On Saturday, 01/16/2021, at approximately 2212 hours, Ofc. Howell and I (Ofc. R. Perez) were on a mask patrol on the 200 block of Duval St. While on patrol we were flagged down by the staff at Rick's Bar.

Upon arrival we spoke to a female later identified by her Florida DL as Mirtha Valdez. Valdez handed me two driver's licenses and pointed to two males who were standing at the entrance of Rick's Bar. The males handed her the licenses trying to enter Rick's Bar. Valdes stated she believed the licenses were fake. The first male was later identified by his Illinois DL as Grayson Biddle. The second male was later identified by his Michigan DL as Grant Hood.

I asked Biddle and Hood to walk toward Charles St. so we could check their licenses. I explained to both Biddle and Hood that they are being detained. Ofc. Howell took the licenses to his patrol vehicle to verify whether they were fake or not. I saw Hood whisper something in Biddle's ear and I warned them that if they decide to run, I will use my TASER. Both Hood and Biddle took off running before we made it to Charles St. Biddle ran onto Duval St. and started to run northbound.

I retrieved my TASER, activated it, and deployed my TASER in the direction of Biddle's back. Both prongs from the TASER cartridge struck Biddle in his back, approximately one foot apart. I achieved neuromuscular incapacitation (NMI) through the usage of my TASER. I placed Biddle in handcuffs and walked him over to Charles St. I contacted Sgt. A. Rodriguez and asked him to respond to my location in reference to a use of force. Sgt. A. Rodriguez told dispatch to send an ambulance to my location.

A couple minutes later Ofc. Howell arrives on scene with Hood in handcuffs. Ofc. Howell stated he chased Hood on foot and gave him several commands to stop. See Ofc. Howell's supplemental report.

While I waited for Sgt. A. Rodriguez and rescue to arrive on scene, Biddle stated he was peer pressured into running away.

Rescue 2 arrived on scene and medically evaluated Biddle. Biddle was not injured when he fell after I deployed my TASER. Rescue 2 medically cleared Biddle and Ofc. Lopez removed the prongs that were in Biddle's back.

I collected the TASER cartridge, both prongs, two AFIDs and a blast door from the cartridge. Biddle had a fake driver's license from Maine with a date of birth of 10/01/1997. Hood had a fake driver's license from Illinois with a date of birth of 04/02/1998. I checked both fake licenses on F/NCIC and they both were not on file. We asked if they had actual licenses and they stated their licenses were in their wallets. Biddle had an Illinois driver's license and Hood had a Michigan driver's license. I checked the real licenses on F/NCIC, and I got a return for both Biddle and Hood. Biddle was born on 10/01/2000 he is 20 years old and Hood was born in 04/02/2001, he is 19 years old. They both were using the fake driver's licenses to enter Rick's Bar.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause, that on 01/16/2021, Grayson T. Biddle, did knowingly possess an instrument in the similitude of a driver's license issued by the state of Maine, violating F.S.S. 322.212(1)(b) unauthorized possession of and other unlawful acts in reference to a driver's license. Furthermore, Grayson T. Biddle did knowingly and intentionally, run away, resisting me in my lawful execution of my legal duty violating F.S.S. 843.02 resisting arrest without violence.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause, that on 01/16/2021, Grant J. Hood, did knowingly

possess an instrument in the similitude of a driver's license issued by the state of Illinois, violating F.S.S. 322.212(1)(b) unauthorized possession of and other unlawful acts in reference to a driver's license. Furthermore, Grant J. Hood did knowingly and intentionally, run away, resisting me in my lawful execution of my legal duty violating F.S.S. 843.02 resisting arrest without violence.

My Axon BWC was activated during this incident. I placed the TASER cartridge, prongs, AFIDs, blast door and the fake driver's licenses in the KWPD Property Division as evidence.

On Saturday, 01/16/2021 at approximately 2212 hours, Ofc. R. Perez and I (Ofc. Howell) were on a foot patrol of the 200 Block of Duval Street. Ofc. R. Perez and I were flagged down at 202 Duval Street (Rick's Bar) by Rick's security regarding a possible trespassing call.

Ofc. R. Perez and I encountered two unknown male subject's attempting to enter the bar with false identifications. I walked away from the two unknown male subjects and left them with Ofc. R. Perez. I was in the process of walking to my patrol vehicle to check the validity of the false identification when I heard Ofc. R. Perez deploy his taser for one of the unknown subjects. As I turned around, I witnessed Grant J. Hood (DOB: 04/02/2001, Arrestee) running south on Duval Street, past me. I initiated in a foot pursuit, giving Hood clear, loud verbal commands to stop. Hood continued to run, turning left on Caroline Street, heading east. I drew my taser, again giving Hood clear, loud verbal commands to stop or he would be tased. Hood darted in between several parked cars on Ann Street, again turning left, heading north. I reholstered my taser and continued to pursue Hood. Hood continued running and turned right onto Greene Street, heading east, and then right again onto Simonton Street, heading south. I witnessed Hood attempt to hide within the parking lot at 220 Simonton Street. I drew my taser and gave Hood clear, loud commands to lay face down with his hands behind his back. I placed Hood in handcuffs and walked him back to 202 Duval Street. Ofc. R. Perez had the other male subject seated on the curb, on the Charles Street side of 202 Duval Street. I placed Hood on the curb next to the other male subject. Key West Fire/Rescue was dispatched and cleared both subjects.

I searched Hood and placed him in the back of the transport van. Ofc. R. Perez transported Hood to the Monroe County Corrections Center, without incident.

My BWC was activated for the foot pursuit, arrest and subsequent search of Hood.

At this time, no further information.
