A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CULTURAL PRESERVATION SOCIETY, AKA CPS SUNSET CELEBRATION TO CONDUCT A STREET FAIR DURING THE CONCH REPUBLIC INDEPENDENCE CELEBRATION ON THE SATURDAY, APRIL 24, 2021 FROM 10:00 A.M. TO 6:00 P.M; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF THE 200 AND 300 BLOCK OF DUVAL CROSS STREETS WILL REMAIN OPEN FROM 8:00 A.M. TO 7:30 P.M; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City

Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public

property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship

with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless
such use is otherwise preempted by law"

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City"

SECTION 3. That the Key West Cultural Preservation Society is hereby granted permission to conduct the street fair on the days and during the hours stated above; Provided all trash is adequately collected and contained; guarantee indemnifying the City is executed; Provided the organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

**SECTION 4.** That all neighboring property owners and/or tenants shall be notified of the event on the 200 and 300 blocks of Duval.

**SECTION 5.** The Conch Republic Independence Celebration, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

**SECTION 6.** That the applicant acknowledges this authorization may be revoked by this Commission, or the City Manager, due to exigent circumstances such as the resurgence of COVID- 19 in the Community.

**SECTION 7.** That this resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the Presiding Officers and the Clerk of the Commission.
