove Cedeno from the vehicle. I had Cedeno by his left wrist and attempted to pull him out. Cedeno was pulling back and would not exit. Using my other hand, I was able to grab on to the back side of Cedeno and pull him out. Ofc. Perez grabbed Cedeno from behind and escorted him to the ground. I grabbed Cedeno's left wrist and brought it around to his back for Ofc. Perez to handcuff him. Ofc. Perez stated Cedeno reached for the glove box and believed he was possibly reaching for a weapon. Ofc. Perez and I escorted him to Ofc. Perez's vehicle.

I spoke to two witnesses, later identified as Kelby Thomas and Susan Murphy. Both witnesses filled out a Key West Police Department witness statement. Murphy stated she captured the video on her cell phone of the incident and would email it to me.

The vehicle was towed by Arnold's Towing.

I turned both witness statements into the Key West Police Department Records division.

My Axon BWC and Coban were activated and uploaded. The video captured by Murphy was uploaded to Evidence.com.
