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AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION" BY AMENDING SECTION 2-351, TO AMEND THE COMPOSITION OF THE KEY WEST HOUSING AUTHORITY BOARD TO SEVEN MEMBERS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Key West finds that it is necessary to adjust the membership of the Key West Housing Authority Board;" and

WHEREAS, an amendment to section 2-351 of the Code of Ordinances will promote the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and visitors of the City of Key West.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That Section 2-351 of the Code of
Ordinances is hereby amended as follows*:

Sec. 2-351. - Created, composition, terms, vacancies.

There is created a board of commissioners of the housing authority to be composed of <u>five seven</u> members, who shall be appointed by the mayor for terms of four years. Vacancies in the board shall be filled as provided for the original appointments for the balance of the term of the membership. This increase in the number of members is pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 421.05 which provides that no fewer than five persons and no more than seven persons shall be appointed to the authority.

Section 2: If any section, provision, clause, phrase, or application of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall be construed as reasonable and necessary to achieve the lawful purposes of this Ordinance.
