On 01/10/2021 at approximately 0030 hours, I (Ofc. A. Litton) was dispatched to Mary Ellen's Bar, 420 Appelrouth Lane, in reference to a customer refusing to leave.

When I arrived, the bartender, Clausell Johnson, met me outside to explain a customer inside was refusing to leave after being asked multiple times. Johnson also stated when he went outside to call the police, he watched as the suspect, Kevin Santana, leaned over the bar to spit into the ice-well. Johnson walked me inside and pointed me to Santana.

I explained to Santana that he had been asked multiple times to leave the bar. I asked if he would leave after the police arrived? Santana replied "Nah." Santana still refused to leave after being told he would go to jail. I grabbed Santana by his right wrist, stood him up, and attempted to place his right hand behind his back to escort him outside. Santana stood up and instantly began pulling away from me, toward the other end of the bar. I told Santana to place his hands behind his back as he continued to pull away from me. I maintained control of Santana's right arm as he stepped into a bar stool, knocking it over, and then falling over it. I moved the barstool away, placed Santana in handcuffs while on the floor, and walked him outside to my patrol vehicle.

I searched Santana and placed him in my patrol vehicle. Sergeant B. Vazquez responded to the scene to complete a response to resistance incident report. Santana stated he was not injured and was transported to MCDC without incident. Santana refused to provide any contact information including his current address and phone number. Axon BWC was activated during this incident and later uploaded to Evidence.com.

Based on his actions during this incident, Kevin Santana violated FSS 810.08, trespassing in structure, when he was asked multiple times by bar staff to leave the establishment. Santana was asked multiple times by the bartenders to leave for disrupting other guests. Santana attempted to cause more of a problem when he spit in the ice-well after refusing to leave the establishment. I also gave Santana multiple opportunities to leave the bar before he was placed under arrest.

Based on his actions during this incident, Kevin Santana violated FSS 843.02, resisting without violence. While being taken into custody and told to place his hands behind his back, Santana pulled away from me and attempted to turn towards me to defeat my efforts of placing him in handcuffs. Santana pulled away until he fell over a barstool onto the ground, allowing me to place him in handcuffs for the initial crime of trespassing.
