It was brought to my attention that there is an item on the agenda this evening that will affect the welfare of animals in our city. I was not aware of this item and I feel it is important that the organizations that are charged with the protection and welfare of animals in the community have some input with respect to ordinances that may negatively affect animals.

There are two other organizations whose mission involves the care of cats in our community and I believe they will have strong opinions about this ordinance amendment.
