WHEREAS, Simonton Street is an important connector for vehicles, bicycles and pedestrians, and this project will repair trench failures, rehabilitate the pavement surface, provide new pavement markings, ADA compliant sidewalks and curb ramps along Simonton Street from Truman Ave to the northern limits of Simonton Street; and

WHEREAS, two bids were received in response to ITB 20-002, with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. submitting the lowest bid; and

WHEREAS, City staff finds the lowest bid to be reasonable and responsible, and recommends award of the bid to Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. is hereby awarded in response to ITB 20-002 for Simonton Street Improvements, in an amount not to exceed \$1,435,129.25.

Section 2: That this project is funded from budget account 102-4102-541-6300 -- Project II41021901 FY 2019 ADA Sidewalks and Project No. II41021902 2019 Repairing Program, and any necessary budget adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract in substantial conformance with the bid documents upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.

ACTION STATEMENT

Award the contract for ITB #20-002 Simonton Street Improvements to Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. (CTS) in the amount of \$1,435,129.25. Authorize the City Manager to execute this agreement and any necessary budget transfers/amendments.

BACKGROUND

Per Resolution 18-195, a task order for design services was authorized to Keith and Schnars, P.A. The design included pavement rehabilitation, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) sidewalks, curb ramps and pavement markings along Simonton Street between Truman Avenue and the northern terminus of the street.

On September 3, 2019, city staff issued an Invitation to Bid (ITB #20-002) for the construction contract for the project. Bids were received and opened on October 2, 2019 in the office of the City Clerk. Bids were received from two firms: Charley Toppino and Sons, Inc. (CTS) and DN Higgins, Inc. The following is a summary of the bid results:

Based on review of bid results, CTS was determined to be the lowest responsive bidder.

PURPOSE AND JUSTIFICATION

Simonton Street is an important connection for vehicles, bicycles and pedestrians. Per the 2019 Pavement Management Plan the average Pavement Condition Index (PCI) for Simonton Street within the limits of the project is 38 which indicates the road is in very poor condition. Extensive trench failures and deferred maintenance have contributed to the poor condition of this road segment. The project will repair the trench failures, rehabilitate the pavement surface, provide new pavement markings, provide ADA compliant sidewalks and curb ramps along Simonton Street from Truman Avenue to the northern limits of Simonton Street.

This project supports the Key West Strategic Plan including meeting Infrastructure Goal #1, A transportation system which is aesthetically attractive, functional, efficient, safer and environmentally sensitive.

FINANCIAL

The contract amount of \$1,435,129.25 will be funded from Internal Improvements (Gas Tax)/ Streets / Professional Services account 102-4102-541-6300, Project # II41021902 (2019 Repaving Program). Upon approval, a purchase order will be issued to CTS for the not-to-exceed fee of \$1,435,129.25.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends awarding a construction contract for ITB #20-002 Simonton Street Improvements to Charley Toppino & Sons. in the amount of \$1,435,129.25 and authorizing the City Manager to execute this agreement and any necessary budget transfers/amendments.
