On February 14, 2021, at approximately 0425 hours, I (Ofc. N. Wynn) was dispatched to 817 Washington St., Apt 1, in reference to a Criminal Mischief complaint.

I arrived and met with one of the victims, Iris Matamoros Chavarria, at the apartment. Chavarria stated that around 0400 hours her ex-boyfriend, identified as Luis Grullon Matos, started banging on the windows and doors of the apartment that she shares with her mother. Chavarria said Matos tried to get into the front door but she would not open it. Chavarria stated that she went back to her bedroom, which is in the front of the building next to the building's parking lot. Chavarria said she then heard two crashes and looked out the corner of the blinds and saw Matos leaving. Chavarria could not see what type of vehicle Matos left in.

Chavarria was not able to see the damage to any vehicles in the parking lot from her window due to it being dark. but she had heard two crashes. Chavarria and I walked over to the parking lot and inspected her car. The windshield on her silver Kia sedan was shattered on the passenger side. Chavarria's mother's blue Jeep SUV was parked next to her Kia and its windshield was also shattered on the driver's side. There was an approximately 6" by 6" piece of what looked to be broken cinder block on the hood of the Jeep.

I spoke with Chavarria's mother, Olga Chavarria, about the incident. Olga said that Matos had been banging on the windows and doors of the apartment. Olga said that she had made eye contact with Matos through the window, and that had motioned to her to let him in. Olga said she had refused and Matos started hitting the front door again. Olga did not see what type of vehicle Matos left in.

Chavarria and Matos have a 6-month-old son together. They had not, at the time of this incident, established custody or visitation rights. Chavarria said that the last time she had spoken with Matos was on January 17, 2021.

When Chavarria made her initial call to Key West Communications, she identified her ex-boyfriend, Matos, as the suspect. While I was conducting my interviews at 817 Washington St, Ofc. R. Perez and Ofc. Roscoe went to Matos' last know address, his mother's apartment at 831 Thomas St. Ofc. R. Perez and Ofc. Roscoe were able to make contact with Matos at his mother's upstairs apartment and get him downstairs to their patrol vehicles without incident. However, according to Ofc. Roscoe, Matos became combative once they got handcuffs on him and got him to the awaiting patrol vehicles. After I completed my initial investigation at 817 Washington St I went to Matos` house. When I arrived Matos was lying on the ground, on his left side, handcuffed, with Ofc. R. Perez holding Matos' shoulders down and Ofc. Roscoe holding down Matos' legs. Ofc. R. Perez stated to me that while he and Ofc, Roscoe were taking Matos into custody, Matos said "I know who you are" and threatened to kill both Ofc. Perez an Ofc. Roscoe. Ofc. R. Perez also told me that Matos had admitted to breaking the windshields on the vehicles. Due to the fact that Matos had to be taken to the ground in the course of his arrest, watch supervisor Sgt. A. Rodriguez was called to the scene. Sgt. A. Rodriguez interviewed Matos, and Matos stated that he was not injured.

Ofc. Dantu arrived as well and got a hobble strap out of his vehicle. The hobble was secured carefully around Matos' legs. Matos remained combative but was brought back up to his feet. Matos was escorted to my patrol vehicle. Officers attempted to place Matos in the back seat of my vehicle. Even though Matos was hobbled he was able to bring his legs up and kick at Ofc. Perez. Matos missed. Officers were able to situate Matos in the back seat of my patrol vehicle. The hobble placed on Matos was secured through the passenger rear and front doors for transport. I transported Matos to the Monroe County Detention Center. Matos remained calm as he was removed from my patrol vehicle and taken into custody by Corrections Deputies.

This incident was recorded on my BWC. The transportation of Matos to Monroe County Detention Center was recorded on my in-car COBAN.

PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

At approximately 0400 hours on the morning of February 14, 2021, Luis Grullon Matos used a piece of cinder block to shatter the front windshield of Iris Chavarria's Kia sedan, causing approximately \$350.00 in damage. Matos used the same block to shatter the front windshield of Olga Chavarria's Jeep SUV, causing another \$350.00 in damage, approximately. Matos caused this damage maliciously after Olga and Iris Chavarria would not let him into their apartment at that time of morning. Based on these facts Matos was charged with violation of FSS 806.13-(1)(b)(2) CRIMINAL MISCHIEF OVER \$200 UNDER \$1000.

While being lawfully taken into custody by Ofc. R. Perez and Ofc. Roscoe, Matos became combative and tried to fight with officers, even though he had handcuffs on. Matos had to be taken to the ground. Matos continued to kick at officers and had to be pinned down by Ofc. R. Perez and Ofc. Roscoe while Ofc. Dantu placed him in a hobble. Matos then tried to kick Ofc. R. Perez as he was being placed in the back of my patrol vehicle. Based on these facts Matos was charged with violation of FSS 843.01 RESISTING OFFICER WITH VIOLENCE.

While being lawfully detained Matos made overt threats to Ofc. R. Perez and Ofc. Roscoe saying that he knew who they were, and that he was going to kill them. Based on these facts Matos was charged with violation of FSS 838.021-(3)(b) CORRUPTION BY THREAT AGAINST A PUBLIC OFFICIAL.

On 02/14/2021, at 0426 hours, Ofc. Wynn and I (Ofc. R. Perez) were dispatched to 814 Washington St. in reference to a criminal mischief. While in route to Washington St. I was advised the suspect left in a red Honda SUV. The victim advised the suspect lives at 831 Thomas St. I drove to 831 Thomas St. to speak with the suspect.

Upon arrival, I waited for confirmation from Ofc. Wynn that a crime has been committed. Ofc. Roscoe arrived on scene and Ofc. Wynn advised the suspect was a male named Luis Grullon-Matos and he damaged two vehicles. Ofc. Roscoe and I walked over to 831 Thomas St. apartment 3 to speak with the suspect. We knock on the door and Grullon-Matos' sister opened the door I asked her if I could speak to Grullon-Matos. Grullon-Matos approached the door, stated I know why you were here and began to cry. Grullon-Matos started to tell a story of a time he got stabbed in the Dominican Republic. I told Grullon-Matos he has told me the story before and that I needed to know what happened earlier in the night. Grullon-Matos stated, "I broke the windows on the cars, I will pay for them." I asked Grullon-Matos to step out of his apartment. Grullon-Matos complied and was placed in handcuffs.

We began to walk Grullon-Matos down the stairs toward Ofc. Roscoe's vehicle. Grullon-Matos began screaming that I am arresting him because he is Hispanic. I explained to Grullon-Matos that I am Hispanic, and he is being arrested for criminal mischief. Ofc. Roscoe and I approached his vehicle we attempted to place Grullon-Matos against the vehicle to search him. Grullon-Matos lifted his legs and pushed off the vehicle with his legs causing Ofc. Roscoe and I to stumble backwards. We attempted to place him in the vehicle, and he pushed against the vehicle with his legs causing Ofc. Roscoe and I to stumble again. We attempted to gain control of Grullon-Matos, he began pulling away from us and tried throwing himself on the ground. Ofc. Roscoe and I placed Grullon-Matos on the ground in a controlled manner. Ofc. Roscoe controlled Grullon-Matos' legs and I controlled Grullon-Matos' upper body. Grullon-Matos stated several times he knew Ofc. Roscoe and I and he was going to kill us.

Ofc. Dantu and Ofc. Agleev arrived on scene. Ofc. Dantu placed a hobble on Grullon-Matos' legs. Ofc. Agleev and I stood Grullon-Matos up and walked him to Ofc. Wynn's vehicle. After placing Grullon-Matos in the vehicle he attempted to kick me when I was trying to put his seat belt on.

My AXON BWC was activated during this incident.

On 02/14/2021 at approximately 0424 hours, I was dispatched to the corner of Olivia St. and Thomas St. to assist Ofc. R. Perez.

When I arrived, Ofc R. Perez was already on scene. Ofc. R. Perez and I proceeded to 831 Thomas St. (Apt. 3) upstairs in attempt to make contact with the subject, Luis Grullon Matos.

Ofc. Perez knocked on the door, but no one answered. He then said he saw a back door. I proceed to the back of the apartment building to make sure Matos did not attempt to exit the back door of the apartment.

I found the stairs that lead to the back door of the apartment. A short time later I heard talking coming form the front of the apartment building so I went back to the front of the building. I went back to the front of the building and found Ofc. R Perez standing at the door of the apartment with Matos.

Ofc. R. Perez and Matos were speaking in Spanish so I could not understand what was being said. After a short time, Matos came out of the apartment. Once Matos was out of the apartment Ofc. R Perez and I placed Matos into custody.

As we were escorting Matos to my patrol car, he began yelling and cursing in both Spanked and English. Once we got to my patrol car, we attempted to place Matos in the back of my patrol car, he lifted his leg up and placed his foot on the side of my patrol and pushed back away from the car, causing Ofc. R. Perez and I to stumble backwards. Once I regained my balance, we attempted to place him in the car again, he did the same thing.

Matos then began tensing up and pulling away from Ofc. Perez and I. I told Ofc. Perez we needed to take Matos to the ground. Ofc. Perez and I then escorted Matos to the ground in a controlled manner. Once Matos was on the ground Ofc. R. Perez maintained control of Matos's upper body as I maintained control of his legs. Matos continued to resist us while on the ground. I requested another unit from dispatch.

When Ofc. Dantu arrived I asked him to get a Hobble so we could restrain Matos's legs to place him in the back of my patrol car. Ofc. Dantu retrieved a hobble form his patrol car which was applied to Matos's legs.

Once Matos was hobbled, he was able to be placed into the back of Ofc, Wynn's patrol car.

My BWC recorded the above interaction.
