

Project Location

The project is located along SR 5/Whitehead Street from Fleming Street to Truman Avenue





Project Schedule and Cost

Total Construction Cost	\$1.7 million



The project is currently in 90% Design Phase.

- Work with municipalities to review plans
- Receive feedback from the public
- Transition project to the construction team



Project Scope

- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Providing new pavement markings
- Improving signage along the corridor
- Upgrading pedestrian signals, detectors, and ramps
- Reconstructing uplifted and broken portions of the sidewalk
- Enhancing handicapped parking and sight visibility at all intersections which has resulted in the removal of 5 parking spaces
- Upgrading existing Lighting to Lighting Emitting Diode (LED)





Maintenance of Traffic:

- Existing narrow travel lanes may provide limited space for trucks and other oversized vehicles during construction
- Temporary closure of side streets
- Vehicular detours
- Parking will be restricted within the work zones and final paving operation during construction





Project Phasing and Hours of Operation:

- Closure of Whitehead Street in both directions during the repaving phase
 - Work will be phased to limit the length of the closure to one block at a time
- Lane closures will be limited only between 9
 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday through Friday
- Work to take place from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday





Speed:

Existing 20 Mile Per Hour (MPH) limit will remain





- Sidewalk closures and detours for sidewalk replacement and pedestrian ramp improvements will be clearly marked
- Sidewalk work will only be performed one side of the road at a time





Dust:

The contractor will be required to water and sweep in order to minimize construction-related dust



Noise:

Some noise should be expected during daytime hours



Access:

Access to area property and businesses will maintain during construction
