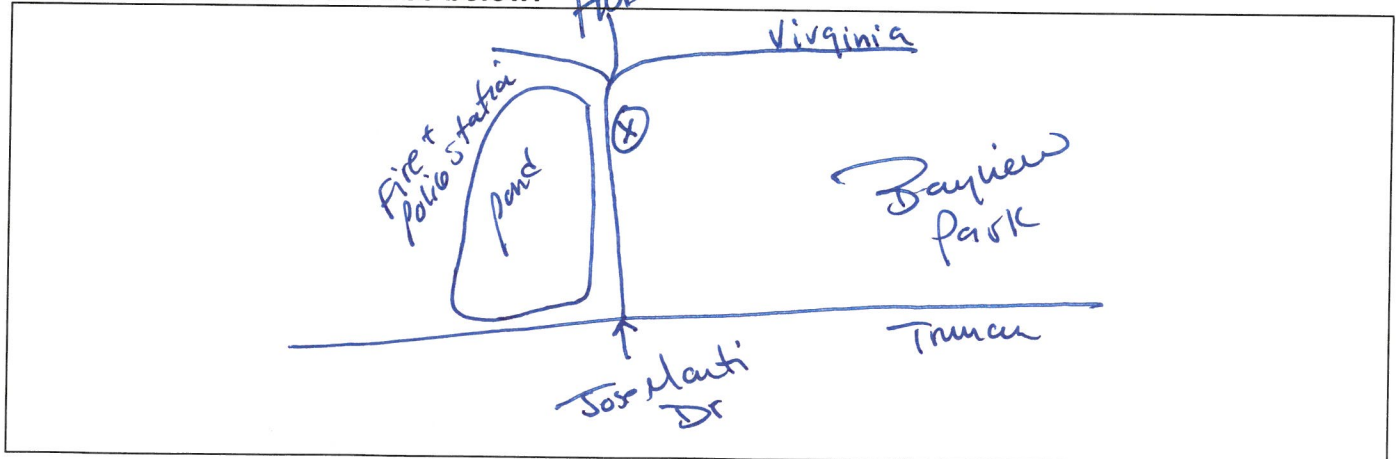

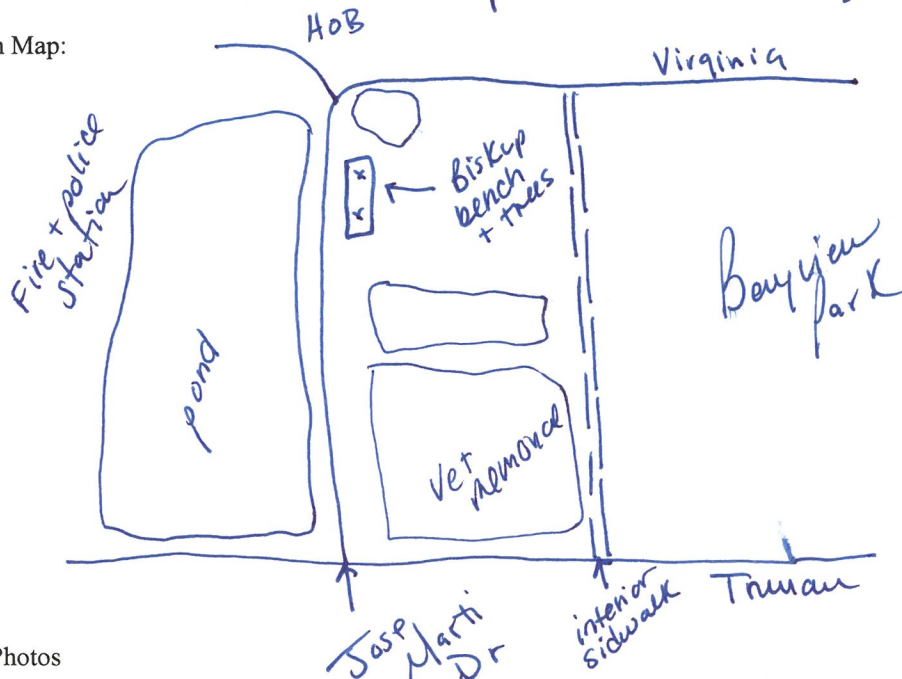

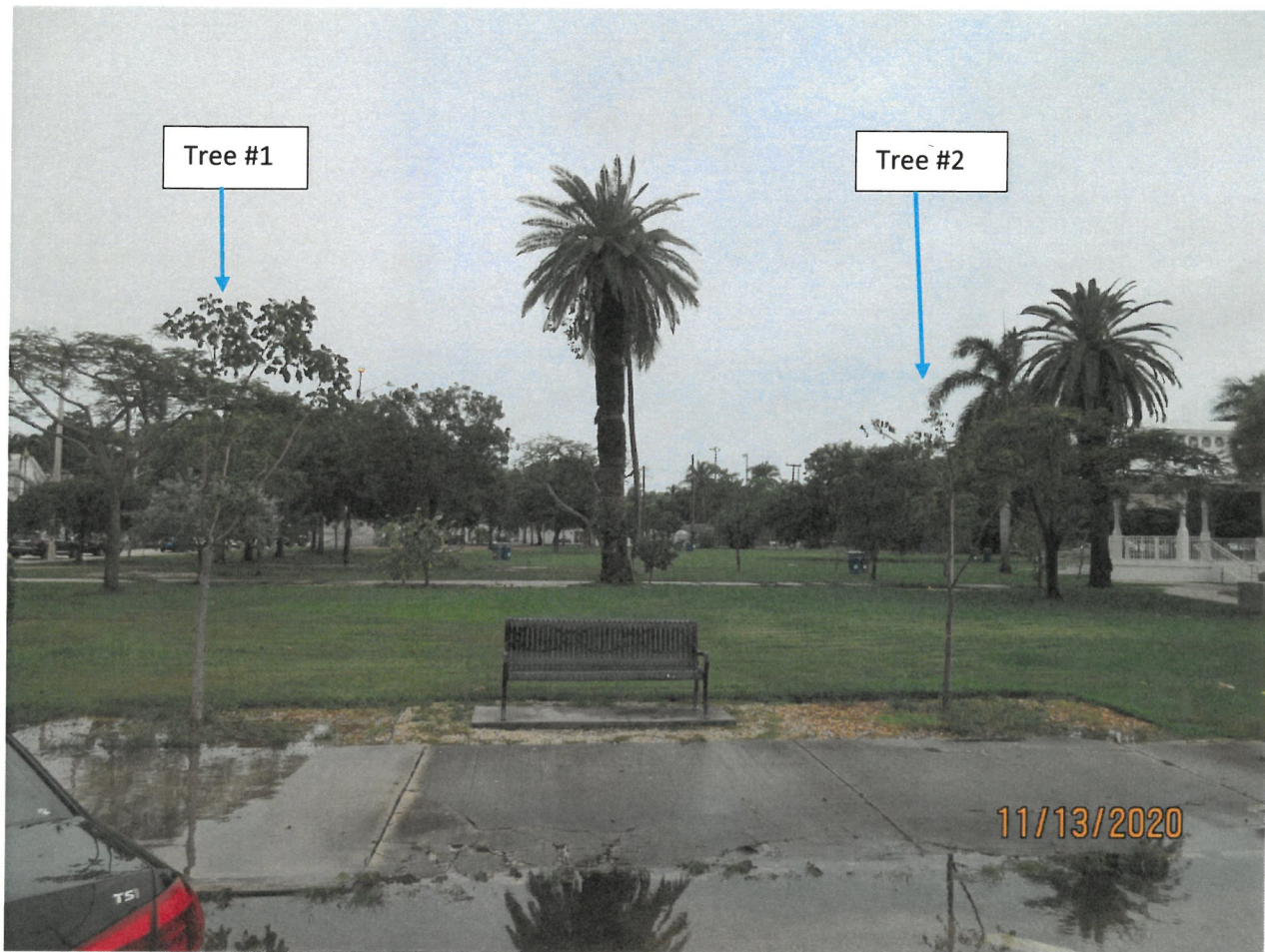

Sgt. Eric Marion Biskup, 49, passed a w a y peacefully at home on Saturday, Jan. 9, 2016 with friends and family by his side after fighting a courageous battle with pancreatic cancer.

For 20 years, Sgt. Biskup served the Key West Police Department with honor and dedication.

Originally from Chicago, he went into the Army after high school. Following his honorable discharge, he pursued a career in law enforcement, serving not only with the Key West Police Department, but with the New Orleans Police Department, the Satellite Beach Police Department and the Snohomish, Washington Sheriff's Department.

Eric loved the night watch and he loved Key West. He maintained his compassion through two decades of night

shifts, and his demeanor was highlighted on national television during a season of MTV's Cuff'd and on local radio. His personal tastes were eclectic: He loved Harleys and Volkswagens, he played the drums and guitar, he was a stargazer and a collector of all things Army. He was a warm, witty, smart, loyal friend who will be dearly missed.

Eric is survived by son Tyler (Mikayla), sister Christa Rosinski (John), and nephews Kurt Rosinski, Alex Rosinski (Melissa and son Owen). Eric's extended family is spread out across the country and in Germany. He also leaves behind his devoted fiancé, Laura Marzano, who stood by his side as he fought the ravages of cancer. In addition, he leaves behind his Key West Police Department family and a loyal army of friends who love and admire him. He was predeceased by parents Martin and Martha Biskup.

Two new trees now grace Bayview Park in honor of Sgt. Eric Biskup, who succumbed to cancer this month at the age of 49.

In an effort spearheaded by City Commissioner Sam Kaufman, the City's Community Services Department planted a rare cinnamon bark tree and a jatropa tree. A new bench was installed between the trees.

Rob Crider, owner of Just Keys Trees, Inc. generously donated the cinnamon bark tree.

"It's appropriate that it's right across from the police department," said Chief Donie Lee. "It's a place where we can come and sit for a moment and remember how Eric touched our lives."
